Preface

This publication provides data on Quarterly Gross Domestic Product (GDP) estimates for the four quarters of 2024, the annual figure for 2024, and the first quarter of 2025. The figures presented in the report are newly obtained quarterly estimates, benchmarked to the annual rebased estimates. This technique allows for national accounts quarterly time series data on the rebased estimates.

Quarterly National Accounts (QNA) are integrated systems of macroeconomic accounts designed to describe the entire system of production in a nation quarterly. They provide a picture of the current status of the economy that is timely and more frequent than that provided by Annual National Accounts (ANA). The key attribute of QNA is that they provide a reasonable level of detail of the economy that helps the government to assess, analyse, and monitor economic growth regularly.

QNA adopts the same concepts, definitions, and structure as ANA. In principle, QNA covers the entire sequence of accounts and balance sheets as reflected in the 2008 System of National Accounts (2008 SNA).

The data for Q1 2025 were obtained from the Quarterly Establishment Survey (QES) conducted by the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS). This series covers major aggregates of quarterly GDP by kind of economic activities at current and constant (2019) prices.

We are grateful to the various agencies and establishments that made their data available as input to the estimates.

Introduction

The National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) has been conducting Establishment Surveys to provide data for the estimation of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for the country. In 2008, NBS started to improve the GDP series by conducting Quarterly Establishment Surveys (QES) for the four quarters of each year to provide timely estimates for decisions and policymaking.

In 2018, the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) conducted the Quarterly Establishment Surveys for the first three quarters of 2018 (Q1-Q3/ 2018), while the fourth quarter survey for 2018 was conducted in the first quarter of 2019. This compilation procedure is carried out to date, publishing the Q4 GDP report within the first quarter of the new accounting year. It is important to note that the Bureau maintains a publication date of 45 days after the quarter.

In subsequent sections of this report, emphasis will be given to the composition of GDP in the first quarter of 2025, the corresponding quarter of 2024, and the immediate past quarter of 2024 (Q4 2024).



Overview of GDP in Quarter One 2025

Following the rebasing of the Gross Domestic Product using 2019 as the base year, previous quarterly GDP estimates were benchmarked to the rebased annual estimates to align the old series to the new rebased estimates. This procedure provided new quarterly GDP series, which are compared to the 2025 first quarter estimates. Gross Domestic Product (GDP) grew by **3.13%** (year-on-year) in real terms in the first quarter of 2025. This growth rate is higher than the 2.27% recorded in the first quarter of 2024. The performance of the GDP in the quarter under review was driven mainly by the Services sector, which recorded a growth of 4.33% and contributed 57.50% to the aggregate GDP. The agriculture sector grew by 0.07%, from the growth of -1.79% recorded in the first quarter of 2024. The growth of the industry sector was 3.42%, from 2.35% recorded in the first quarter of 2024. In terms of share of the GDP, the services and industry sectors contributed more to the aggregate GDP in the first quarter of 2025 compared to the corresponding quarter of 2024.

In the quarter under review, aggregate GDP at basic price stood at N94,051,733.20 million in nominal terms. This performance is higher when compared to the first quarter of 2024, which recorded an aggregate GDP of N79,505,265.15 million, indicating a year-on-year nominal growth of 18.30%. For better clarity, the Nigerian economy has been classified broadly into the oil and non-oil sectors (Pages 5 & 6).

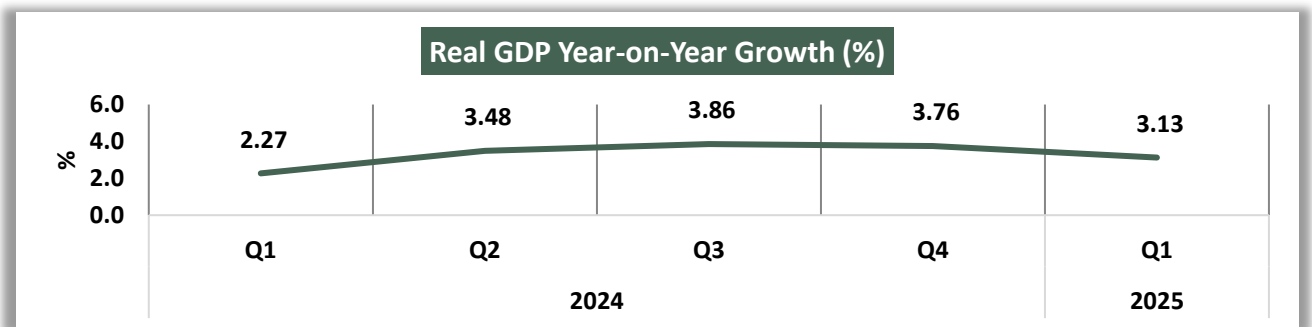


Figure 1: Real GDP Growth

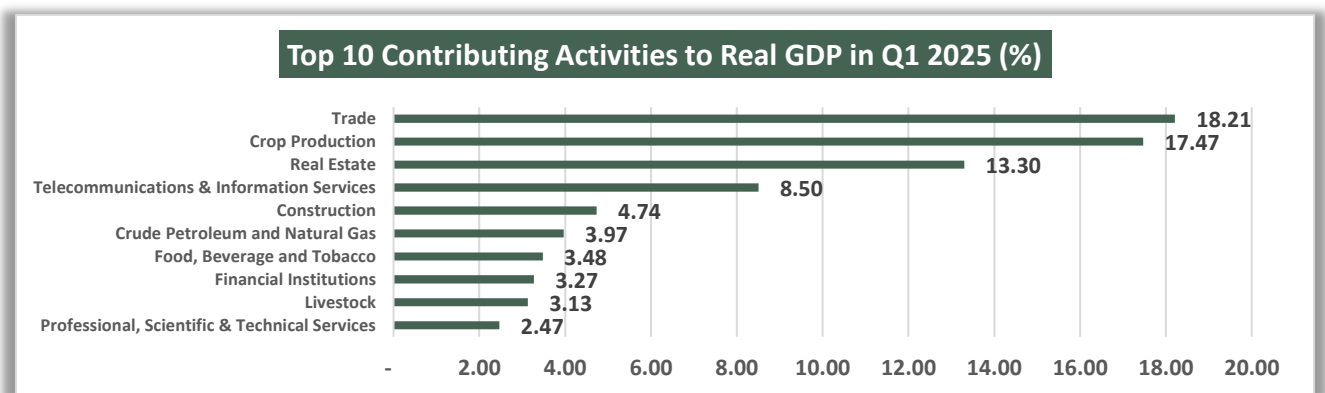


Figure 2: Top 10 Contributing Activities to Real GDP in Q1 2025

The Oil Sector

The nation in the first quarter of 2025 recorded an average daily oil production of 1.62 million barrels per day (mbpd), higher than the daily average production of 1.57 mbpd recorded in the same quarter of 2024 by 0.05 mbpd and higher than the fourth quarter of 2024 production volume of 1.54 mbpd by 0.08mbpd. 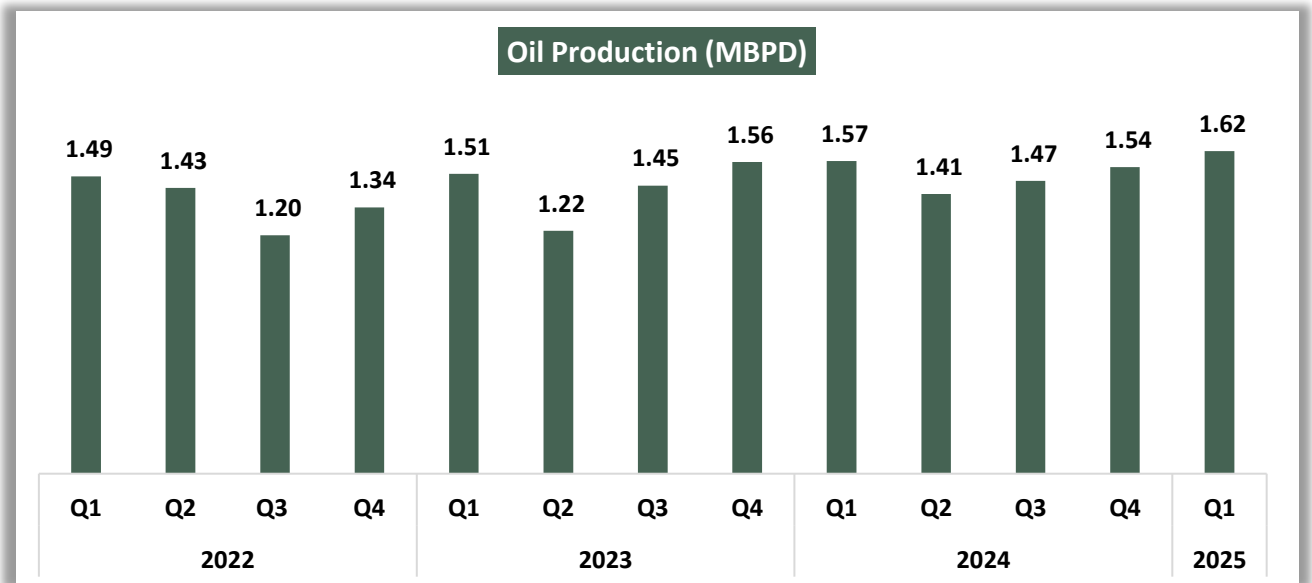


Figure 3: Crude Oil Output (MBPD)

The real growth of the oil sector was 1.87% (year-on-year) in Q1 2025, indicating a decrease of 2.85% points relative to the rate recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024 (4.71%). Growth decreased by 0.22% points when compared to Q4 2024, which was 2.08%. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the oil sector recorded a growth rate of 13.81% in Q1 2025. The Oil sector contributed 3.97% to the total real GDP in Q1 2025, down from the figure recorded in the corresponding period of 2024 at 4.02%. and up from the preceding quarter, where it contributed 2.80%.

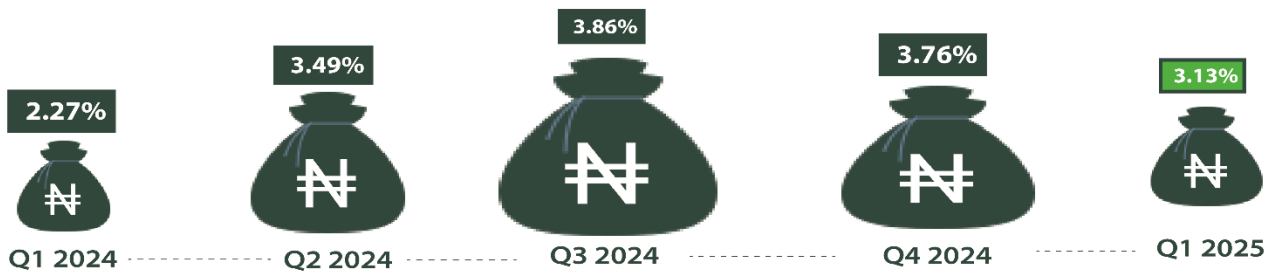

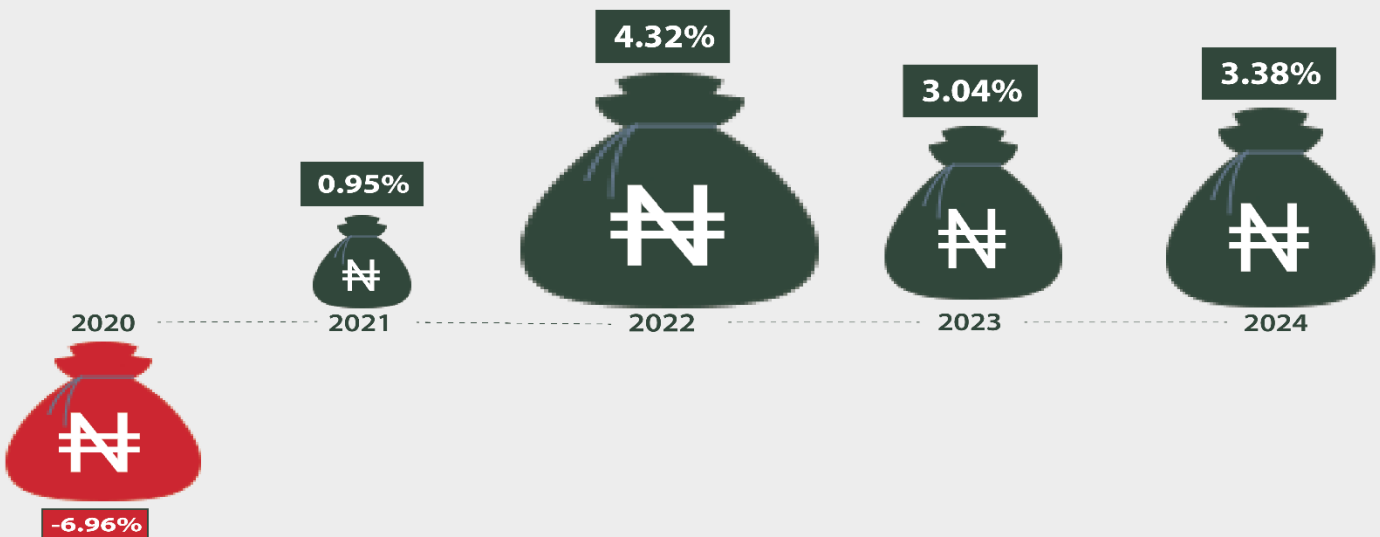

The Non-Oil Sector

The non-oil sector grew by 3.19% in real terms during the reference quarter (Q1 2025). This rate was higher by 1.02% points compared to the rate recorded in the same quarter of 2024, which was 2.17% and lower than the 3.80% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024. This sector was driven in the first quarter of 2025 mainly by Information and Communication (Telecommunications); Agriculture (Crop production); Real Estate; Financial and Insurance (Financial Institutions); Trade; Construction; and Manufacturing (Food, Beverage and Tobacco), accounting for positive GDP growth.

In real terms, the non-oil sector contributed 96.03% to the nation's GDP in the first quarter of 2025, higher than the share recorded in the first quarter of 2024, which was 95.98% and lower than the fourth quarter of 2024 recorded as 97.20%.

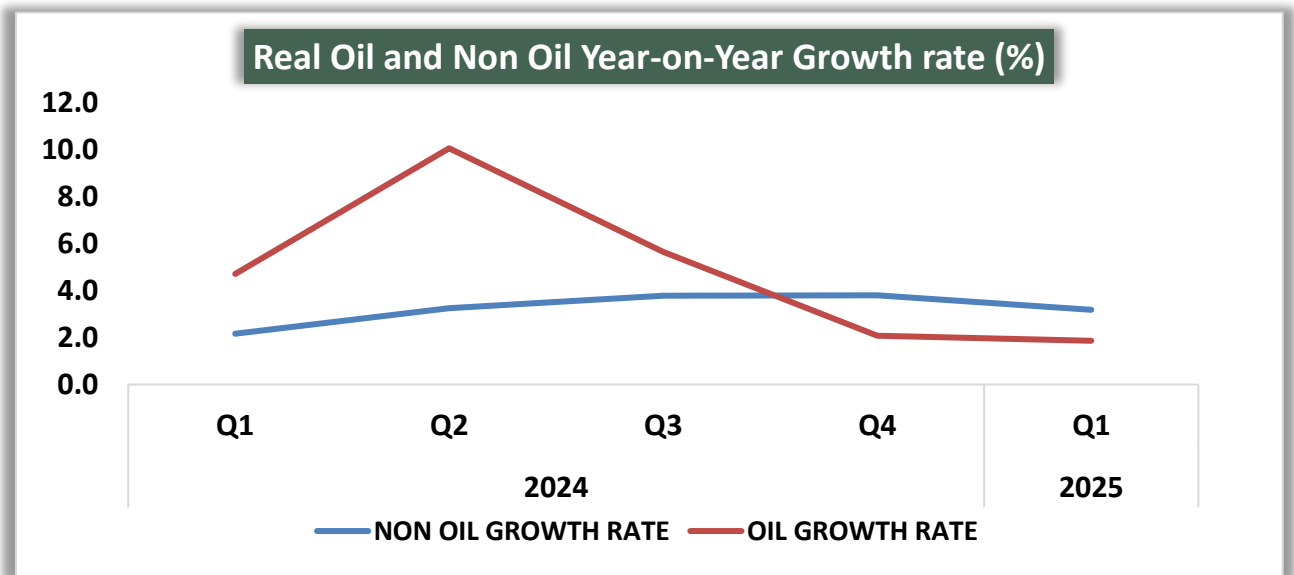
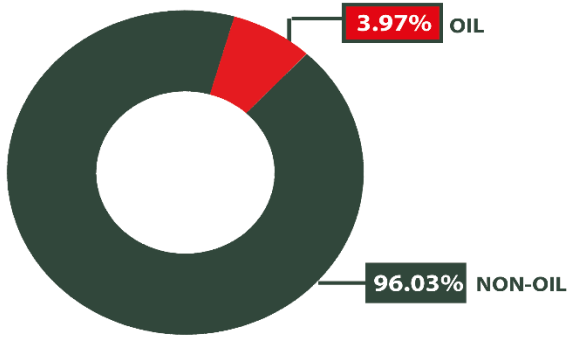


Figure 4: Crude Oil and Non-Oil Growth

CONTRIBUTION OF OIL AND NON-OIL SECTORS

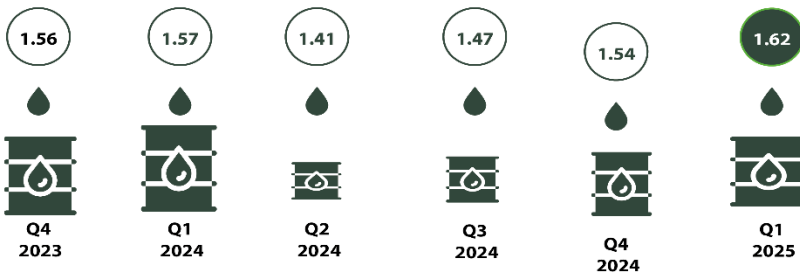

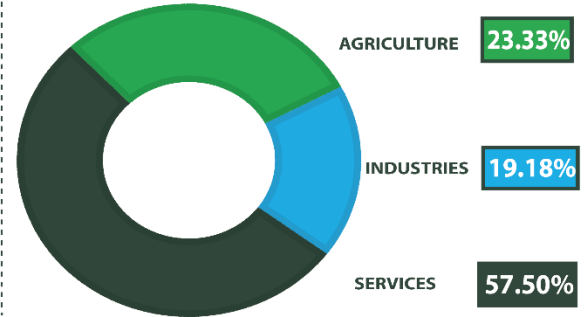

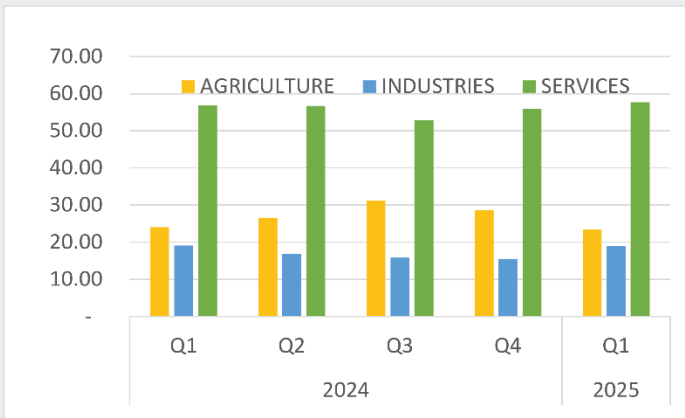
OIL PRODUCTION (MBPD)



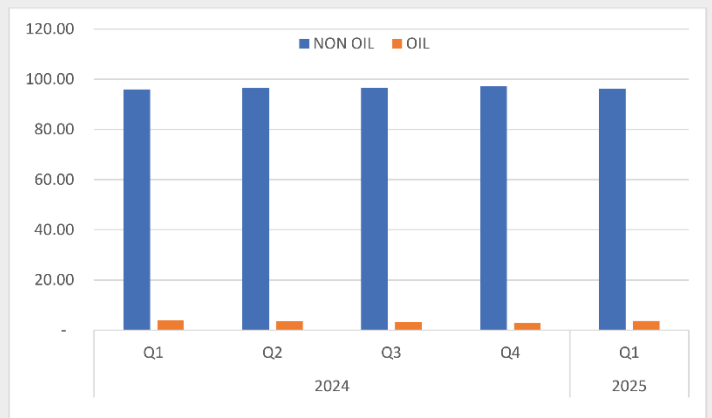
CONTRIBUTION TO REAL GDP

Major Economic Sectors: Q1 2025

Mining & Quarrying

The Mining & Quarrying sector consists of Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas, Coal Mining, Metal ores and Quarrying, and Other Minerals sub-activities. This sector grew nominally by -5.33% (year-on-year) in Q1 2025. Metal Ore activity exhibited the highest growth rate of all the sub-activities at 83.55%, followed by Quarrying and Other Mining activity at 56.13%. Crude Petroleum and Natural gas was the main contributor to the sector with a weight of 89.16% in Q1 2025. Comparing Q1 2025's rate of growth relative to Q1 2024 and Q4 2024 growth rates, there was a decrease of 26.50% points and a decrease of 64.82% points respectively. The Mining & Quarrying sector contributed 4.38% to the overall GDP in the first quarter of 2025, lower than the contributions recorded in 2024 first quarter at 5.47% and higher than the previous quarter at 3.50%.

In real terms, the Mining and Quarrying sector grew by 2.97% (year-on-year) in the first quarter of 2025. Compared to the same quarter of 2024 and the fourth quarter of 2024, it was lower by 4.38% points and lower by 0.18% points respectively. Quarter-on-quarter, the growth rate recorded was 12.00% during the quarter. The contribution of Mining and Quarrying to Real GDP in the quarter under review stood at 4.22%, lower than the rate of 4.23% recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024 and higher than the 3.02% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024.

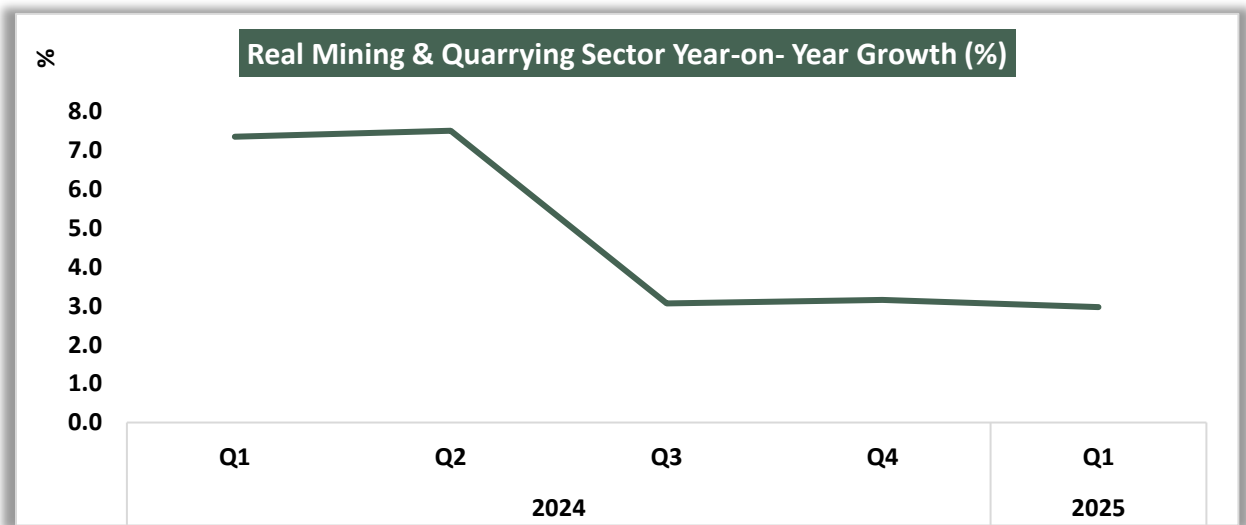


Figure 5: Mining and Quarrying real growth

Agriculture

Four sub-activities make up the Agricultural sector: Crop Production, Livestock, Forestry, and Fishing. The sector grew by 10.04% year-on-year in nominal terms in Q1 2025, showing an increase of 7.87% points from the same quarter of 2024. Looking at the preceding quarter's growth rate of 8.82%, there was an increase of 1.22% points. Crop production remained the major driver of the sector. This is evident as it accounts for 64.57% of the overall nominal value of the sector in the first quarter of 2025.

Quarter-on-quarter growth stood at -38.17% in the first quarter of 2025. Agriculture contributed 19.40% to nominal GDP in the first quarter of 2025. This figure was lower than the rate recorded in the first quarter of 2024 and lower than the fourth quarter of 2024, which recorded 20.86% and 28.25% respectively.

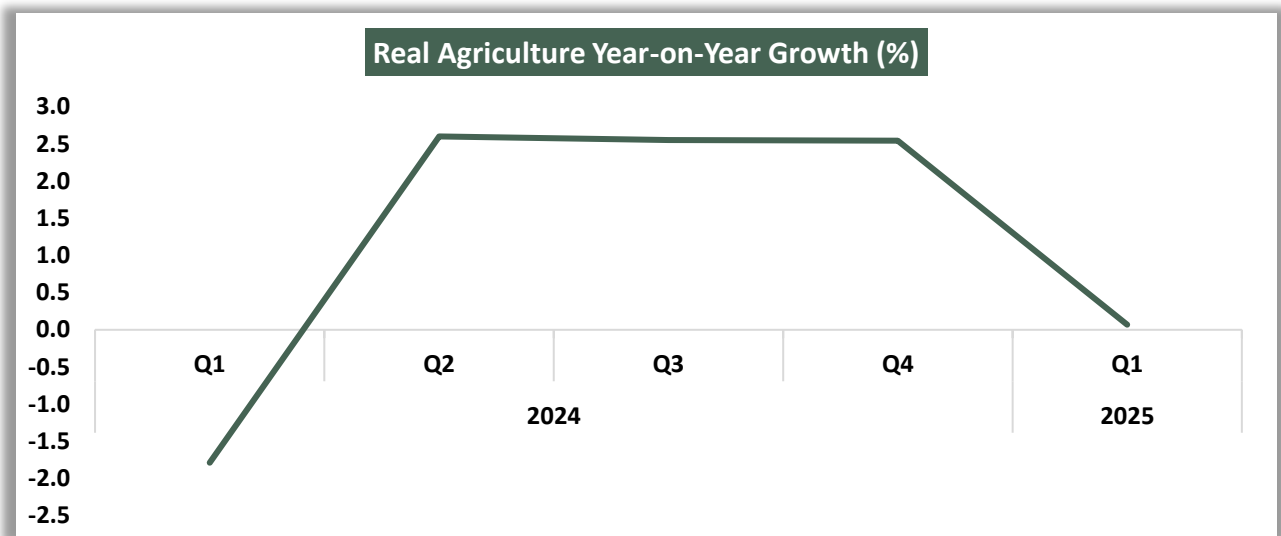


Figure 6: Agriculture real growth

The agricultural sector in the first quarter of 2025 grew by 0.07% (year-on-year) in real terms, an increase of 1.85% points from the corresponding period of 2024, and a decrease of 2.48% points from the preceding quarter which recorded a growth rate of 2.54%. It grew on a quarter-on-quarter basis at -34.70%.

However, the sector contributed 23.33% to aggregate GDP in real terms in Q1 2025, lower than the contribution in the first quarter of 2024 and lower than the fourth quarter of 2024 which stood at 24.04% and 28.68% respectively.

Manufacturing

The Manufacturing sector is comprised of thirteen activities: Oil Refining; Cement; Food, Beverages and Tobacco; Textile, Apparel, and Footwear; Wood and Wood products; Pulp Paper and Paper products; Chemical and Pharmaceutical products; Non-metallic Products, Plastic and Rubber products; Electrical and Electronic; Basic Metal and Iron and Steel; Motor Vehicles and Assembly; and Other Manufacturing.

Nominal GDP growth of the Manufacturing sector in the first quarter of 2025 was 42.40% (year-on-year), 35.09% points higher than the figure recorded in the corresponding period of 2024 (7.31%) and 29.25% points higher than the preceding quarter figure of 13.14%. Quarter-on-quarter, growth of the sector was recorded at 4.69% during the quarter. The contribution of Manufacturing to Nominal GDP in the first quarter of 2025 was 10.78%, higher than the figure recorded in the corresponding period of 2024 at 8.95% and higher than the fourth quarter of 2024 at 9.27%.

Real GDP growth in the manufacturing sector in the first quarter of 2025 was 1.69% (year-on-year), higher than the same quarter of 2024 and higher than the preceding quarter by 0.11% points and 0.41% points respectively. The growth rate of the sector on a quarter-on-quarter basis stood at 1.42%. The Real contribution to GDP in the 2025 first quarter was 9.62%, lower than the 9.76% recorded in the first quarter of 2024 and higher than the 7.62% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024.

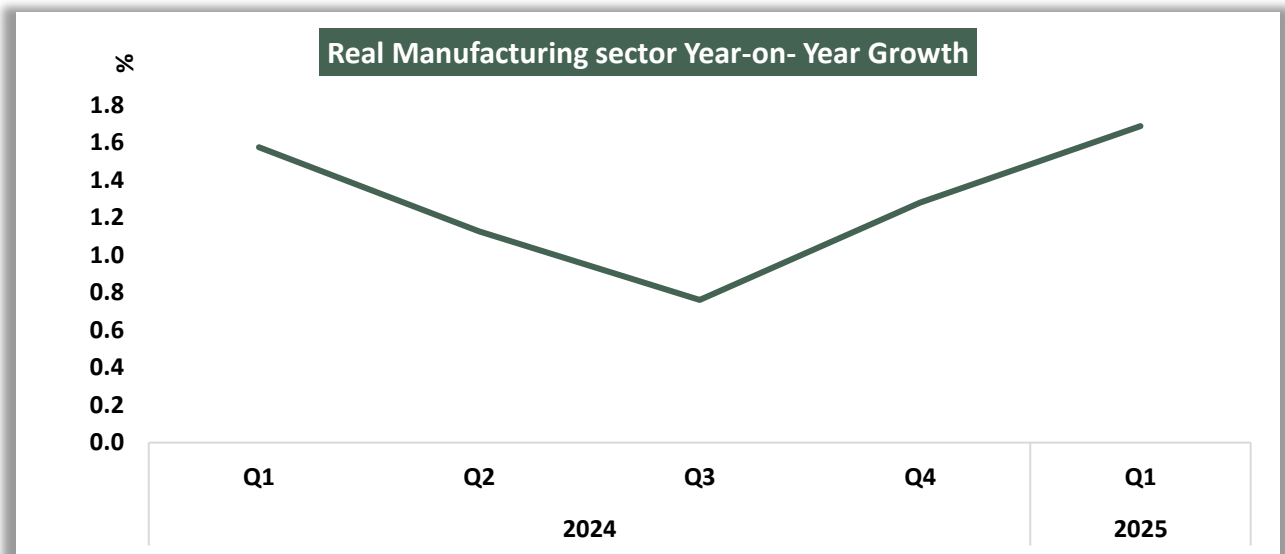


Figure 7: Manufacturing real growth

Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air Conditioning Supply

The Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air conditioning Supply sector recorded a year-on-year growth of -23.52% in the first quarter of 2025. This was 1.89% points lower than the 25.41% growth rate recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024, and 17.90% points higher than the growth rate of 5.62% recorded in the quarter before. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector recorded a growth rate of -65.18% in Q1 2025. The contribution of Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air Conditioning Supply to Nominal GDP in the first quarter of 2025 was 0.36%, higher than the contribution made in the corresponding quarter of 2024 at 0.35% and lower than its contribution of 0.94% in the quarter before.

In real terms, the sector grew by 18.65% in Q1 2025, an increase from the growth rate of 2.49% recorded in the same quarter of 2024. When compared to the immediate past quarter, there was an increase of 26.62% points from -7.97% recorded. On a quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew at a rate of -63.25%. The contribution of this sector to real GDP in the first quarter of 2025 was 0.35%, higher than the 0.30% recorded in Q1 2024 and lower than the 0.76% recorded in Q4 2024.

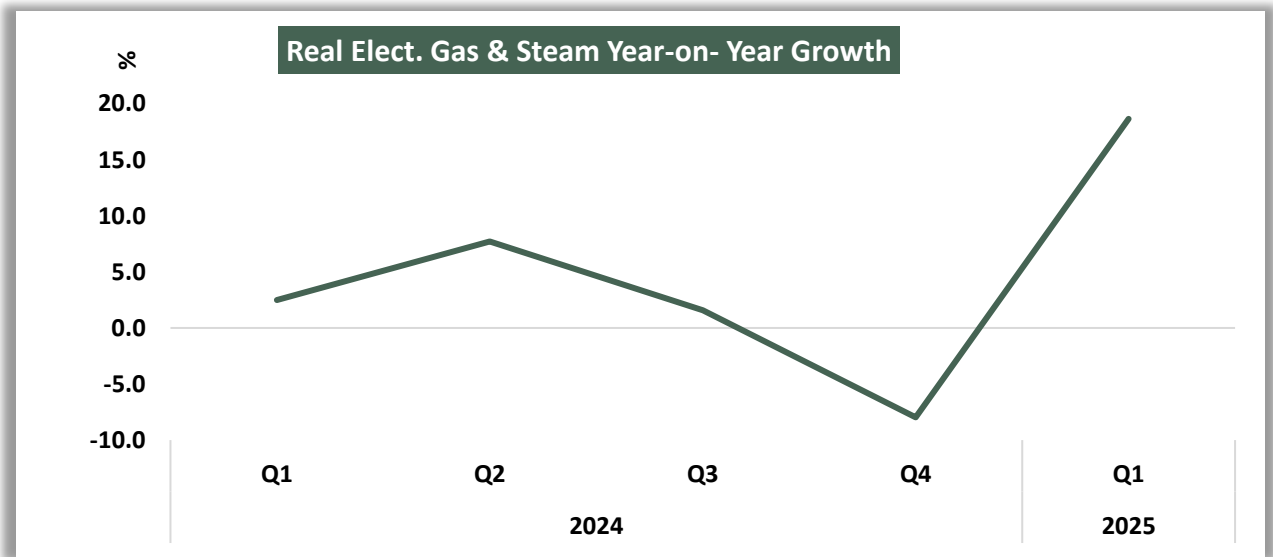


Figure 8: Electricity, Gas and Steam real growth

Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management, and Remediation

This sector grew by 36.07% in nominal terms (year-on-year) in the first quarter of 2025, an increase of 0.33% points compared to the rate of 35.74% recorded in the same quarter of 2024. There was an increase of 7.50% points when compared to the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Nominal growth quarter-on-quarter was recorded at 32.81%. The Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management and Remediation sector contributed 0.22% to nominal GDP in the first quarter of 2025, higher than the 0.20% it contributed a year earlier and higher than the 0.15% contributed in the fourth quarter of 2024.

The real growth rate of the Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management and Remediation sector in the first quarter of 2025 was recorded at 9.43% (year-on-year), higher by 3.01% points from the rate recorded in the previous year. Relative to the preceding quarter, there was a decrease of 0.09% points. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by 17.23% in real terms.

Its contribution to total real GDP was 0.25% in the first quarter of 2025, higher than its contribution of 0.24% in the same quarter of the previous year, and higher than the immediate past quarter where it contributed 0.17%.

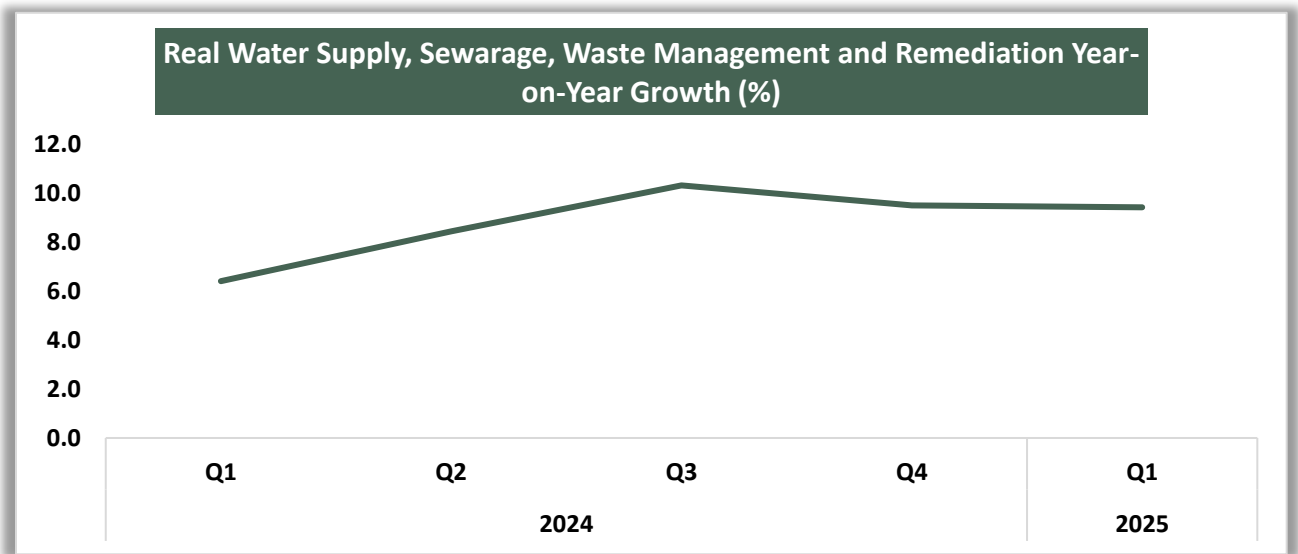


Figure 9: Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management and Remediation real growth

Construction

The Construction sector grew by 23.46% in nominal terms (year-on-year) in the 2025 first quarter, an increase of 14.78% points compared to the rate of 8.69% recorded in the same quarter of 2024. Also, there was an increase of 1.56% points when compared to the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Nominal growth quarter-on-quarter was recorded at 9.93%. Construction contributed 5.38% to nominal GDP in the first quarter of 2025, higher than the 5.16% it contributed a year earlier and higher than the 4.41% contributed to the fourth quarter of 2024.

The real growth rate of the construction sector in the first quarter of 2025 was recorded at 6.21% (year-on-year), higher by 6.73% points from the rate recorded in the previous year. Relative to the preceding quarter, there was a decrease of 0.30% points. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by -1.96% in real terms.

Its contribution to total real GDP was 4.74% in the first quarter of 2025; higher than its contribution of 4.60% in the same quarter of the previous year, and higher than in the immediate past quarter where it contributed 3.88%.

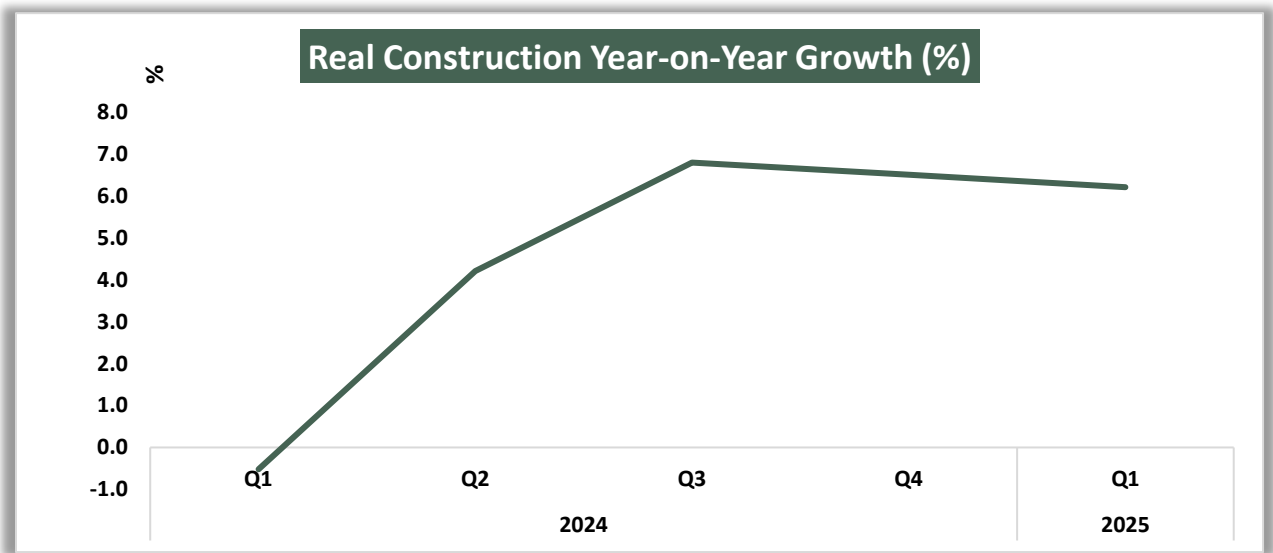


Figure 10: Construction real growth

Trade

In the first quarter of 2025, the nominal year-on-year growth rate of Trade stood at 9.13%. This indicates an increase of 0.37% points when compared to the first quarter of 2024 growth rate of 8.76% and 18.67% points lower than the previous quarter's growth rate of 27.80%. The quarter-on-quarter growth rate was -27.20%. Trade's contribution to Nominal GDP in the first quarter of 2025 was 15.52%, lower than the contribution in the same quarter of the previous year of 16.82%, and lower than the preceding quarter recorded at 19.19%.

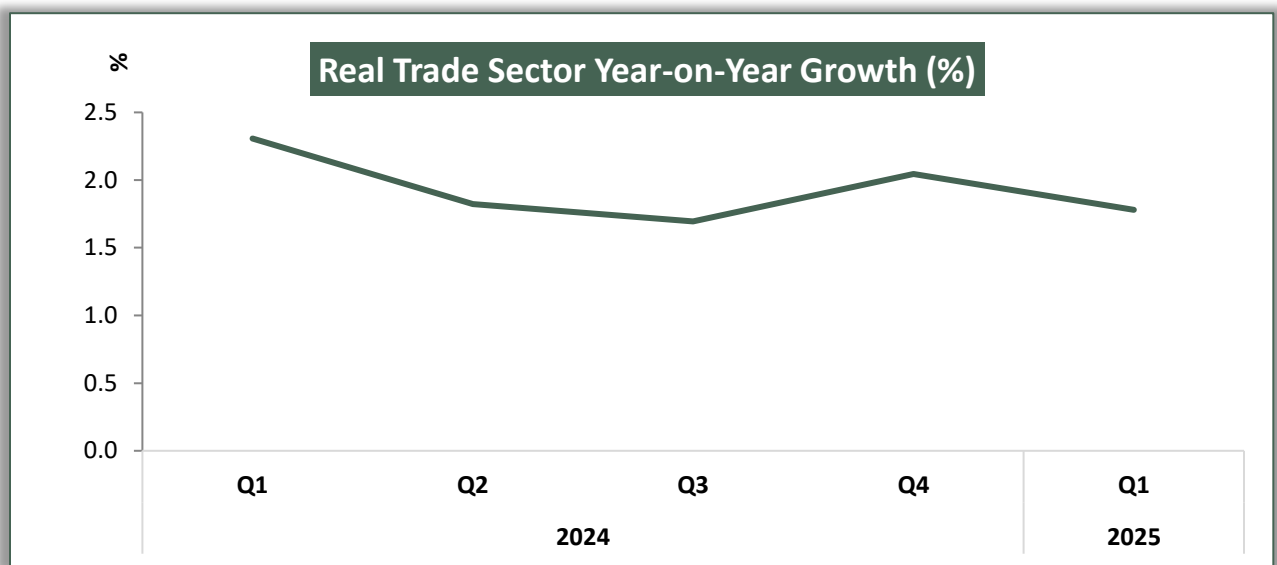


Figure 11: Trade real growth

In real terms, Trade's year-on-year growth stood at 1.78% in the first quarter of 2025, which was 0.53% points lower than the rate recorded in the previous year at 2.31%, and 0.26% points lower than in the preceding quarter at 2.04% growth rate. Quarter-on-quarter growth stood at -14.92%. Trade's contribution to GDP was 18.21%, lower than the 18.45% it represented in the previous year, and higher than the 17.18% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024.

Accommodation and Food Services

In nominal terms, Accommodation and Food Services grew by 60.33% year -on- year in 2025 first quarter. This represents an increase of 52.46% points relative to the same quarter of 2024 when the growth rate was 7.88%. Growth was higher than in the preceding quarter by 37.96% points when growth was 22.37%. Quarter-on-quarter growth stood at 35.36%. Accommodation and Food Services contribution to nominal GDP stood at 1.25% in the first quarter of 2025, higher than the figure recorded in the previous year and higher than the fourth quarter of 2024 contribution recorded at 0.93% and 0.83% respectively.

The real year-on-year growth rate for this sector in the first quarter of 2025 stood at 2.65%, lower by 0.02% points from 2.67% recorded in the previous year. Relative to the preceding quarter, the growth rate was 1.85% points lower than the 4.50% recorded. Quarter-on-quarter, real growth was 5.31%. The sector in the first quarter of 2025 represented 0.77% of the real GDP, which was relatively same with the contribution of 0.77% recorded in the first quarter of 2024 and higher than the fourth quarter of 2024 contribution of 0.59%.

Transportation and Storage

Six activities make up the Transportation and Storage sector: Road Transport; Rail Transport and Pipelines; Water Transport; Air Transport; Transport Services; and Post and Courier Services.

The sector grew by 53.56% in nominal terms in the first quarter of 2025 (year-on-year). This rate was higher relative to the figure of 38.11% recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024 and higher than 38.48% in the previous quarter. All six sub-activities under the Transport and Storage industry recorded positive growth rates in the first quarter of 2025. Quarter-on-quarter growth stood at 3.91%. Transport activities contributed 1.51% to Nominal GDP in Q1 2025, an increase from the 1.16% recorded in the corresponding period of 2024, and higher than the 1.30% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024.

In real terms, the Transportation and Storage sector grew by 14.08% in Q1 2025. This rate represents an increase of 2.16% points compared to the same quarter of the previous year and an increase of 0.88% points relative to the preceding quarter. Quarter-on-quarter, growth was -9.02%. The contribution of the sector to real GDP in Q1 of 2025 was 0.99%, higher than the 0.90% recorded in the preceding year and higher than 0.87% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024.

Information & Communication

The Information and Communication sector is composed of the four activities of Telecommunications and Information Services; Publishing; Motion Picture, Sound Recording and Music Production; and Broadcasting.

In nominal terms, in the first quarter of 2025, the sector growth was recorded at 31.63% (year-on-year), 28.23% points increase from the rate of 3.40% recorded in the same quarter of 2024, and 13.67% points higher than the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. The quarter-on-quarter growth rate recorded in the first quarter of 2025 was 8.35%. The Information and Communications sector contributed 10.29% to the total Nominal GDP in the first quarter of 2025, higher than the rate of 9.25% recorded in the same quarter of 2024 and higher than the 8.55% it contributed in the preceding quarter.

The sector in the first quarter of 2025 recorded a growth rate of 7.40% in real terms, year-on-year. From the rate recorded in the corresponding period of 2024, there was an increase of 3.36% points. On a quarter-on-quarter, the sector exhibited a growth of -8.86% in real terms. Of total real GDP, the sector contributed 10.59% in the first quarter of 2025, higher than in the same quarter of the previous year in which it represented 10.17% and higher than the preceding quarter in which it represented 9.32%.

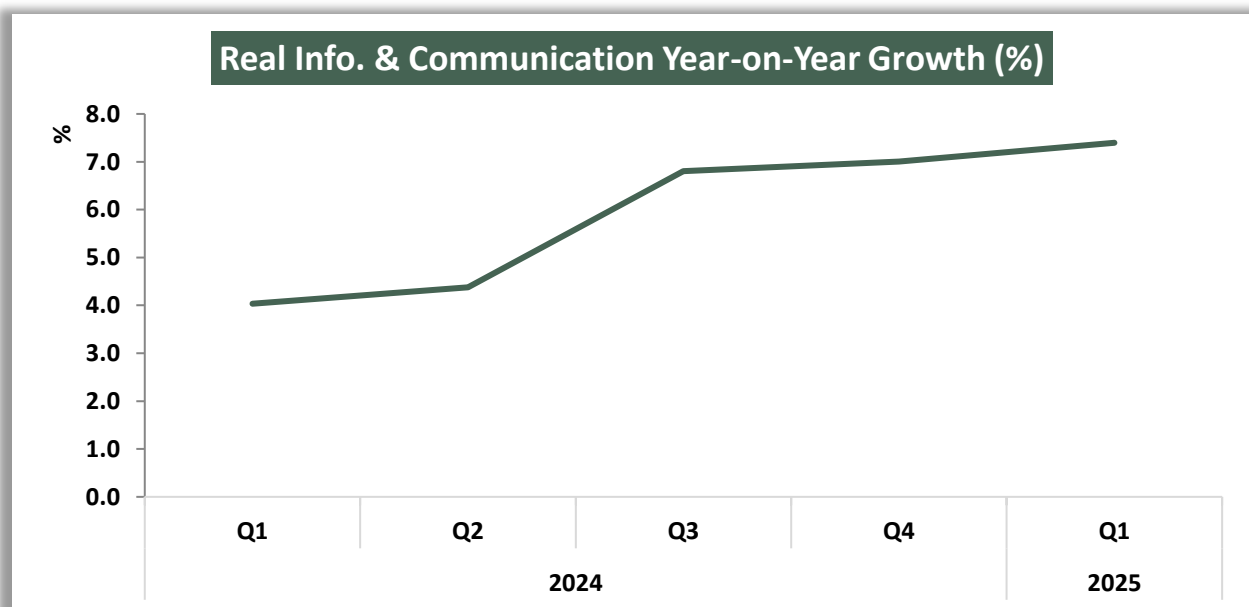


Figure 12: Information and Communication real growth rate

Arts, Entertainment and Recreation

In Nominal terms, the growth of Arts, Entertainment and Recreation sector was 1.32% in the first quarter of 2025 (year-on-year), representing a decrease of 5.89% points relative to the preceding quarter's growth rate of 7.21% and a decrease of 20.22% points compared with the year-earlier growth rate of 21.54%. On a quarterly basis, growth was recorded at 35.36%. The activity contributed 0.58% to the total nominal GDP in the first quarter of 2025. This contribution was lower than the 0.68% it contributed in Q1 of 2024 and higher than the 0.39% it contributed in Q4 of 2024.

In real terms, the activity grew by 9.63% year-on-year, which was lower than the rate recorded in Q1 2024 by 1.12% points, and higher by 2.46% points when compared with that of the preceding quarter. Quarter-on-quarter, growth stood at 31.62% in real terms. The activity of Art, Entertainment and Recreation contributed 0.47% to real GDP in Q1 2025, higher than the 0.44% recorded in the same quarter of 2024 and higher than the 0.29% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024.

Real Estate Services

In nominal terms, Real Estate Services in the first quarter of 2025 grew by 18.08%, lower by 91.96% points than the growth rate reported for the same period in 2024 and higher compared to the preceding Quarter. On a quarter-on-quarter, the sector growth rate was 80.09%. The contribution to nominal GDP in Q1 2025 stood at 17.46%, relative to 17.50% recorded in the first quarter of 2024 and 8.73% in the fourth quarter of 2024.

Real GDP growth recorded in the sector for the first quarter of 2025 stood at 4.61%, lower than the growth recorded in the first quarter of 2024 by 3.40% points, and lower by 0.67% points relative to Q4 2024. On a quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by -27.16% in the first quarter of 2025. It contributed 13.30% to real GDP in Q1 2025, higher than the 13.11% it recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024 and lower than the 14.66% contributed in the preceding quarter.

Finance and Insurance

The Finance and Insurance Sector consists of the two subsectors, Financial Institutions, and Insurance, in which the former accounted for 90.74% and the latter 9.26% of the sector respectively in real terms in Q1 2025.

The sector grew at 21.01% in nominal terms (year-on-year), with the growth rate of Financial Institutions at 22.82% and 5.74% growth rate recorded for Insurance. The overall rate was higher than Q1 2024 by 9.97% points, and lower by 6.43% points than the preceding quarter. The quarter-on-quarter growth was 2.41%. The sector's contribution to the nominal GDP was 3.07% in Q1 2025, higher than the 3.00% it represented a year previous, and higher than the contribution of 2.70% it made in the preceding quarter.

Growth in this sector in real terms totaled 15.03%, higher by 13.57% points from the rate recorded in the 2024 first quarter and higher by 9.04% points from the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Quarter-on-quarter growth in real terms stood at 17.50%. The contribution of Finance and Insurance to real GDP totalled 3.60%, higher than the contribution of 3.23% recorded in the first quarter of 2024 by 0.37% points, and higher than 2.46% recorded in Q4 2024 by 1.14% points.

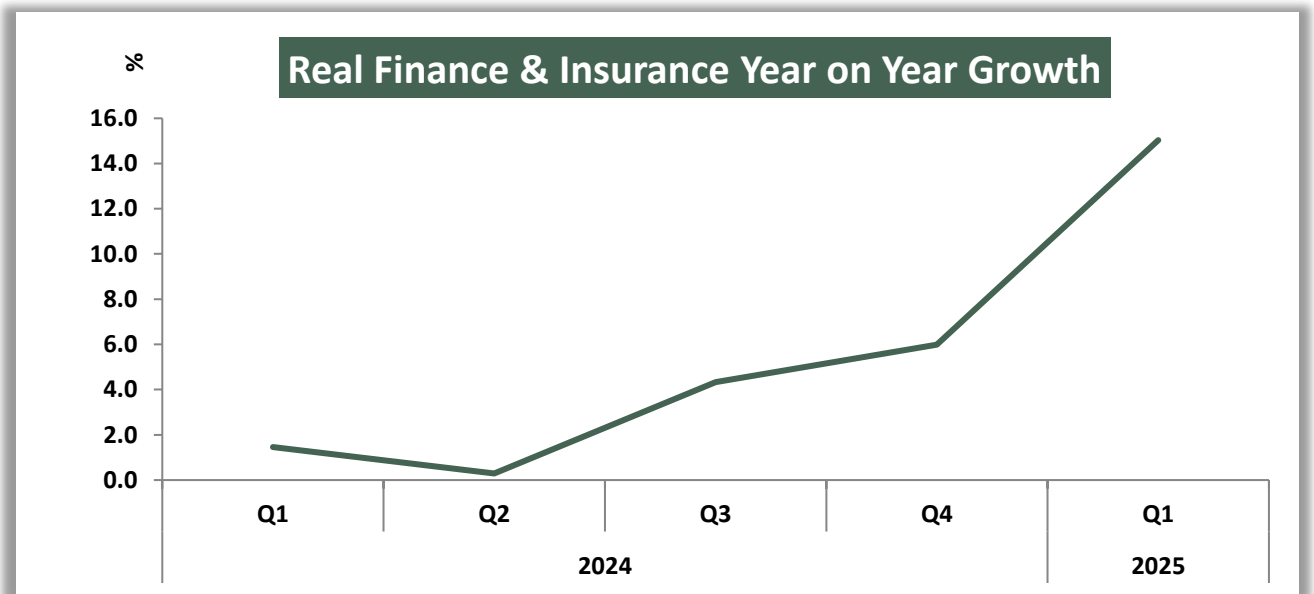


Figure 13: Finance and Insurance real growth

Professional, Scientific and Technical Services

In the first quarter of 2025, Professional, Scientific and Technical Services recorded a nominal growth of -8.43% (year-on-year), which is 17.31% points lower than Q1 2024, and 34.81% points lower than the rate recorded in Q4 2024. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by -40.93%. The contribution of Professional, Scientific and Technical Services to nominal GDP was 2.10% in Q1 2025, down from the 2.72% contribution in Q1 2024 and down from the 3.21% recorded in Q4 2024.

Real growth in the sector was recorded at 2.53% in Q1 2025, a decrease of 3.18% points relative to the rate recorded in the corresponding period of 2024, and 2.49% points lower than that of Q4 2024. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector grew by -19.23% in Q1 2025. Professional, Scientific and Technical Services contributed 2.47% to aggregate GDP in Q1 2025, lower than the contribution of 2.48% in Q1 2024 and higher than the 2.45% recorded in Q4 2024.

Administrative and Support Services

In nominal terms, the Administrative and Support Services sector grew by 30.96% (year-on-year) in Q1 2025, higher by 5.76% points compared to the first quarter of 2024 and lower by 21.49% points than the growth rate in the previous quarter. Quarter-on-quarter, the growth rate in the sector was -27.92% in Q1 2025. The contribution of Administrative and Support Services to nominal GDP was 1.08% in Q1 2025, higher with the 0.97% it contributed in the same period in 2024 and lower than the figure of 1.34% it contributed in the preceding quarter

In real terms, the sector recorded a growth rate of 2.92% (year-on-year), a decrease of 18.39% points from the corresponding quarter of 2024 and a fall of 13.79% points from the rate recorded in Q4 2024. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by -26.77% in Q1 2025. The sector's contribution to real GDP was 1.26% in the 2025 first quarter, relatively same with the corresponding quarter in 2024 and lower than the 2024 fourth quarter.

Public Administration

In nominal terms, the Public Administration sector grew by 7.26% in Q1 2025, lower by 1.06% points from the corresponding quarter of 2024 and lower by 17.28% points relative to Q4 2024. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by -44.70%. The contribution of Public Administration to Nominal GDP stood at 1.82% in Q1 2025, lower than the 2.01% recorded in Q1 2024 by 0.19% points and lower than the 2.97% recorded in Q4 2024 by 1.15% points.

In real terms, the sector recorded a growth rate of 1.83% (year-on-year) in Q1 2025, lower by 0.49% points and lower by 0.43% points from the Q1 2024 rate and the Q4 2024 rate respectively. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector grew by -35.56% in Q1 2025. The contribution of Public Administration to real GDP stood at 2.14% in Q1 2025, lower than the 2.17% recorded in Q1 2024 and lower than the 2.67% in Q4 2024.

Education

Nominal growth in the Education sector in the first quarter of 2025 was 39.05% (year-on-year), up by 25.72% points from the growth of 13.32% reported in the corresponding quarter of 2024, and up by 27.22% points when compared to Q4 2024 growth rate of 11.83%. The quarter-on-quarter growth rate was -2.90%. The contribution of Education to nominal GDP in Q1 2025 was 1.16%; up from 0.99% reported in Q1 2024 and up from 1.08% in Q4 2024.

Real growth in Education year-on-year stood at 2.47% in Q1 2025; an increase of 1.11% points from the corresponding quarter of 2024 which was estimated at 1.37%. When compared with the previous quarter's rate of 2.24%, the sector's growth increased by 0.24% points. The Sector contributed 0.78% to total real GDP in Q1 2025 which was relatively same with the 0.78% reported for the corresponding quarter in 2024 and lower than the 0.81% recorded in Q4 2024.

Human Health and Social Services

The year-on-year growth rate for Human Health and Social Services in nominal terms was 51.13%, up relative to the growth rate of 24.57% reported in the same quarter of 2024 by 26.56% points and up by 32.98% points compared to Q4 2024. Quarter-on-quarter growth was 23.10%. The contribution to nominal GDP was 2.03% in Q1 2025, higher than the 1.59% recorded in Q1 2024 and up from the 1.49% recorded in Q4 2024.

Real GDP growth of Human Health and Social Services for Q1 2025 stood at 1.76% (year-on-year) compared to 1.23% for the corresponding period of 2024 which shows an increase of 0.52% points. The growth in Q1 2025 was lower than the growth recorded in Q4 2024 by 2.49% points. Quarter-on-quarter, this sector grew by -10.48%. The contribution of Human Health and Social Services to real GDP was 1.64% in Q1 2025, lower than the figure recorded in Q1 2024 and higher than the 1.47% recorded in the preceding quarter.

Other Services

In nominal terms, Other Services grew by 33.69% (year-on-year) in Q1 2025. This growth rate was higher than the -5.04% growth rate recorded in the same quarter of the previous year and higher than the growth rate of 11.52% in Q4 2024 by 38.73% points and 22.17% points respectively. Quarter-on-quarter growth was -15.70%. This sector contributed 1.59% to the aggregate nominal GDP in Q1 2025, higher than the 1.41% it contributed in the same period of the previous year and lower than the 1.70% it contributed in the preceding quarter.

Other Services' real GDP grew by -6.13% (year-on-year) in Q1 2025. This growth was higher by 6.79% points than the growth recorded in the same period of the previous year, and lower by 12.76% points from Q4 2024. Quarter-on-quarter growth was -40.12%. The sector contributed 1.28% to real GDP in Q1 2025, lower than the 1.40% recorded for the corresponding quarter of 2024 and lower than the 1.71% recorded in Q4 2024.
