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Preface

This publication provides data on Quarterly Gross Domestic Product (GDP) estimates for the four quarters of 2025, the annual figures for 2025, the first and second quarter of 2026. The figures presented in the report are rebased quarterly time series estimates.

Quarterly National Accounts (QNA) are integrated systems of macroeconomic accounts designed to describe the entire system of production in a nation quarterly. They provide a picture of the current status of the economy that is timely and more frequent than that provided by the Annual National Accounts (ANA). The key attribute of QNA is that they provide a reasonable level of detail on the economy that helps the government to assess, analyse, and monitor economic growth regularly.

QNA adopts the same concepts, definitions, and structure as ANA. In principle, QNA covers the entire sequence of accounts and balance sheets as reflected in the 2008 System of National Accounts (2008 SNA).

The data for Q2 2026 were obtained from the Quarterly Establishment Survey (QES) conducted by the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS). This series covers major aggregates of quarterly GDP by kind of economic activities at current and constant (2019) prices.

We are grateful to the various agencies and establishments that made their data available as input to the estimates.

Introduction

The National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) has been conducting Establishment Surveys to provide data for the estimation of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for the country. In 2008, NBS started to improve the GDP series by conducting Quarterly Establishment Surveys (QES) for the four quarters of each year to provide timely estimates for decisions and policymaking.

In 2018, the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) conducted the Quarterly Establishment Surveys for the first three quarters of 2018 (Q1-Q3/ 2018), while the fourth quarter survey for 2018 was conducted in the first quarter of 2019. This compilation procedure is carried out to date, publishing the Q4 GDP report within the first quarter of the new accounting year. It is important to note that the Bureau maintains a publication date of 45 days after the quarter.

In subsequent sections of this report, emphasis will be given to the composition of GDP in the second quarter of 2026, the corresponding quarter of 2025, and the immediate past quarter of 2026 (Q1 2026).



Overview of GDP in Quarter Two 2026

Gross Domestic Product (GDP) grew by 4.43% (year-on-year) in real terms in the second quarter of 2026, higher than the 4.23% recorded in the second quarter of 2025. During the quarter under review, agriculture grew by 4.39%, an improvement from the 2.82% recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2025. The growth of the industry sector stood at 3.96% from 7.46% recorded in the second quarter of 2025, while the services sector recorded a growth of 4.60% from 3.94% in the same quarter of 2025. In terms of share of the GDP, the services sector contributed more to the aggregate GDP in the second quarter of 2026 at 56.62% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025 at 56.53%.

In the quarter under review, aggregate GDP at basic price stood at N119,294,681.84 million in nominal terms. This performance is higher when compared to the second quarter of 2025, which recorded an aggregate GDP of N100,730,501.10 million, indicating a year-on-year nominal growth of 18.43%. For better clarity, the Nigerian economy has been classified broadly into the oil and non-oil sectors (Pages 5 & 6).

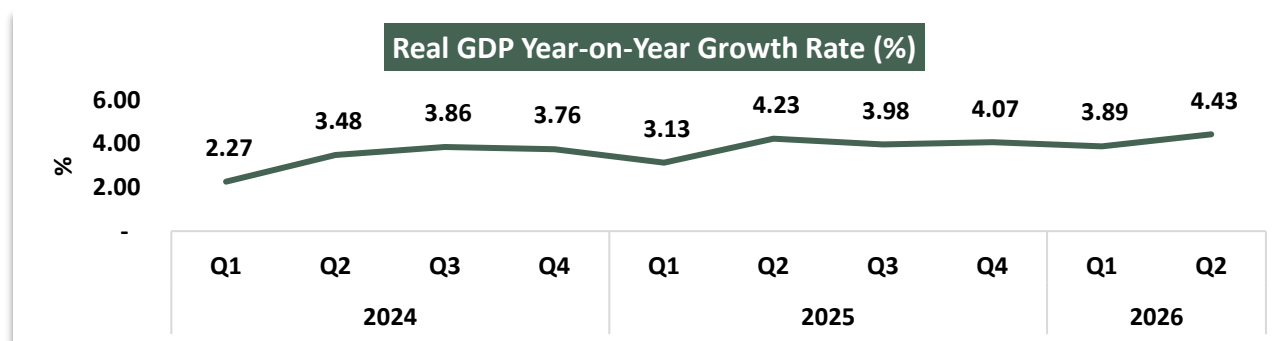


Figure 1: Real GDP Growth

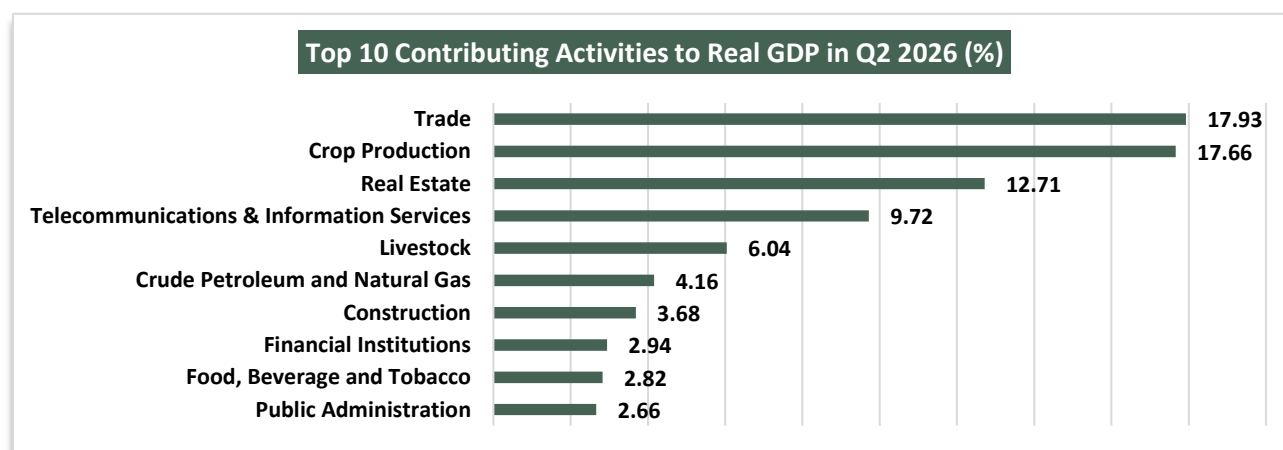


Figure 2: Top 10 Contributing Activities to Real GDP in Q2 2026

The Oil Sector

The nation in the second quarter of 2026 recorded an average daily oil production of 1.72 million barrels per day (mbpd), higher than the daily average production of 1.68 mbpd recorded in the same quarter of 2025 by 0.05 mbpd and higher than the first quarter of 2026 production volume of 1.55 mbpd by 0.17 mbpd. 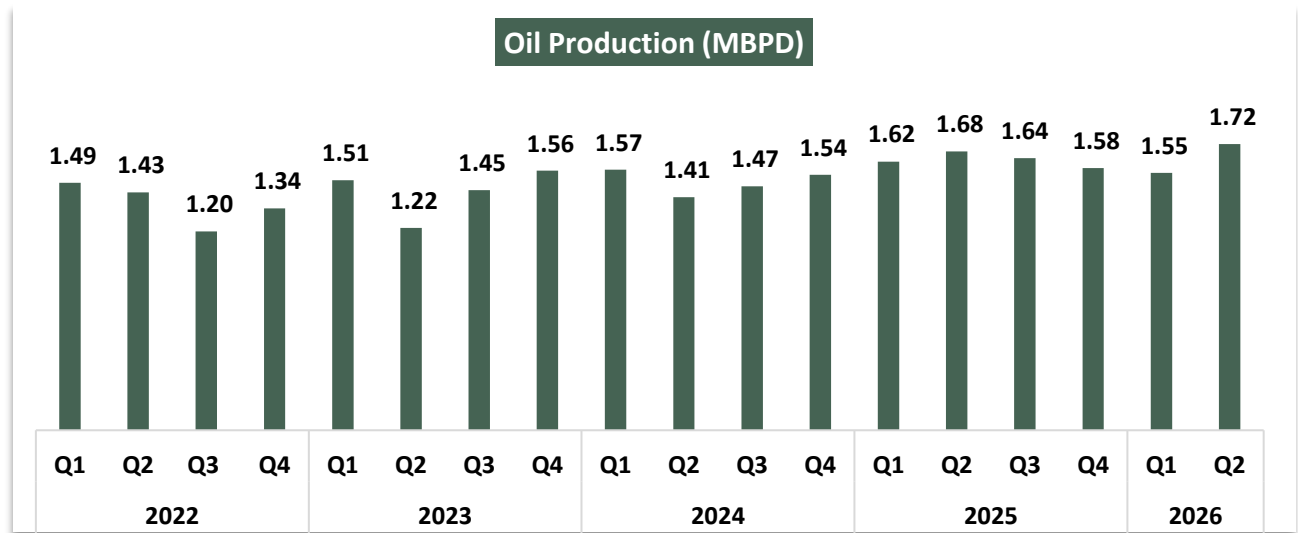


Figure 3: Crude Oil Output (MBPD)

The real growth of the oil sector was 7.31 (year-on-year) in Q2 2026, indicating a decrease of 13.15% points relative to the rate recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2025 (20.46%). Growth increased by 4.74% points when compared to Q1 2026, which was 2.57%. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the oil sector recorded a growth rate of 10.91% in Q2 2026. The Oil sector contributed 4.16% to the total real GDP in Q2 2026, up from the figure recorded in the corresponding period of 2025 at 4.05%. and up from the preceding quarter, where it contributed 3.92%.

The Non-Oil Sector

The non-oil sector grew by 4.31% in real terms during the reference quarter (Q2 2026). This rate was higher by 0.67% points compared to the rate recorded in the same quarter of 2025, which was 3.64%, and higher than the 3.94% recorded in the first quarter of 2026. This sector was driven in the second quarter of 2026 mainly by Agriculture (Crop production); Information and Communication (Telecommunications); Real Estate; Trade; Financial & Insurance (Financial Institutions); Manufacturing (Cement); and Construction, accounting for positive GDP growth.

In real terms, the non-oil sector contributed 95.84% to the nation's GDP in the second quarter of 2026, lower than the share recorded in the second quarter of 2025, which was 95.95%, and lower than the first quarter of 2026, recorded as 96.08%.

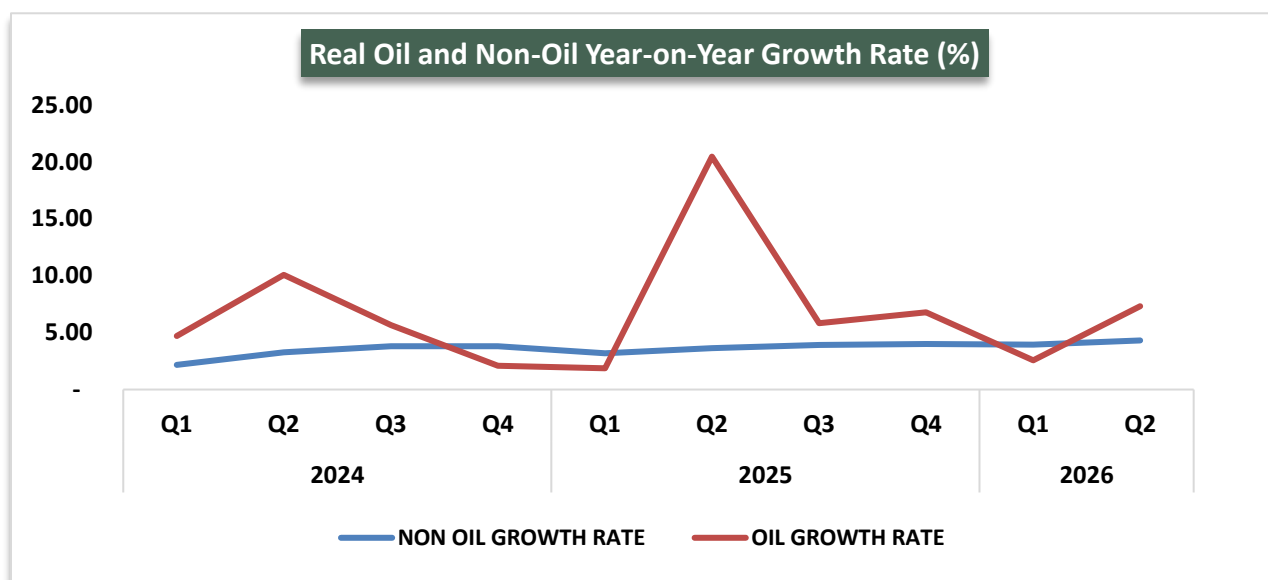
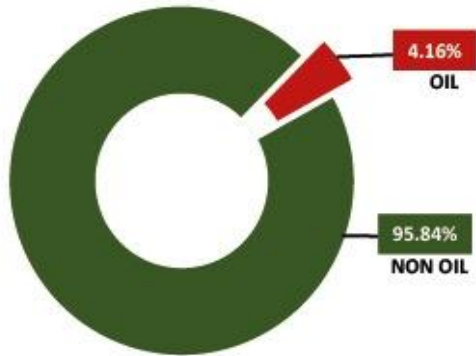


Figure 4: Crude Oil and Non-Oil Growth

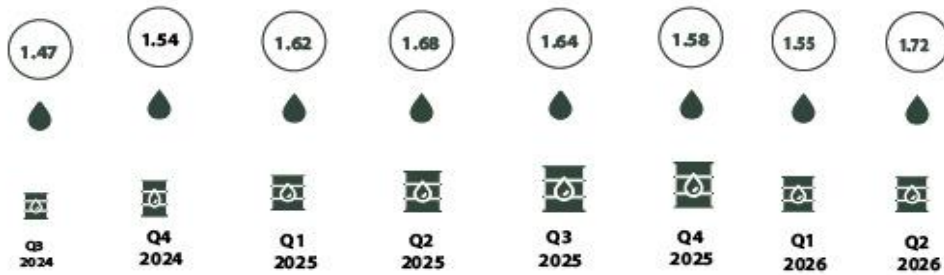

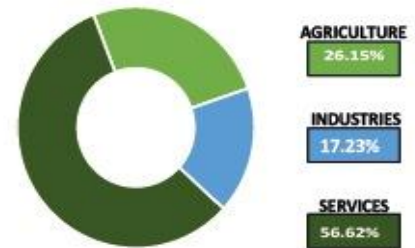

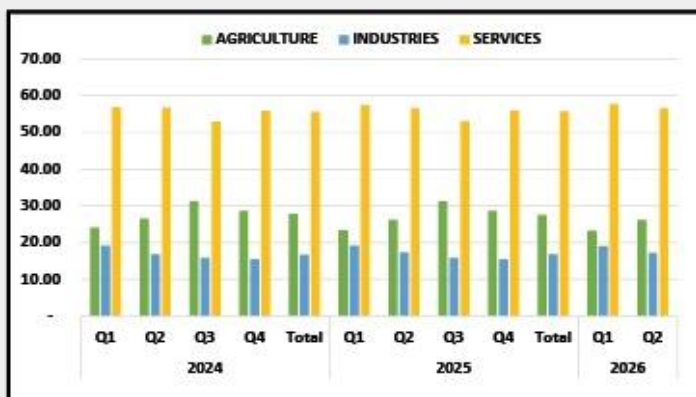
OIL PRODUCTION (MBPD)



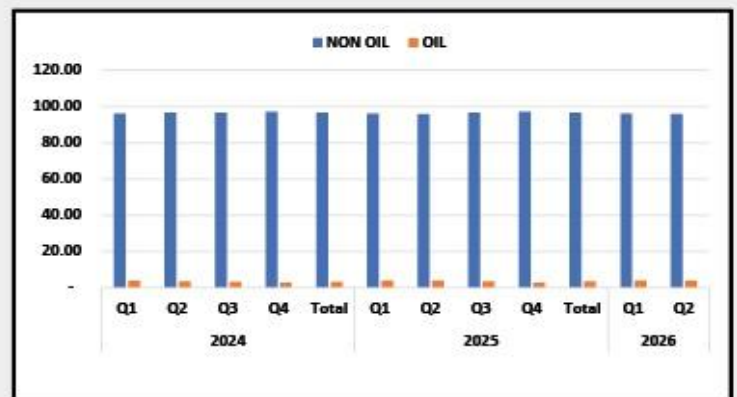
CONTRIBUTION TO REAL GDP

Major Economic Sectors: Q2 2026

Mining & Quarrying

The Mining & Quarrying sector consists of Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas, Coal Mining, Metal ores and Quarrying, and Other Minerals sub-activities. This sector grew nominally by 66.49% (year-on-year) in Q2 2026. Coal mining activity exhibited the highest growth rate of all the sub-activities at 99.37%, followed by Metal Ore at 89.08%. Crude Petroleum and Natural gas was the main contributor to the sector with a weight of 95.37% in Q2 2026. Comparing Q2 2026's rate of growth relative to Q2 2025 and Q1 2026 growth rates, there was an increase of 61.88% points and an increase of 52.57% points, respectively. The Mining & Quarrying sector contributed 4.19% to the overall GDP in the second quarter of 2026, higher than the contribution recorded in the 2025 second quarter at 2.98% and lower than the previous quarter at 4.23%.

In real terms, the Mining and Quarrying sector grew by 6.37% (year-on-year) in the second quarter of 2026. Compared to the same quarter of 2025 and the first quarter of 2026, it was lower by 14.48% points and higher by 4.48% points, respectively. Quarter-on-quarter, the growth rate was 8.49% in Q2 2026. The contribution of Mining and Quarrying to Real GDP in the quarter under review stood at 4.30%, higher than the rate of 4.23% recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2025 and higher than the 4.14% recorded in the first quarter of 2026.

Agriculture

Four sub-activities make up the Agricultural sector: Crop Production, Livestock, Forestry, and Fishing. The sector grew by 14.25% year-on-year in nominal terms in Q2 2026, showing an increase of 12.41% points from the same quarter of 2025. Looking at the preceding quarter's growth rate of 9.93%, there was an increase of 4.32% points. Crop production remained the major driver of the sector. This is evident as it accounts for 59.35% of the overall nominal value of the sector in the second quarter of 2026.

Quarter-on-quarter growth stood at 20.69% in the second quarter of 2026. Agriculture contributed 20.29% to nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2026. This figure was lower than the rate recorded in the second quarter of 2025 and higher than the first quarter of 2026, which recorded 21.04% and 18.11%, respectively.

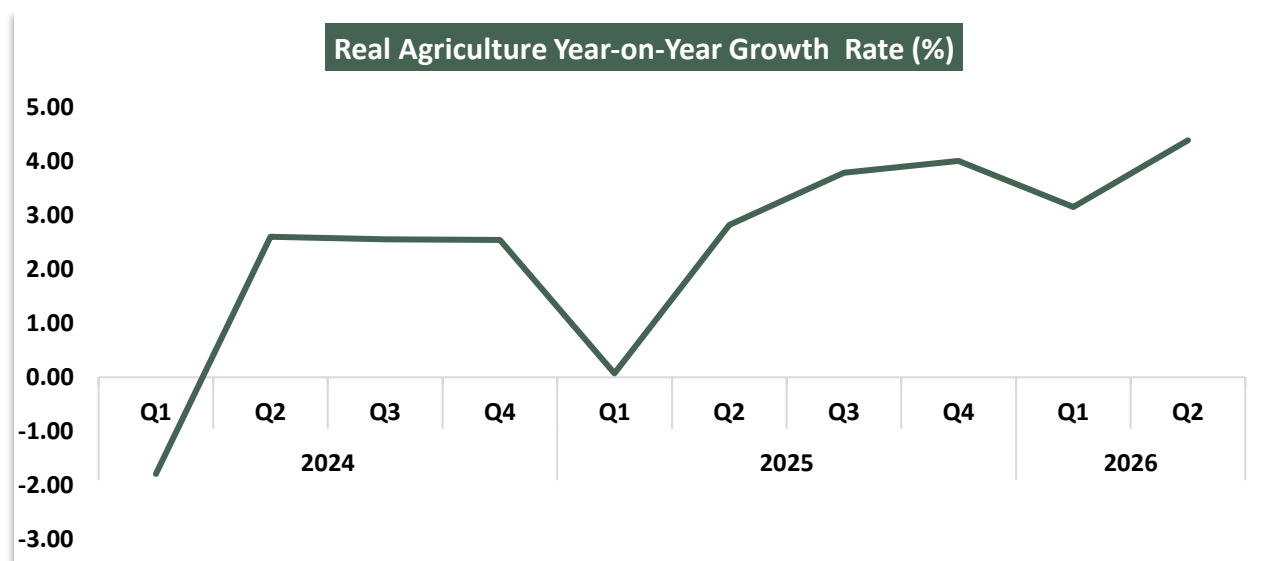


Figure 6: Agriculture real growth

The agricultural sector in the second quarter of 2026 grew by 4.39% (year-on-year) in real terms, an increase of 1.57% points from the corresponding period of 2025, and an increase of 1.24% points from the preceding quarter, which recorded a growth rate of 3.15%. It grew on a quarter-on-quarter basis at 17.80%.

However, the sector contributed 26.15% to aggregate GDP in real terms in Q2 2026, lower than the contribution in the second quarter of 2025 and higher than the contribution in the first quarter of 2026, which stood at 26.17% and 23.16%, respectively.

Manufacturing

The Manufacturing sector is comprised of thirteen activities: Oil Refining; Cement; Food, Beverages and Tobacco; Textile, Apparel, and Footwear; Wood and Wood products; Pulp Paper and Paper products; Chemical and Pharmaceutical products; Non-metallic Products, Plastic and Rubber products; Electrical and Electronic; Basic Metal and Iron and Steel; Motor Vehicles and Assembly; and Other Manufacturing.

Nominal GDP growth of the Manufacturing sector in the second quarter of 2026 was 35.55% (year-on-year), 31.03% points higher than the figure recorded in the corresponding period of 2025 (4.51%) and 25.32% points higher than the preceding quarter figure of 10.22%. Quarter-on-quarter, growth of the sector was recorded at -16.03% during the quarter. The contribution of Manufacturing to Nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2026 was 7.86%, higher than the figure recorded in the corresponding period of 2025 at 6.87% and lower than the first quarter of 2026 at 10.08%.

Real GDP growth in the manufacturing sector in the second quarter of 2026 was 3.24% (year-on-year), higher than the same quarter of 2025 and lower than the preceding quarter by 1.65% points and 0.05% points, respectively. The growth rate of the sector on a quarter-on-quarter basis stood at -15.85%. The Real contribution to GDP in the second quarter of 2026 was 7.72%, lower than the 7.81% recorded in the second quarter of 2025 and lower than the 9.57% recorded in the first quarter of 2026.

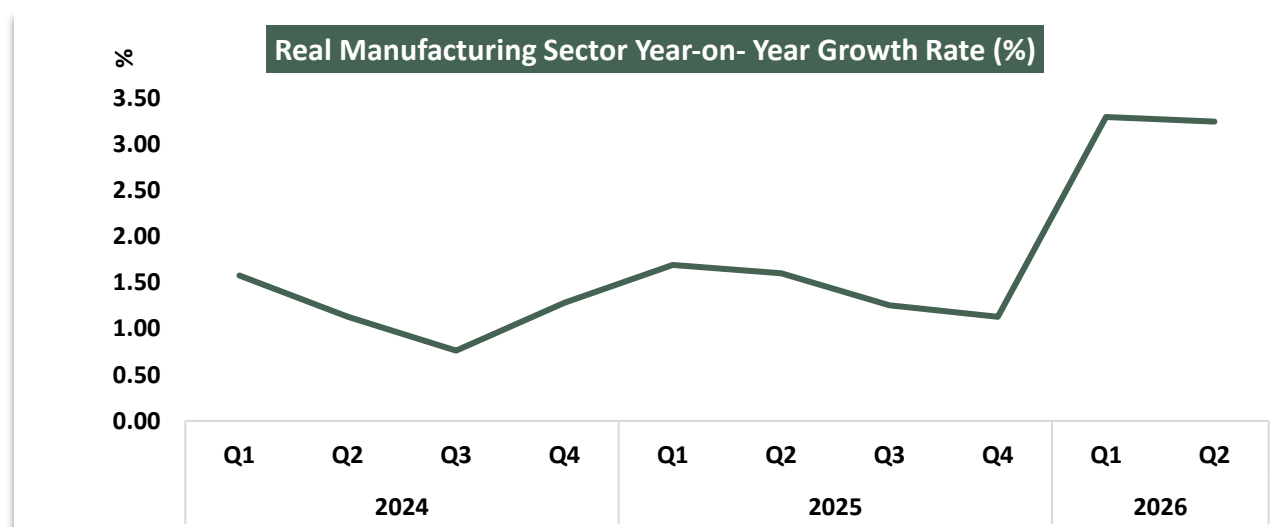


Figure 7: Manufacturing real growth

Electricity, Gas, Steam, and Air Conditioning Supply

The Electricity, Gas, Steam, and Air conditioning Supply sector recorded a year-on-year growth of – 0.87% in the second quarter of 2026. This was 13.81% points lower than the 12.94% growth rate recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2025, and 4.11% points higher than the growth rate of - 4.98% recorded in the quarter before. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector recorded a growth rate of 289.08% in Q2 2026. The contribution of Electricity, Gas, Steam, and Air Conditioning Supply to Nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2026 was 1.06%, lower than the contribution in the corresponding quarter of 2025 at 1.27% and higher than its contribution of 0.29% in the quarter before.

In real terms, the sector grew by -10.63% in Q2 2026, a decrease from the growth rate of 11.47% recorded in the same quarter of 2025. When compared to the immediate past quarter, there was an increase of 4.67% points from -15.30% recorded. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector grew at 286.60%. The contribution of this sector to real GDP in the second quarter of 2026 was 1.05%, lower than the 1.23% recorded in Q2 2025 and higher than the 0.28% recorded in Q1 2026.

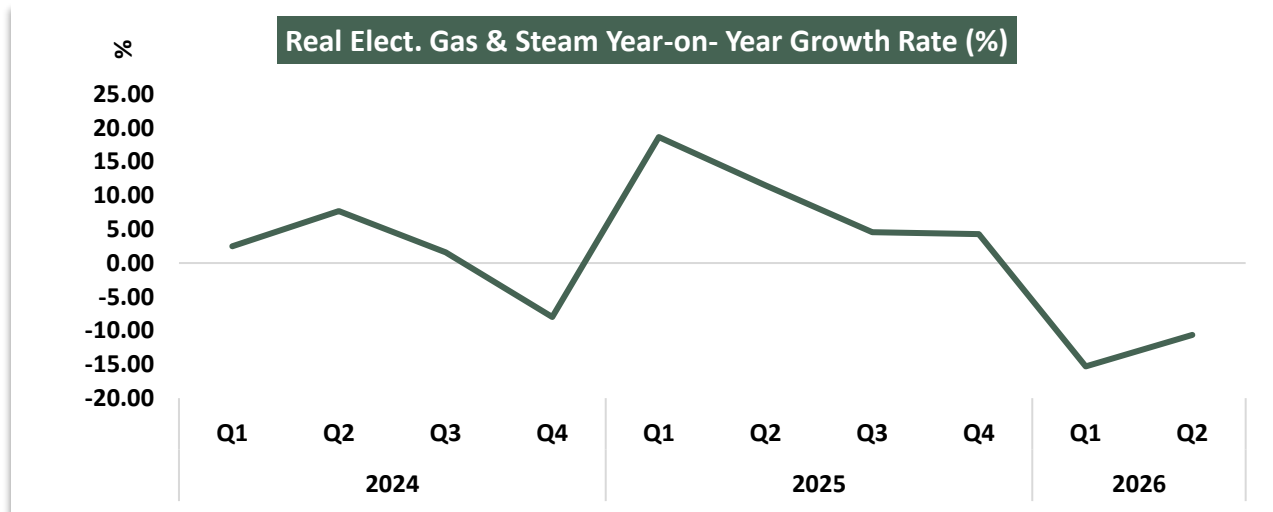


Figure 8: Electricity, Gas and Steam real growth

Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management, and Remediation

This sector grew by 56.74% in nominal terms (year-on-year) in the second quarter of 2026, an increase of 43.45 percentage points compared to the rate of 13.28% recorded in the same quarter of 2025. There was an increase of 30.77 percentage points when compared to the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Nominal growth quarter-on-quarter was recorded at 99.05%. The Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management, and Remediation sector contributed 0.44% to nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2026, higher than the 0.34% it contributed a year earlier and higher than the 0.24% contributed in the first quarter of 2026.

The real growth rate of the Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management, and Remediation sector in the second quarter of 2026 was 11.24% (year-on-year), higher by 0.64 percentage points from the rate recorded in the previous year. Relative to the preceding quarter, there was an increase of 0.93 percentage points. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by 84.58% in real terms.

Its contribution to total real GDP was 0.47% in the second quarter of 2026, higher than its contribution of 0.44% in the same quarter of the previous year, and higher than the immediate past quarter, where it contributed 0.27%.

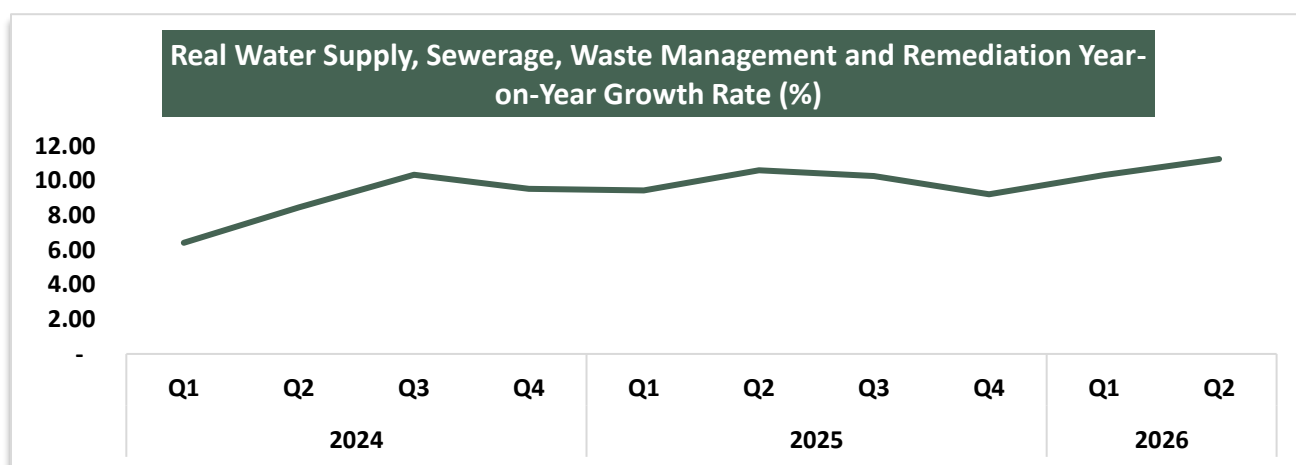


Figure 9: Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management, and Remediation real growth

Construction

The Construction sector grew by 27.38% in nominal terms (year-on-year) in the 2026 second quarter, an increase of 17.80% points compared to the rate of 9.58% recorded in the same quarter of 2025. Also, there was an increase of 9.08% points when compared to the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Nominal growth quarter-on-quarter was recorded at -14.47%. Construction contributed 4.29% to nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2026, higher than the 3.99% it contributed a year earlier and lower than the 5.41% contributed to the first quarter of 2026.

The real growth rate of the construction sector in the second quarter of 2026 was recorded at 6.75% (year-on-year), higher by 1.48% points from the rate recorded in the previous year. Relative to the preceding quarter, there was an increase of 0.37% points. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by -20.73% in real terms.

Its contribution to total real GDP was 3.68% in the second quarter of 2026; higher than its contribution of 3.60% in the same quarter of the previous year, and lower than in the immediate past quarter, where it contributed 4.85%.

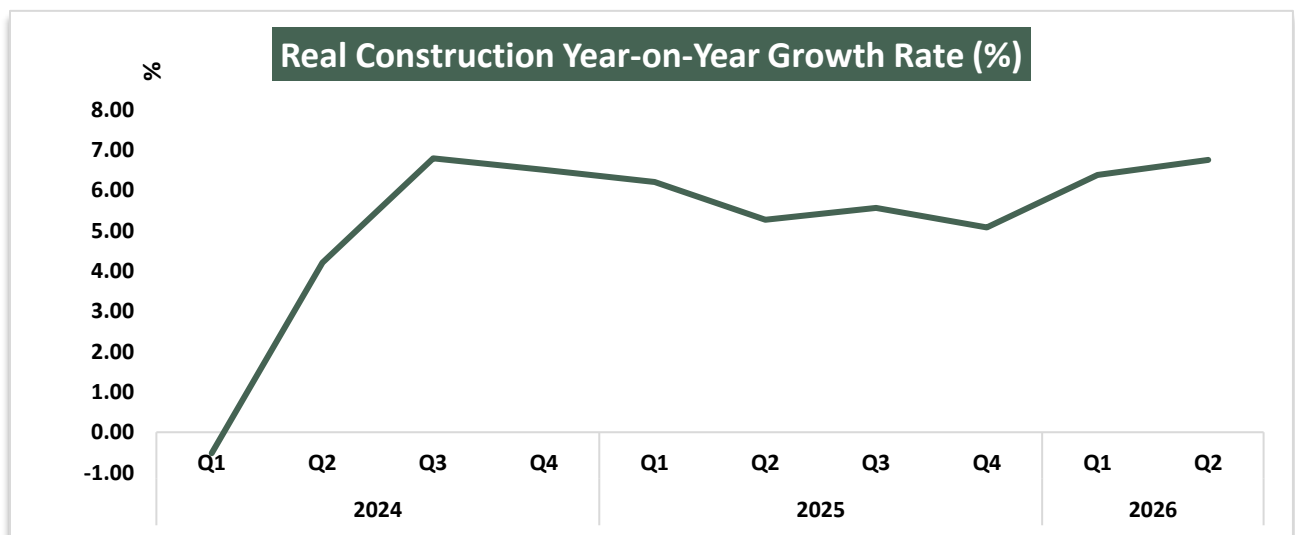


Figure 10: Construction real growth

Trade

In the second quarter of 2026, the nominal year-on-year growth rate of Trade stood at 4.82%. This indicates a decrease of 39.01% points when compared to the second quarter of 2025 growth rate of 43.83% and 33.33% points lower than the previous quarter's growth rate of 38.15%. The quarter-on-quarter growth rate was 35.79%. Trade's contribution to Nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2026 was 22.95%, lower than the contribution in the same quarter of the previous year of 25.93%, and higher than the preceding quarter recorded at 18.20%.

In real terms, Trade's year-on-year growth stood at 2.40% in the second quarter of 2026, which was 1.11% points higher than the rate recorded in the previous year at 1.29%, and 0.32% points higher than in the preceding quarter at 2.08% growth rate. Quarter-on-quarter growth stood at 4.51%. Trade's contribution to GDP was 17.93%, lower than the 18.28% it represented in the previous year, and higher than the 17.89% recorded in the first quarter of 2026.

Accommodation and Food Services

In nominal terms, Accommodation and Food Services grew by 59.85% year-on-year in the 2026 second quarter. This represents an increase of 56.16% points relative to the same quarter of 2025, when the growth rate was 3.69%. Growth was higher than in the preceding quarter by 53.89% points when growth was 5.97%. Quarter-on-quarter, growth stood at -58.28%. Accommodation and Food Services' contribution to nominal GDP stood at 0.44% in the second quarter of 2026, higher than the figure recorded in the previous year and lower than the first quarter of 2026 contribution recorded at 0.32% and 1.13%, respectively.

The real year-on-year growth rate for this sector in the second quarter of 2026 stood at 6.96%, higher by 4.48% points from 2.48% recorded in the previous year. Relative to the preceding quarter, the growth rate was 2.60% points higher than the 4.36% recorded. Quarter-on-quarter, real growth was -60.08%. The sector in the second quarter of 2026 represented 0.30% of the real GDP, which was higher than the contribution of 0.29% recorded in the second quarter of 2025 and lower than the first quarter of 2026 contribution of 0.77%.

Transportation and Storage

Six activities make up the Transportation and Storage sector: Road Transport; Rail Transport and Pipelines; Water Transport; Air Transport; Transport Services; and Post and Courier Services.

The sector grew by 49.87% in nominal terms in the second quarter of 2026 (year-on-year). This rate was higher relative to the 13.67% recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2025 and higher than 6.51% in the previous quarter. Of the six sub-activities under the Transport and Storage industry, all activities recorded positive growth rates in the second quarter of 2026. Quarter-on-quarter growth stood at -30.31%. Transport activities contributed 0.88% to Nominal GDP in Q2 2026, an increase from the 0.70% recorded in the corresponding period of 2025, and lower than the 1.36% recorded in the first quarter of 2026.

In real terms, the Transportation and Storage sector grew by 5.70% in Q2 2026. This rate represents a decrease of 16.39% points compared to the same quarter of the previous year and a decrease of 1.71% points relative to the preceding quarter. Quarter-on-quarter, growth was -32.91%. The contribution of the sector to real GDP in Q2 2026 was 0.66%, higher than the 0.65% recorded in the preceding year and lower than the 1.02% recorded in the first quarter of 2026.

Information & Communication

The Information and Communication sector is composed of the four activities of Telecommunications and Information Services; Publishing; Motion Picture, Sound Recording and Music Production; and Broadcasting.

In nominal terms, the sector growth in the second quarter of 2026 was 45.32% (year-on-year), 23.93% points increase from the rate of 21.39% recorded in the same quarter of 2025, and 36.13% points higher than the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. The quarter-on-quarter growth rate in the second quarter of 2026 was 38.47%. The Information and Communications sector contributed 12.27% to the total Nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2026, higher than the rate of 10.00% recorded in the same quarter of 2025 and higher than the 9.54% it contributed in the preceding quarter.

The sector in the second quarter of 2026 recorded a growth rate of 9.62% in real terms, year-on-year. From the rate recorded in the corresponding period of 2025, there was an increase of 3.02% points. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector exhibited a growth of 8.24% in real terms. Of total real GDP, the sector contributed 11.74% in the second quarter of 2026, higher than in the same quarter of the previous year, in which it represented 11.18%, and higher than the preceding quarter, in which it represented 11.31%.

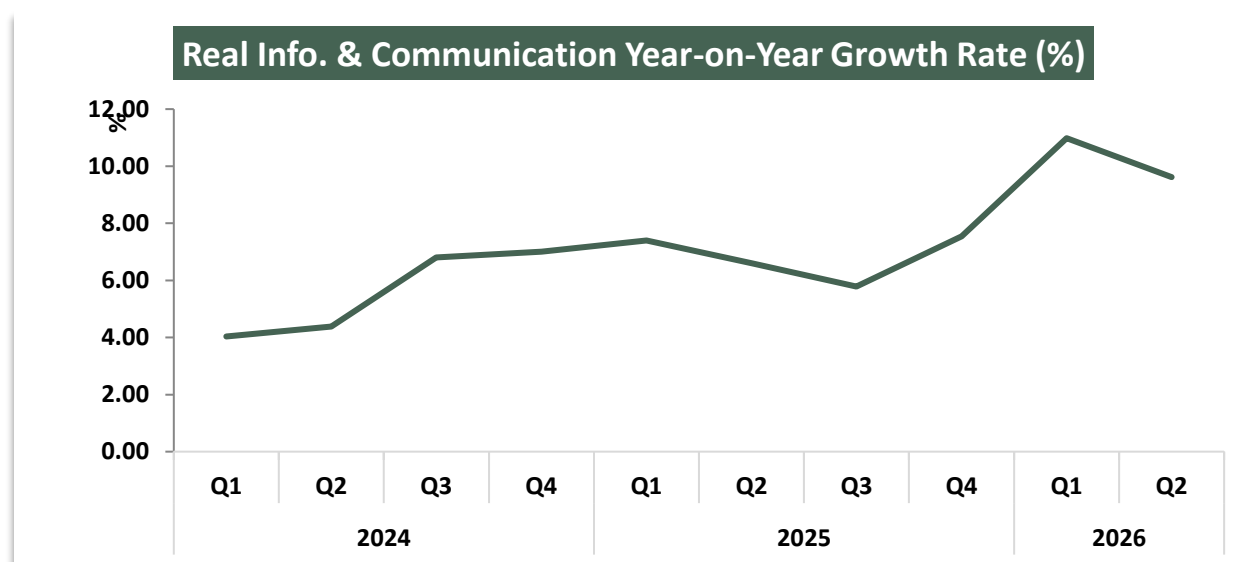


Figure 12: Information and Communication real growth rate

Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation

In nominal terms, the growth of the Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation sector was 11.98% in the second quarter of 2026 (year-on-year), representing a decrease of 19.23% points relative to the preceding quarter's growth rate of 31.21% and an increase of 6.65% points compared with the growth rate a year-earlier at 5.32%. On a quarterly basis, growth was recorded at -35.47%. The activity contributed 0.39% to the total nominal GDP in the second quarter of 2026. This contribution was lower than the 0.41% it contributed in Q2 2025 and lower than the 0.65% it contributed in Q1 2026.

In real terms, the activity grew by 11.93% year-on-year, which was higher than the rate recorded in Q2 2025 by 4.29% points, and higher by 0.67% points when compared with that of the preceding quarter. Quarter-on-quarter, growth stood at -34.94% in real terms. The activity of Art, Entertainment, and Recreation contributed 0.31% to real GDP in Q2 2026, higher than the 0.29% recorded in the same quarter of 2025 and lower than the 0.50% recorded in the first quarter of 2026.

Real Estate Services

In nominal terms, Real Estate Services in the second quarter of 2026 grew by 13.85%, higher by 7.71% points than the growth rate reported for the same period in 2025 and lower compared to the preceding Quarter. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector growth rate was -44.61%. The contribution to nominal GDP in Q2 2026 stood at 8.71%, relative to 9.06% recorded in the second quarter of 2025 and 16.94% in the first quarter of 2026.

Real GDP growth recorded in the sector for the second quarter of 2026 stood at 3.76%, lower than the growth recorded in the second quarter of 2025 by 0.03% points, and higher by 1.47% points relative to Q1 2026. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector grew by 1.26% in the second quarter of 2026. It contributed 12.71% to real GDP in Q2 2026, lower than the 12.80% it recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2025 and lower than the 13.10% contributed in the preceding quarter.

Finance and Insurance

The Finance and Insurance Sector consists of the two subsectors, Financial Institutions, and Insurance, in which the former accounted for 87.22% and the latter 12.78% of the sector, respectively in real terms in Q2 2026.

The sector grew at 11.88% in nominal terms (year-on-year), with the growth rate of Financial Institutions at 10.92% and 18.88% growth rate recorded for Insurance. The overall rate was lower than Q2 2025 by 51.79% points, and lower by 35.03% points than the preceding quarter. The quarter-on-quarter growth was 21.49%. The sector's contribution to the nominal GDP was 4.32% in Q2 2026, lower than the 4.57% it represented a year previous, and higher than the contribution of 3.83% it made in the preceding quarter.

Growth in this sector in real terms totaled 9.29%, lower by 6.84% points from the rate recorded in the 2025 second quarter and higher by 0.74% points from the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Quarter-on-quarter, growth in real terms stood at -6.49%. The contribution of Finance and Insurance to real GDP totalled 3.37%, higher than the contribution of 3.23% recorded in the second quarter of 2025 by 0.15% points, and lower than 3.76% recorded in Q1 2026 by 0.39% points.

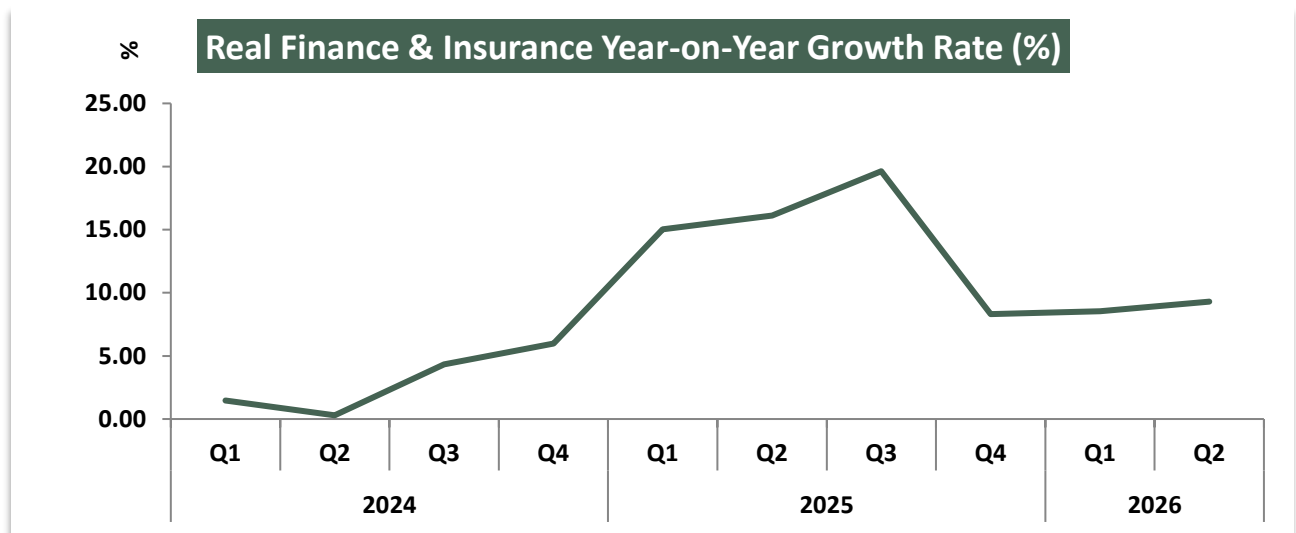


Figure 13: Finance and Insurance real growth

Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services

In the second quarter of 2026, Professional, Scientific and Technical Services recorded a nominal growth of 5.22% (year-on-year), which is 17.11% points lower than Q2 2025, and 33.72% points lower than the rate recorded in Q1 2026. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by 23.12%. The contribution of Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services to nominal GDP was 2.84% in Q2 2026, down from the 3.19% contribution in Q2 2025 and up from the 2.48% recorded in Q1 2026.

Real growth in the sector was recorded at 2.79% in Q2 2026, an increase of 0.51% points relative to the rate recorded in the corresponding period of 2025, and 0.13% points higher than that of Q1 2026. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector declined by 5.24% in Q2 2026. Professional, Scientific and Technical Services contributed 2.22% to aggregate GDP in Q2 2026, lower than the contribution of 2.25% in Q2 2025 and lower than the 2.44% recorded in Q1 2026.

Administrative and Support Services

In nominal terms, the Administrative and Support Services sector grew by 5.72% (year-on-year) in Q2 2026, lower by 65.65% points compared to the second quarter of 2025 and lower by 33.98% points than the growth rate in the previous quarter. Quarter-on-quarter, the growth rate in the sector was 56.26% in Q2 2026. The contribution of Administrative and Support Services to nominal GDP was 1.85% in Q2 2026, lower than the 2.07% it contributed in the same period in 2025 and higher than the 1.28% it contributed in the preceding quarter.

In real terms, the sector recorded a growth rate of 3.27% (year-on-year), an increase of 0.19% points from the corresponding quarter of 2025 and an increase of 0.06% points from the rate recorded in Q1 2026. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by 20.27% in Q2 2026. The sector's contribution to real GDP was 1.45% in the 2026 second quarter, lower than the corresponding quarter in 2025 and higher than the 2026 first quarter.

Public Administration

In nominal terms, the Public Administration sector grew by 4.35% in Q2 2026, lower by 38.95% points from the corresponding quarter of 2025 and lower by 33.64% points relative to Q1 2026. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by 71.83%. The contribution of Public Administration to Nominal GDP stood at 3.41% in Q2 2026, lower than the 3.87% recorded in Q2 2025 and higher than the 2.14% recorded in Q1 2026.

In real terms, the sector recorded a growth rate of 1.94% (year-on-year) in Q2 2026, higher by 0.14% points and lower by 0.02% points from the Q2 2025 rate and the Q1 2026 rate, respectively. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector grew by 32.26% in Q2 2026. The contribution of Public Administration to real GDP stood at 2.66% in Q2 2026, lower than the 2.73% recorded in Q2 2025 and higher than the 2.10% in Q1 2026.

Education

Nominal growth in the Education sector in the second quarter of 2026 was 43.98% (year-on-year), up by 40.14% points from the growth of 3.85% reported in the corresponding quarter of 2025, and up by 42.91% points when compared to the Q1 2026 growth rate of 1.07%. The quarter-on-quarter growth rate was -24.33%. The contribution of Education to nominal GDP in Q2 2026 was 0.70%; up from 0.58% reported in Q2 2025 and down from 1.00% in Q1 2026.

Real growth in Education year-on-year stood at 2.76% in Q2 2026; an increase of 0.54% points from the corresponding quarter of 2025, which was estimated at 2.22%. When compared with the previous quarter's rate of 1.22%, the sector's growth increased by 1.54% points. The sector contributed 0.52% to total real GDP in Q2 2026, which was lower than the 0.53% reported for the corresponding quarter in 2025 and lower than the 0.76% recorded in Q1 2026.

Human Health and Social Services

The year-on-year growth rate for Human Health and Social Services in nominal terms was 54.32%, up relative to the growth rate of 6.36% reported in the same quarter of 2025 by 47.96% points and up by 51.80% points compared to Q1 2026. Quarter-on-quarter, growth was 14.74% in Q2 2026. The contribution to nominal GDP was 1.89% in Q2 2026, higher than the 1.45% recorded in Q2 2025 and up from the 1.77% recorded in Q1 2026.

Real GDP growth of Human Health and Social Services for Q2 2026 stood at 2.64% (year-on-year) compared to 2.35% for the corresponding period of 2025, which shows an increase of 0.28% points. The growth in Q2 2026 was higher than the growth recorded in Q1 2026 by 0.65% points. Quarter-on-quarter, this sector grew by 5.44%. The contribution of Human Health and Social Services to real GDP was 1.63% in Q2 2026, lower than the figure recorded in Q2 2025 and higher than the 1.61% recorded in the preceding quarter.

Other Services

In nominal terms, Other Services grew by 5.23% (year-on-year) in Q2 2026. This growth rate was higher than the -1.37% growth rate recorded in the same quarter of the previous year and higher than the growth rate of -1.40% in Q1 2026 by 6.61% points and 6.63% points, respectively. Quarter-on-quarter, growth was -2.08%. This sector contributed 1.21% to the aggregate nominal GDP in Q2 2026, lower than the 1.36% it contributed in the same period of the previous year and lower than the 1.33% it contributed in the preceding quarter.

Other Services' real GDP grew by -0.70% (year-on-year) in Q2 2026. This growth was higher by 2.30% points than the growth recorded in the same period of the previous year, and higher by 1.26% points from Q1 2026. Quarter-on-quarter, growth was -2.59% in Q2 2026. The sector contributed 1.13% to real GDP in Q2 2026, lower than the 1.18% recorded for the corresponding quarter of 2025 and lower than the 1.20% recorded in Q1 2026.
