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Preface

This publication provides data on Quarterly Gross Domestic Product (GDP) estimates for the four quarters and the annual figures for 2024 as well as the four quarters and annual figures for 2025. The figures presented in the report are newly obtained quarterly estimates, benchmarked to the annual rebased estimates. This technique allows for national accounts quarterly time series data on the rebased estimates.

Quarterly National Accounts (QNA) are integrated systems of macroeconomic accounts designed to describe the entire system of production in a nation quarterly. They provide a picture of the current status of the economy that is timely and more frequent than that provided by the Annual National Accounts (ANA). The key attribute of QNA is that they provide a reasonable level of detail on the economy that helps the government to assess, analyse, and monitor economic growth regularly.

QNA adopts the same concepts, definitions, and structure as ANA. In principle, QNA covers the entire sequence of accounts and balance sheets as reflected in the 2008 System of National Accounts (2008 SNA).

The data for Q4 2025 were obtained from the Quarterly Establishment Survey (QES) conducted by the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS). This series covers major aggregates of quarterly GDP by kind of economic activities at current and constant (2019) prices.

We are grateful to the various agencies and establishments that made their data available as input to the estimates.

Introduction

The National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) has been conducting Establishment Surveys to provide data for the estimation of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for the country. In 2008, NBS started to improve the GDP series by conducting Quarterly Establishment Surveys (QES) for the four quarters of each year to provide timely estimates for decisions and policymaking.

In 2018, the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) conducted the Quarterly Establishment Surveys for the first three quarters of 2018 (Q1-Q3/ 2018), while the fourth quarter survey for 2018 was conducted in the first quarter of 2019. This compilation procedure is carried out to date, publishing the Q4 GDP report within the first quarter of the new accounting year. It is important to note that the Bureau maintains a publication date of 45 days after the quarter.

In subsequent sections of this report, emphasis will be given to the composition of GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025, the corresponding quarter of 2024, and the immediate past quarter of 2025 (Q3 2025). In addition, the annual figures of 2025 compared to 2024 are highlighted in this report.



Overview of GDP in Quarter Four 2025

Following the rebasing of the Gross Domestic Product using 2019 as the base year, previous quarterly GDP estimates were benchmarked to the rebased annual estimates to align the old series with the new rebased estimates. This procedure provided a new quarterly GDP series, which is compared to the 2025 fourth quarter estimates. Gross Domestic Product (GDP) grew by 4.07% (year-on-year) in real terms in the fourth quarter of 2025. This growth rate is higher than the 3.76% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024. During the quarter under review, agriculture grew by 4.00%, an improvement from the 2.54% recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024. The growth of the industry sector stood at 3.88% from 2.49% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024, while the services sector recorded a growth of 4.15% from 4.75% in the same quarter of 2024. In terms of share of the GDP, the services sector contributed more to the aggregate GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025 at 55.92% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2024 at 55.87%. On an annual basis, the growth rate in 2025 stood at 3.87% from 3.38% in 2024.

In the quarter under review, aggregate GDP at basic price stood at N122,810,658.96 million in nominal terms. This performance is higher when compared to the fourth quarter of 2024, which recorded an aggregate GDP of N104,478,934.86 million, indicating a year-on-year nominal growth of 17.55%. For better clarity, the Nigerian economy has been classified broadly into the oil and non-oil sectors (Pages 5 & 6).

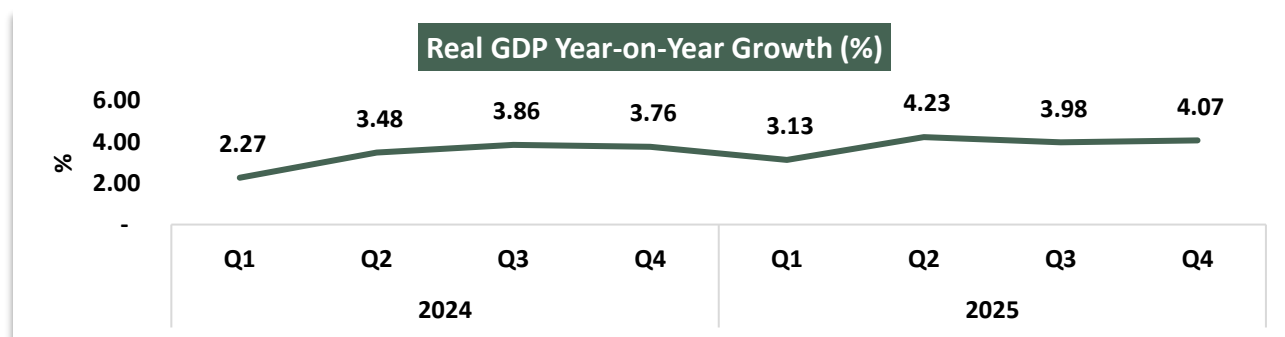


Figure 1: Real GDP Growth

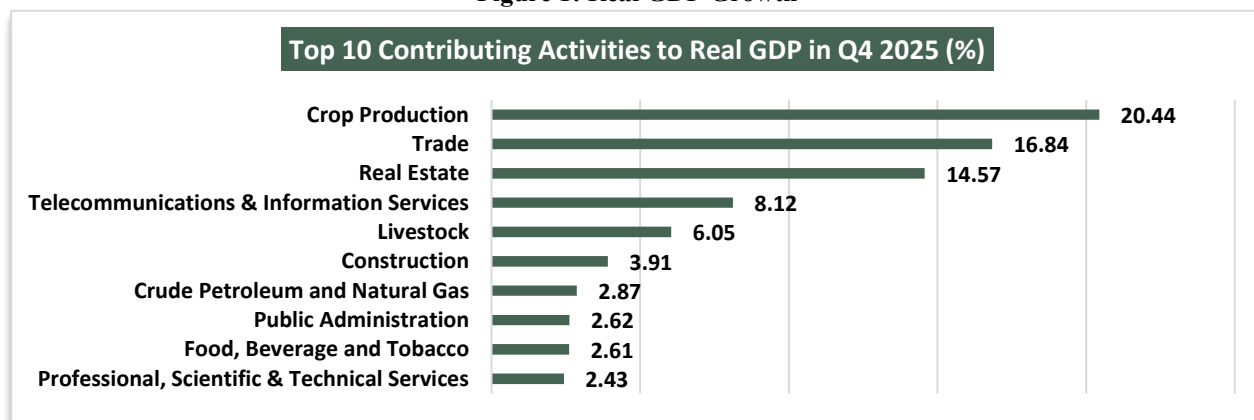


Figure 2: Top 10 Contributing Activities to Real GDP in Q4 2025

The Oil Sector

The nation in the fourth quarter of 2025 recorded an average daily oil production of 1.58 million barrels per day (mbpd), higher than the daily average production of 1.54 mbpd recorded in the same quarter of 2024 by 0.04 mbpd and lower than the third quarter of 2025 production volume of 1.64 mbpd by 0.06 mbpd. 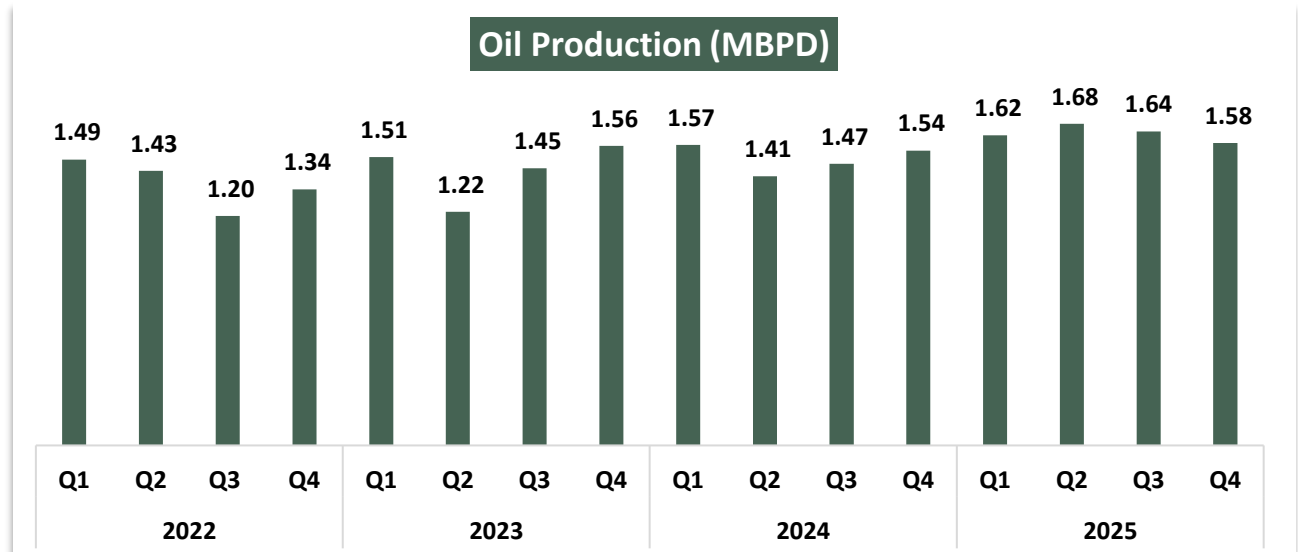


Figure 3: Crude Oil Output (MBPD)

The real growth of the oil sector was 6.79 (year-on-year) in Q4 2025, indicating an increase of 4.71% points relative to the rate recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024 (2.08%). Growth increased by 0.95% points when compared to Q3 2025, which was 5.84%. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the oil sector recorded a growth rate of -6.30% in Q4 2025. The annual growth rate of oil stood at 8.50%, higher than the 5.54% recorded in 2024. The Oil sector contributed 2.87% to the total real GDP in Q4 2025, up from the figure recorded in the corresponding period of 2024 at 2.80%. and down from the preceding quarter, where it contributed 3.44%. Overall, it contributed 3.53% in 2025, higher than its contribution of 3.38% in 2024.

The Non-Oil Sector

The non-oil sector grew by 3.99% in real terms during the reference quarter (Q4 2025). This rate was higher by 0.19% points compared to the rate recorded in the same quarter of 2024, which was 3.80%, and higher than the 3.91% recorded in the third quarter of 2025. This sector was driven in the fourth quarter of 2025 mainly by Agriculture (Crop production); Information and Communication (Telecommunications); Real Estate; Trade; Financial & Insurance (Financial Institutions); Construction; Transportation and Storage (Road Transport), and Manufacturing (Food, Beverage & Tobacco), accounting for positive GDP growth.

In real terms, the non-oil sector contributed 97.13% to the nation's GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025, lower than the share recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024, which was 97.20%, and higher than the third quarter of 2025, recorded as 96.56%. On aggregate, 96.47% was contributed in 2025, lower than the 96.62% reported in 2024.

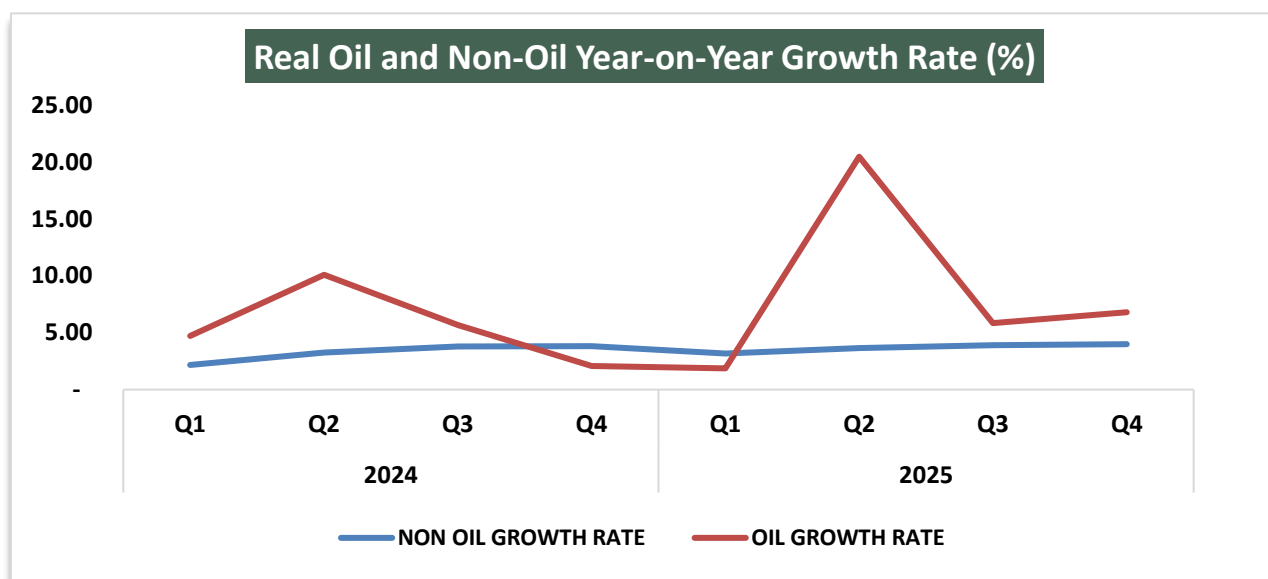
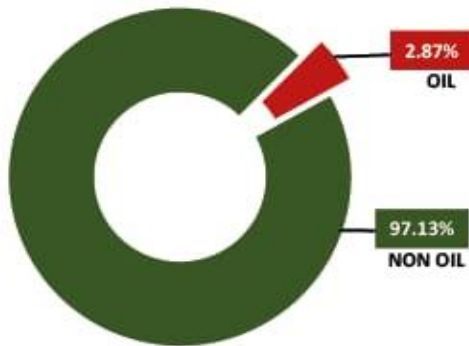


Figure 4: Crude Oil and Non-Oil Growth

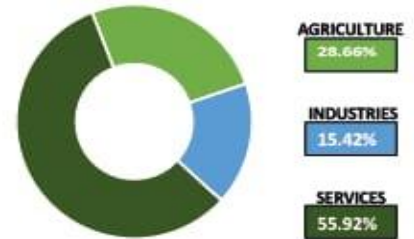

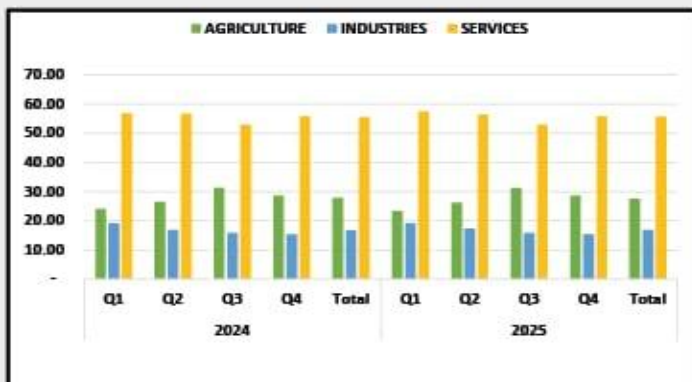
OIL PRODUCTION (MBPD)

Major Economic Sectors: Q4 2025

Mining & Quarrying

The Mining & Quarrying sector consists of Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas, Coal Mining, Metal ores and Quarrying, and Other Minerals sub-activities. This sector grew nominally by -28.02% (year-on-year) in Q4 2025. Metal Ores activity exhibited the highest growth rate of all the sub-activities at 38.82%, followed by Coal Mining at 26.08%. Crude Petroleum and Natural gas was the main contributor to the sector with a weight of 85.23% in Q4 2025. Comparing Q4 2025's rate of growth relative to Q4 2024 and Q3 2025 growth rates, there was a decrease of 87.51% points and an increase of 13.05% points, respectively. The annual growth of the sector stood at -19.44% in 2025, lower than 11.23% recorded in 2024. The Mining & Quarrying sector contributed 2.15% to the overall GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025, lower than the contributions recorded in the 2024 fourth quarter at 3.50% and lower than the previous quarter at 2.37%. The contribution of the sector in 2025 was 2.89%, relative to 4.24% in 2024.

In real terms, the Mining and Quarrying sector grew by 8.90% (year-on-year) in the fourth quarter of 2025. Compared to the same quarter of 2024 and the third quarter of 2025, it was higher by 5.75% points and 1.88% points, respectively. Quarter-on-quarter, the growth rate was -0.45% in Q4 2025. Overall, the sector grew by 9.67% in 2025 relative to 5.24% in 2024. The contribution of Mining and Quarrying to Real GDP in the quarter under review stood at 3.16%, higher than the rate of 3.02% recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024 and lower than the 3.57 recorded in the third quarter of 2025. In total, the sector contributed 3.75% to aggregate GDP in 2025, up from 3.55% in 2024.

Agriculture

Four sub-activities make up the Agricultural sector: Crop Production, Livestock, Forestry, and Fishing. The sector grew by 6.82% year-on-year in nominal terms in Q4 2025, showing a decrease of 2.01% points from the same quarter of 2024. Looking at the preceding quarter's growth rate of 3.18%, there was an increase of 3.63% points. Crop production remained the major driver of the sector. This is evident as it accounts for 64.75% of the overall nominal value of the sector in the fourth quarter of 2025.

Quarter-on-quarter growth stood at 3.36% in the fourth quarter of 2025. Agriculture contributed 25.67% to nominal GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025. This figure was lower than the rate recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024 and lower than the third quarter of 2025, which recorded 28.25% and 26.85%, respectively. Overall, the sector contributed 23.53% to the aggregate GDP in 2025.

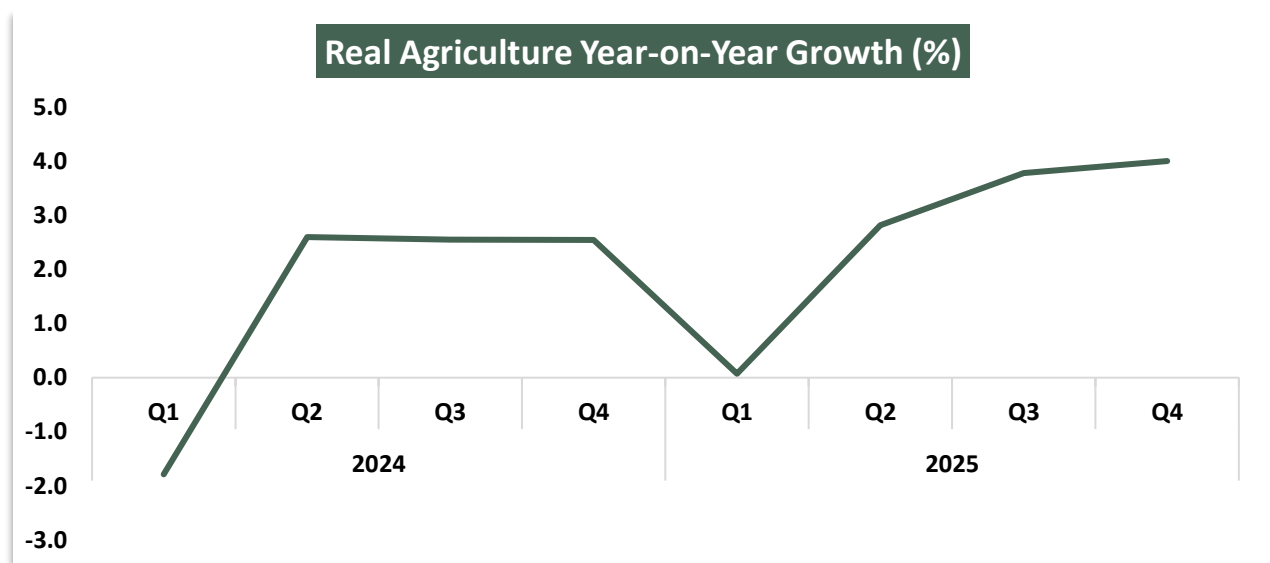


Figure 6: Agriculture real growth

The agricultural sector in the fourth quarter of 2025 grew by 4.00% (year-on-year) in real terms, an increase of 1.46% points from the corresponding period of 2024, and an increase of 0.22% points from the preceding quarter, which recorded a growth rate of 3.79%. It grew on a quarter-on-quarter basis at 2.98%. Overall, the annual growth of the sector stood at 2.92% in 2025 compared to 1.69% in 2024.

However, the sector contributed 28.66% to aggregate GDP in real terms in Q4 2025, lower than the contribution in the fourth quarter of 2024 and lower than the contribution in the third quarter of 2025, which stood at 28.68% and 31.21%, respectively. The overall contribution in 2025 was 27.55% from 27.81% in 2024.

Manufacturing

The Manufacturing sector is comprised of thirteen activities: Oil Refining; Cement; Food, Beverages and Tobacco; Textile, Apparel, and Footwear; Wood and Wood products; Pulp Paper and Paper products; Chemical and Pharmaceutical products; Non-metallic Products, Plastic and Rubber products; Electrical and Electronic; Basic Metal and Iron and Steel; Motor Vehicles and Assembly; and Other Manufacturing.

Nominal GDP growth of the Manufacturing sector in the fourth quarter of 2025 was 5.80% (year-on-year), a 7.35% points lower than the figure recorded in the corresponding period of 2024 (13.14%) and 2.35% points higher than the preceding quarter figure of 3.45%. Quarter-on- quarter, growth of the sector was recorded at 11.82% during the quarter. Overall, the manufacturing sector grew by 12.96% in 2025 relative to 10.84% in 2024. The contribution of Manufacturing to Nominal GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025 was 8.34%, lower than the figure recorded in the corresponding period of 2024 at 9.27% and higher than the third quarter of 2025 at 8.06%. In 2025, the sector contributed 8.46% compared to 8.85% recorded in 2024.

Real GDP growth in the manufacturing sector in the fourth quarter of 2025 was 1.13% (year-on-year), lower than the same quarter of 2024 and lower than the preceding quarter by 0.15% points and 0.13% points, respectively. The growth rate of the sector on a quarter-on-quarter basis stood at 9.01%. Overall, the sector grew by 1.41% in 2025, higher than the 1.20% recorded in 2024. The Real contribution to GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025 was 7.40%, lower than the 7.62% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024 and the third quarter of 2025. In total, the sector contributed 8.05% in 2025, lower than the 8.24% contributed in 2024.

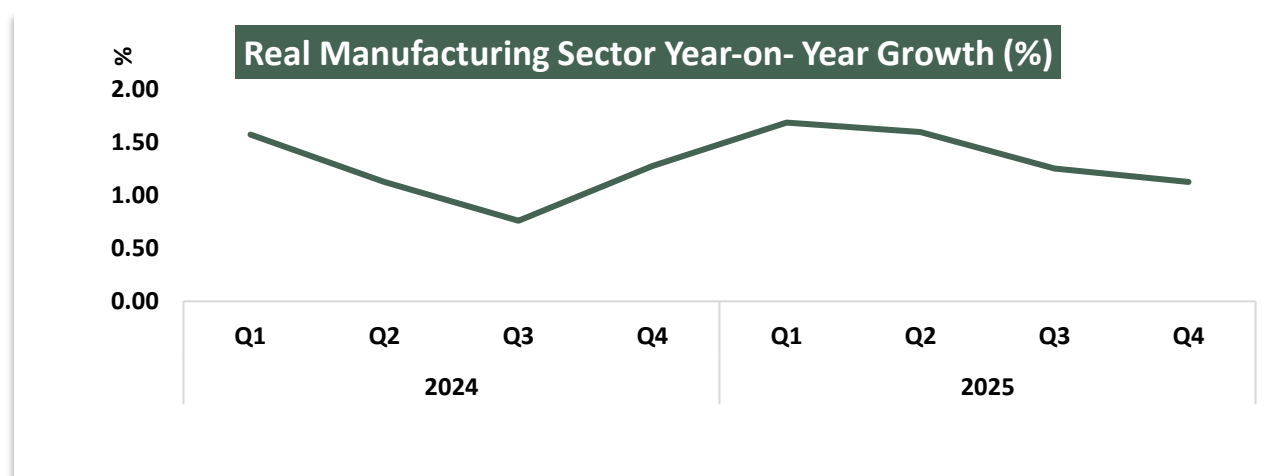


Figure 7: Manufacturing real growth

Electricity, Gas, Steam, and Air Conditioning Supply

The Electricity, Gas, Steam, and Air conditioning Supply sector recorded a year-on-year growth of 8.80% in the fourth quarter of 2025. This was 3.18% points higher than the 5.62% growth rate recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024, and 2.25% points lower than the growth rate of 11.05% recorded in the quarter before. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector recorded a growth rate of 49.04% in Q4 2025. Overall, 12.16% growth rate was recorded in 2025, lower than the 13.41% recorded in 2024. The contribution of Electricity, Gas, Steam, and Air Conditioning Supply to Nominal GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025 was 0.87%, lower than the contribution in the corresponding quarter of 2024 at 0.94% and higher than its contribution of 0.63% in the quarter before. In total, the contribution of the sector in 2025 was 0.79%, lower than the 0.83% recorded in 2024.

In real terms, the sector grew by 4.26% in Q4 2025, an increase from the growth rate of -7.97% recorded in the same quarter of 2024. When compared to the immediate past quarter, there was a decrease of 0.32% points from 4.58% recorded. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector grew at 48.08%. The overall growth of 2025 stood at 8.45%, higher than the 0.56% recorded in 2024. The contribution of this sector to real GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025 was 0.76%, relatively the same as the 0.76% recorded in Q4 2024 and higher than the 0.58% recorded in Q3 2025. Overall, the contribution of the sector was 0.73% in 2025 relative to 0.70% in 2024.

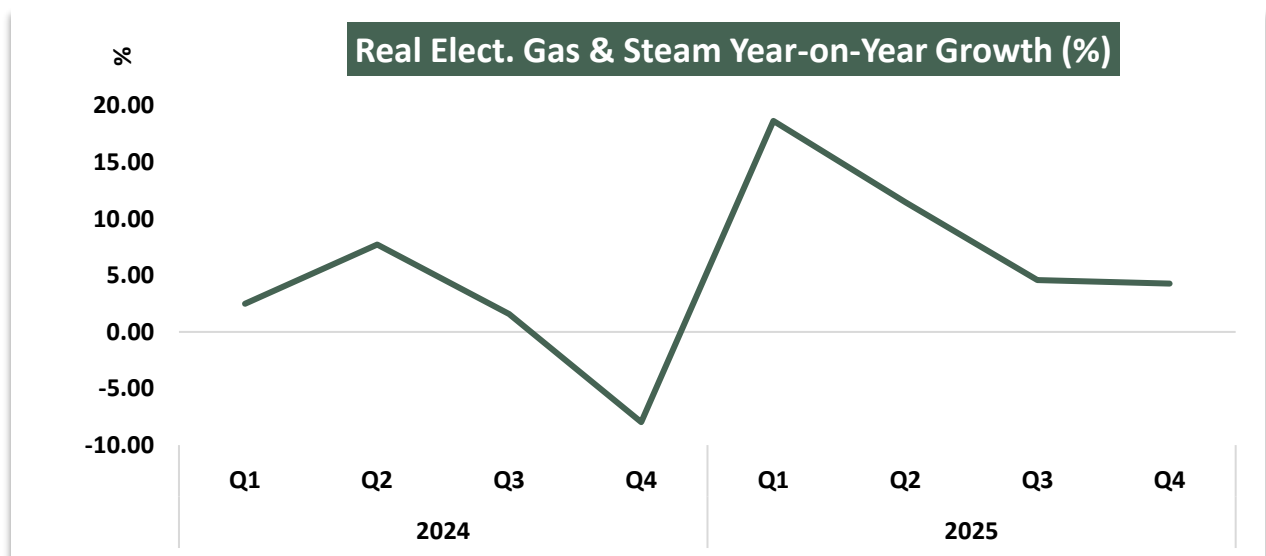


Figure 8: Electricity, Gas and Steam real growth

Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management, and Remediation

This sector grew by 17.31% in nominal terms (year-on-year) in the fourth quarter of 2025, a decrease of 11.26 percentage points compared to the rate of 28.58% recorded in the same quarter of 2024. There was a decrease of 0.53 percentage points when compared to the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Nominal growth quarter-on-quarter was recorded at -5.16%. Overall, the sector grew by 19.62% in 2025 relative to 29.89% in 2024. The Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management, and Remediation sector contributed 0.15% to nominal GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025, relatively the same as the 0.15% it contributed a year earlier and lower than the 0.17% contributed in the third quarter of 2025. In total, the sector contributed 0.22% in 2025 compared to 0.21% in 2024.

The real growth rate of the Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management, and Remediation sector in the fourth quarter of 2025 was 9.21% (year-on-year), lower by 0.30 percentage points from the rate recorded in the previous year. Relative to the preceding quarter, there was a decrease of 1.04 percentage points. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by -5.99% in real terms. In total, 10.01% growth was recorded in 2025 from 8.60% in 2024.

Its contribution to total real GDP was 0.18% in the fourth quarter of 2025, higher than its contribution of 0.17% in the same quarter of the previous year, and lower than the immediate past quarter, where it contributed 0.21%. In total, 2025 recorded a contribution of 0.26% to aggregate GDP from 0.25% in 2024.

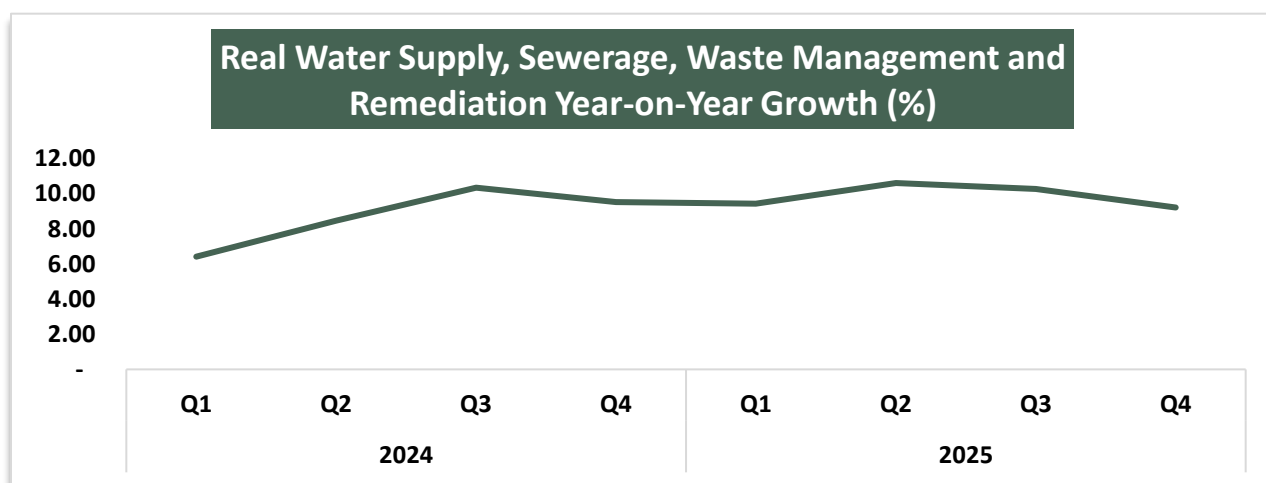


Figure 9: Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management, and Remediation real growth

Construction

The Construction sector grew by 19.94% in nominal terms (year-on-year) in the 2025 fourth quarter, a decrease of 1.96% points compared to the rate of 21.90% recorded in the same quarter of 2024. Also, there was a decrease of 1.29% points when compared to the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Nominal growth quarter-on-quarter was recorded at 16.36%. Overall, the sector grew by 18.80% in 2025 relative to 18.24% in 2024. Construction contributed 4.50% to nominal GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025, higher than the 4.41% it contributed a year earlier and higher than the 4.18% contributed to the third quarter of 2025. In total, 4.49% was contributed in 2025 relative to 4.47% in 2024.

The real growth rate of the construction sector in the fourth quarter of 2025 was recorded at 5.08% (year-on-year), lower by 1.43% points from the rate recorded in the previous year. Relative to the preceding quarter, there was a decrease of 0.49% points. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by 15.62% in real terms. Overall, the growth of the sector in 2025 stood at 5.53%, higher than 4.16% in 2024 in real terms.

Its contribution to total real GDP was 3.91% in the fourth quarter of 2025; higher than its contribution of 3.88% in the same quarter of the previous year, and higher than in the immediate past quarter, where it contributed 3.80%. The annual contribution of the sector stood at 4.00% in 2025 from 3.93% in 2024.

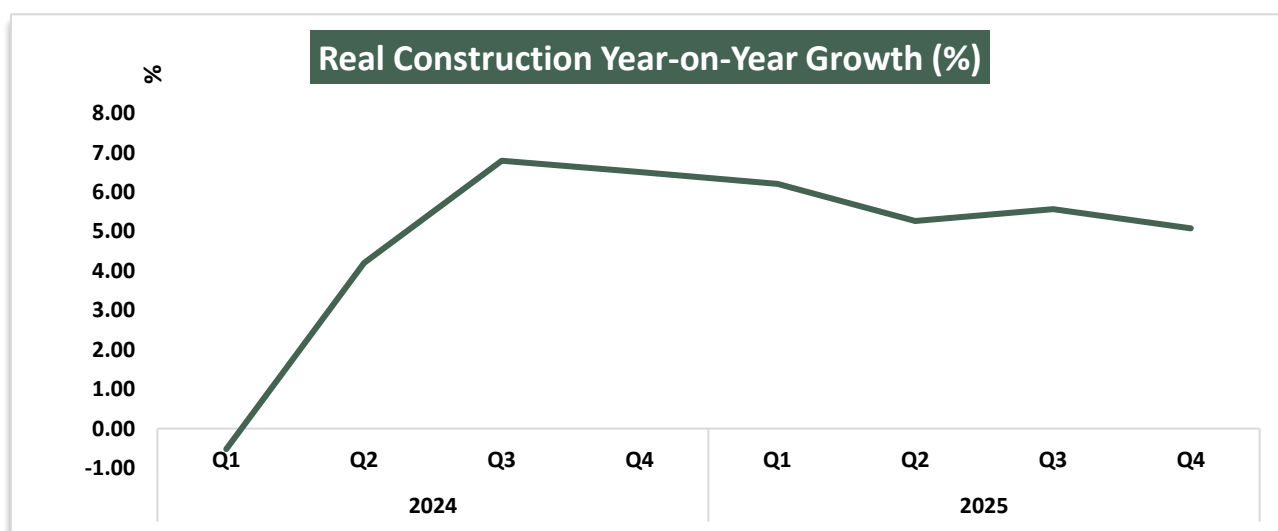


Figure 10: Construction real growth

Trade

In the fourth quarter of 2025, the nominal year-on-year growth rate of Trade stood at 17.05%. This indicates a decrease of 10.75 percentage points when compared to the fourth quarter of 2024 growth rate of 27.80% and 2.22 percentage points lower than the previous quarter's growth rate of 19.27%. The quarter-on-quarter growth rate was 19.93%. In 2025, growth stood at 23.18% relative to 23.00% recorded in 2024. Trade's contribution to Nominal GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025 was 19.10%, lower than the contribution in the same quarter of the previous year of 19.19%, and higher than the preceding quarter recorded at 17.22%. Overall, the sector contributed 19.42% in 2025 relative to 18.64% in 2024.

In real terms, Trade's year-on-year growth stood at 2.00% in the fourth quarter of 2025, which was 0.04 percentage points lower than the rate recorded in the previous year at 2.04%, and 0.02 percentage points higher than in the preceding quarter at 1.98% growth rate. Quarter-on-quarter growth stood at 15.01%. Overall, the growth of the sector was 1.77% in 2025, lower than the 1.97% recorded in 2024. Trade's contribution to GDP was 16.84%, lower than the 17.18% it represented in the previous year, and higher than the 16.42% recorded in the third quarter of 2025. The sector contributed 17.37% in 2025, lower than the 17.73% it contributed in 2024.

Accommodation and Food Services

In nominal terms, Accommodation and Food Services grew by 36.80% year-on-year in the 2025 fourth quarter. This represents an increase of 14.43% points relative to the same quarter of 2024, when the growth rate was 22.37%. Growth was lower than in the preceding quarter by 5.40% points when growth was 42.20%. Quarter-on-quarter, growth stood at 22.77%. Overall, growth was 40.87% in 2025, higher than the 16.35% recorded in 2024. Accommodation and Food Services' contribution to nominal GDP stood at 0.97% in the fourth quarter of 2025, higher than the figure recorded in the previous year and higher than the third quarter of 2025 contribution recorded at 0.83% and 0.86%, respectively. In total, the 2025 contribution stood at 0.85%, higher than 0.71% recorded in 2024.

The real year-on-year growth rate for this sector in the fourth quarter of 2025 stood at 4.22%, lower by 0.28% points from 4.50% recorded in the previous year. Relative to the preceding quarter, the growth rate was 0.15% points lower than the 4.37% recorded. Quarter-on-quarter, real growth was 22.25%. The growth rate of the sector was 3.55% in 2025, lower than the 3.72% recorded in 2024. The sector in the fourth quarter of 2025 represented 0.59% of the real GDP, which was relatively the same as the contribution of 0.59% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024 and higher than the third quarter of 2025 contribution of 0.54%. Overall, the contribution of the sector stood at 0.55% in 2025, relatively the same as the 0.55% recorded in 2024.

Transportation and Storage

Six activities make up the Transportation and Storage sector: Road Transport; Rail Transport and Pipelines; Water Transport; Air Transport; Transport Services; and Post and Courier Services.

The sector grew by 39.62% in nominal terms in the fourth quarter of 2025 (year-on-year). This rate was higher relative to the 38.48% recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024 and higher than 24.35% in the previous quarter. The whole six sub-activities under the Transport and Storage industry recorded positive growth rates in the fourth quarter of 2025. Quarter-on-quarter growth stood at 73.78%. Overall, the growth rate in 2025 was 35.23% relative to 32.22% in 2024. Transport activities contributed 1.55% to Nominal GDP in Q4 2025, an increase from the 1.30% recorded in the corresponding period of 2024, and higher than the 0.96% recorded in the third quarter of 2025. The contribution of the sector in 2025 stood at 1.19% relative to 1.04% in 2024.

In real terms, the Transportation and Storage sector grew by 21.25% in Q4 2025. This rate represents an increase of 8.05% points compared to the same quarter of the previous year and an increase of 11.39% points relative to the preceding quarter. Quarter-on-quarter, growth was 65.81%. Overall, growth was 16.92% in 2025, higher than 7.92% in 2024. The contribution of the sector to real GDP in Q4 of 2025 was 1.02%, higher than the 0.87% recorded in the preceding year and higher than 0.69% recorded in the third quarter of 2025. In total, 0.84% was contributed in 2025, higher than the 0.75% recorded in 2024.

Information & Communication

The Information and Communication sector is composed of the four activities of Telecommunications and Information Services; Publishing; Motion Picture, Sound Recording and Music Production; and Broadcasting.

In nominal terms, in the fourth quarter of 2025, the sector growth was recorded at 26.34% (year-on-year), 8.37% points increase from the rate of 17.97% recorded in the same quarter of 2024, and 5.46% points higher than the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. The quarter-on-quarter growth rate in the fourth quarter of 2025 was 19.58%. Overall, the growth of the sector was 24.96% in 2025 relative to 12.68% in 2024. The Information and Communications sector contributed 9.19% to the total Nominal GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025, higher than the rate of 8.55% recorded in the same quarter of 2024 and higher than the 8.31% it contributed in the preceding quarter. In total, the sector contributed 9.39% in 2025, up from 8.88% in 2024.

The sector in the fourth quarter of 2025 recorded a growth rate of 7.55% in real terms, year-on-year. From the rate recorded in the corresponding period of 2024, there was an increase of 0.55% points. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector exhibited a growth of 18.75% in real terms. Overall, the sector grew by 6.85% in 2025, higher than the 5.57% recorded in 2024. Of total real GDP, the sector contributed 9.64% in the fourth quarter of 2025, higher than in the same quarter of the previous year, in which it represented 9.32%, and higher than the preceding quarter, in which it represented 9.10%. The annual contribution of 10.07% was recorded in 2025 from 9.79% in 2024.

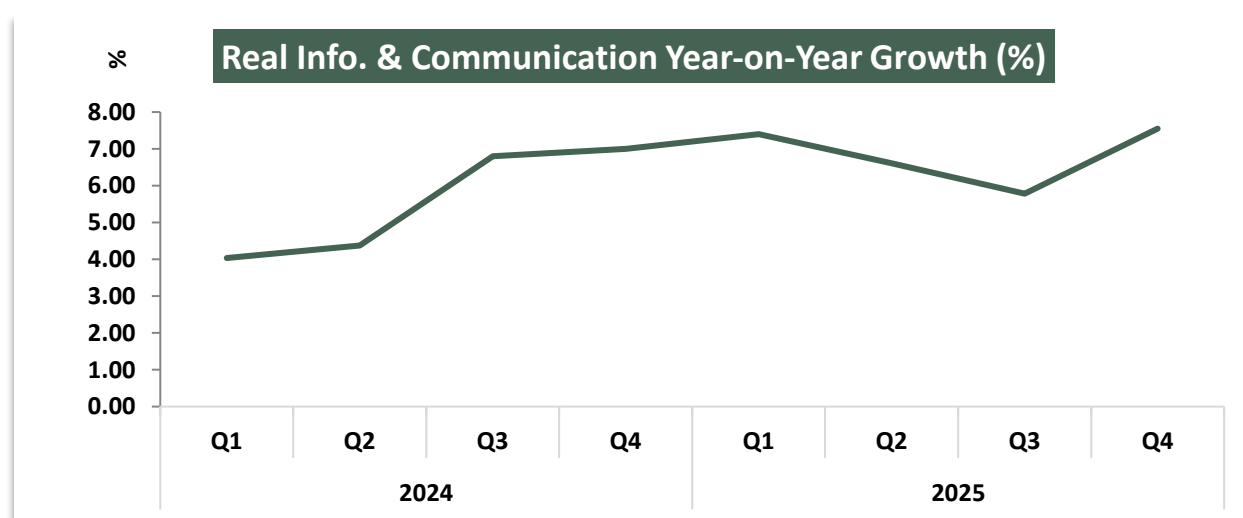


Figure 12: Information and Communication real growth rate

Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation

In Nominal terms, the growth of the Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation sector was 32.04% in the fourth quarter of 2025 (year-on-year), representing an increase of 29.36% points relative to the preceding quarter's growth rate of 2.68% and an increase of 24.83% points compared with the growth rate a year-earlier at 7.21%. On a quarterly basis, growth was recorded at 16.66%. Overall, growth stood at 9.51% in 2025, lower than the 22.20% recorded in 2024. The activity contributed 0.44% to the total nominal GDP in the fourth quarter of 2025. This contribution was higher than the 0.39% it contributed in Q4 of 2024 and higher than the 0.40% it contributed in Q3 of 2025. In total, the sector contributed 0.45% to aggregate GDP in 2025, lower than the 0.49% contribution in 2024.

In real terms, the activity grew by 9.30% year-on-year, which was higher than the rate recorded in Q4 2024 by 2.13% points, and higher by 0.17% points when compared with that of the preceding quarter. Quarter-on-quarter, growth stood at 16.17% in real terms. Overall, growth stood at 9.02% in 2025 as against 8.83% in 2024. The activity of Art, Entertainment, and Recreation contributed 0.30% to real GDP in Q4 2025, higher than the 0.29% recorded in the same quarter of 2024 and the third quarter of 2025. In total, 0.33% was contributed in 2025, higher than the contribution of 0.32% in 2024.

Real Estate Services

In nominal terms, Real Estate Services in the fourth quarter of 2025 grew by 57.44%, higher by 60.37% points than the growth rate reported for the same period in 2024 and lower compared to the preceding Quarter. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector growth rate was -21.30%. Overall, the sector grew by 40.93% in 2025 relative to 34.34% in 2024. The contribution to nominal GDP in Q4 2025 stood at 11.69%, relative to 8.73% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024 and 16.06% in the third quarter of 2025. In total, the sector contributed 13.49% in 2025, higher than the 11.32% contributed in 2024.

Real GDP growth recorded in the sector for the fourth quarter of 2025 stood at 3.43%, lower than the growth recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024 by 1.85% points, and lower by 0.06% points relative to Q3 2025. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector grew by 22.35% in the fourth quarter of 2025. Overall, the sector grew by 3.78% in 2025 compared to 6.59% in 2024. It contributed 14.57% to real GDP in Q4 2025, lower than the 14.66% it recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024 and higher than the 13.36% contributed in the preceding quarter. In total, 13.57% was contributed in 2025 relative to 13.58% in 2024.

Finance and Insurance

The Finance and Insurance Sector consists of the two subsectors, Financial Institutions, and Insurance, in which the former accounted for 90.43% and the latter 9.57% of the sector, respectively in real terms in Q4 2025.

The sector grew at 26.58% in nominal terms (year-on-year), with the growth rate of Financial Institutions at 26.15% and 30.83% growth rate recorded for Insurance. The overall rate was lower than Q4 2024 by 0.86% points, and lower by 13.97% points than the preceding quarter. The quarter-on-quarter growth was 13.00%. Overall, growth in 2025 stood at 38.51%, higher than the 22.82% recorded in 2024. The sector's contribution to the nominal GDP was 2.91% in Q4 2025, higher than the 2.70% it represented a year previous, and higher than the contribution of 2.78% it made in the preceding quarter. In total, a contribution of 3.30% was recorded in 2025 relative to 2.82% in 2024.

Growth in this sector in real terms totaled 8.30%, higher by 2.31% points from the rate recorded in the 2024 fourth quarter and lower by 11.33% points from the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Quarter-on-quarter, growth in real terms stood at 8.37%. Overall, growth stood at 14.54%, higher than the 2.95% recorded in 2024. The contribution of Finance and Insurance to real GDP totalled 2.56%, higher than the contribution of 2.46% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024 by 0.10% points, and lower than 2.65% recorded in Q3 2025 by 0.09% points. In total, 2.97% was contributed in 2025, higher than 2.69% in 2024.

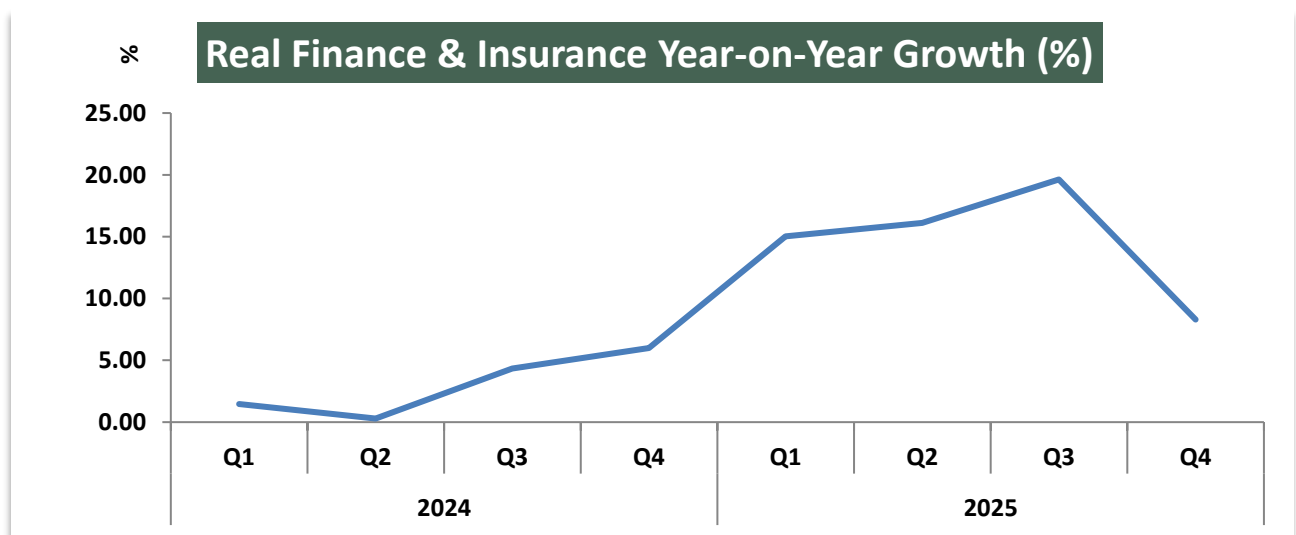


Figure 13: Finance and Insurance real growth

Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services

In the fourth quarter of 2025, Professional, Scientific and Technical Services recorded a nominal growth of 1.26% (year-on-year), which is 25.12% points lower than Q4 2024, and 1.05% points lower than the rate recorded in Q3 2025. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by 20.34%. Overall, growth stood at 4.69% in 2025, lower than 22.20% in 2024. The contribution of Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services to nominal GDP was 2.76% in Q4 2025, down from the 3.21% contribution in Q4 2024 and up from the 2.48% recorded in Q3 2025. In total, the sector contributed 2.64% in 2025 relative to 2.99% in 2024.

Real growth in the sector was recorded at 3.23% in Q4 2025, a decrease of 1.79% points relative to the rate recorded in the corresponding period of 2024, and 0.36% points higher than that of Q3 2025. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector grew by 15.41% in Q4 2025. Overall, growth in real terms stood at 2.77% in 2025, relative to the 5.55% recorded in 2024. Professional, Scientific and Technical Services contributed 2.43% to aggregate GDP in Q4 2025, lower than the contribution of 2.45% in Q4 2024 and higher than the 2.37% recorded in Q3 2025. In total, 2.38% was contributed in 2025, lower than the 2.41% recorded in 2024.

Administrative and Support Services

In nominal terms, the Administrative and Support Services sector grew by 37.93% (year-on-year) in Q4 2025, lower by 14.53% points compared to the fourth quarter of 2024 and lower by 3.91% points than the growth rate in the previous quarter. Quarter-on-quarter, the growth rate in the sector was -2.65% in Q4 2025. Overall, the sector grew by 46.45% in 2025, relative to 48.80% in 2024. The contribution of Administrative and Support Services to nominal GDP was 1.58% in Q4 2025, higher than the 1.34% it contributed in the same period in 2024 and lower than the 1.75% it contributed in the preceding quarter. In total, 1.63% was contributed in 2025, higher than the 1.32% recorded in 2024.

In real terms, the sector recorded a growth rate of 4.49% (year-on-year), a decrease of 12.22% points from the corresponding quarter of 2024 and a decrease of 0.15% points from the rate recorded in Q3 2025. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by -6.64% in Q4 2025. Overall, the real growth of the sector in 2025 was 3.89%, lower than the 21.07% recorded in 2024. The sector's contribution to real GDP was 1.39% in the 2025 fourth quarter, higher than the corresponding quarter in 2024 and lower than the 2025 third quarter. The annual contribution of 1.45% was recorded in 2025.

Public Administration

In nominal terms, the Public Administration sector grew by 17.58% in Q4 2025, lower by 6.97% points from the corresponding quarter of 2024 and lower by 1.68% points relative to Q3 2025. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by 19.56%. Overall, the sector grew by 23.37% in 2025, higher than the 21.59% recorded in 2024. The contribution of Public Administration to Nominal GDP stood at 2.97% in Q4 2025, relatively the same with the 2.97% recorded in Q4 2024 and higher than the 2.69% recorded in Q3 2025. The annual contribution of the sector stood at 2.86% in 2025, from 2.74% recorded in 2024.

In real terms, the sector recorded a growth rate of 2.17% (year-on-year) in Q4 2025, lower by 0.08% points and higher by 0.05% points from the Q4 2024 rate and the Q3 2025 rate, respectively. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector grew by 14.66% in Q4 2025. The annual growth of the sector in 2025 stood at 2.00%, lower than the 2.29% recorded in 2024. The contribution of Public Administration to real GDP stood at 2.62% in Q4 2025, lower than the 2.67% recorded in Q4 2024 and higher than the 2.56% in Q3 2025. In total, 2.52% was contributed in 2025, lower than the 2.57% recorded in 2024.

Education

Nominal growth in the Education sector in the fourth quarter of 2025 was 30.42% (year-on-year), up by 18.59% points from the growth of 11.83% reported in the corresponding quarter of 2024, and down by 2.25% points when compared to the Q3 2025 growth rate of 32.67%. The quarter-on-quarter growth rate was 38.12%. The annual growth rate in 2025 was 28.50%, higher than 11.99% recorded in 2024. The contribution of Education to nominal GDP in Q4 2025 was 1.19%; up from 1.08% reported in Q4 2024 and up from 0.93% in Q3 2025. In total, the sector contributed 0.97% in 2025 relative to 0.90% recorded in 2024.

Real growth in Education year-on-year stood at 2.21% in Q4 2025; a decrease of 0.03% points from the corresponding quarter of 2024, which was estimated at 2.24%. When compared with the previous quarter's rate of 2.51%, the sector's growth decreased by 0.30% points. Overall, the growth in 2025 was 2.35%, higher than 2.00% reported in 2024. The sector contributed 0.80% to total real GDP in Q4 2025, which was lower than the 0.81% reported for the corresponding quarter in 2024 and higher than the 0.65% recorded in Q3 2025. In total, the contribution of the sector was 0.69% in 2025, lower than the 0.70% recorded in 2024.

Human Health and Social Services

The year-on-year growth rate for Human Health and Social Services in nominal terms was 43.73%, up relative to the growth rate of 18.15% reported in the same quarter of 2024 by 25.58% points and down by 1.15% points compared to Q3 2025. Quarter-on-quarter, growth was 5.55% in Q4 2025. Overall, the sector grew by 36.62% in 2025 relative to 20.14% in 2024. The contribution to nominal GDP was 1.82% in Q4 2025, higher than the 1.49% recorded in Q4 2024 and down from the 1.86% recorded in Q3 2025. In total, the 2025 contribution stood at 1.79%, higher than the 1.55% reported in 2024.

Real GDP growth of Human Health and Social Services for Q4 2025 stood at 2.75% (year-on-year) compared to 4.24% for the corresponding period of 2024, which shows a decrease of 1.49% points. The growth in Q4 2025 was lower than the growth recorded in Q3 2025 by 0.14% points. Quarter-on-quarter, this sector grew by 4.94%. The annual growth of the sector stood at 2.46%, lower than the 2.96% recorded in 2024. The contribution of Human Health and Social Services to real GDP was 1.45% in Q4 2025, lower than the figure recorded in Q4 2024 and lower than the 1.55% recorded in the preceding quarter. In total, the contribution of the sector was 1.57% in 2025, lower than the contribution in the previous year.

Other Services

In nominal terms, Other Services grew by 49.18% (year-on-year) in Q4 2025. This growth rate was higher than the 11.52% growth rate recorded in the same quarter of the previous year and higher than the growth rate of 17.98% in Q3 2025 by 37.66% points and 31.20% points, respectively. Quarter-on-quarter, growth was 65.10%. Overall, growth stood at 26.13% in 2025, higher than 18.28% recorded in 2024. This sector contributed 2.16% to the aggregate nominal GDP in Q4 2025, higher than the 1.70% it contributed in the same period of the previous year and higher than the 1.41% it contributed in the preceding quarter. In total, the 2025 contribution stood at 1.65%, higher than the 1.55% recorded in 2024.

Other Services' real GDP grew by 4.11% (year-on-year) in Q4 2025. This growth was lower by 2.52% points than the growth recorded in the same period of the previous year, and lower by 0.08% points from Q3 2025. Quarter-on-quarter, growth was 64.17% in Q4 2025. Overall, the sector grew by 0.34% in 2025, higher than the -1.17% recorded in 2024. The sector contributed 1.71% to real GDP in Q4 2025, relatively the same with the 1.71% recorded for the corresponding quarter of 2024 and higher than the 1.17% recorded in Q3 2025. In total, the contribution of the sector was 1.35% in 2025 from 1.40% in 2024.
