## KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- In Q4 2024, total capital importation into Nigeria stood at US\$5089.16 million, higher than US\$1088.48 million recorded in Q4 2023, indicating an increase of 367.55 %. In comparison to the preceding quarter, capital importation increased by 306.27% from US\$1252.66 million in Q3 2024.
- Portfolio Investment ranked top with US\$3999.17 million, accounting for 78.58%, followed by Other Investment with US\$668.10 million, accounting for (13.13%). Foreign Direct Investment recorded the least with US\$421.88 million (8.29%) of total capital importation in Q4 2024.
- The Banking sector recorded the highest inflow with US\$3229.62 million, representing 63.46% of total capital imported in Q1 2025, followed by the Financing sector, valued at US\$879.16million (17.28%), and Production/Manufacturing sector with US\$421.04 million (8.27%).
- Capital Importation during the reference period originated largely from the United Kingdom with US\$2850.52 million, showing 56.01% of the total capital imported. This was followed by the United States of America with US\$596.77 million (11.73%) and The Republic of South Africa with US\$454.94 Million (8.94%).
- Out of the four states that recorded capital importation during the quarter, Lagos State remained the top destination with US\$3202.18 million, accounting for 62.92% of the total capital imported. Abuja (FCT) followed with US\$1846.47 million (36.28%), Oyo state with US\$40.50million (0.80%) and Ekiti State with US\$0.01 Million
- Stanbic IBTC Bank Ltd received the highest capital importation into Nigeria in Q1 2024 with US\$2236.35 Million- followed by Standard Chartered bank Nigeria with US\$1170.79 million (23.01%), and Rand Merchant Bank with US\$621.78 million (12.22%)

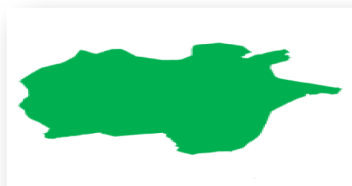
