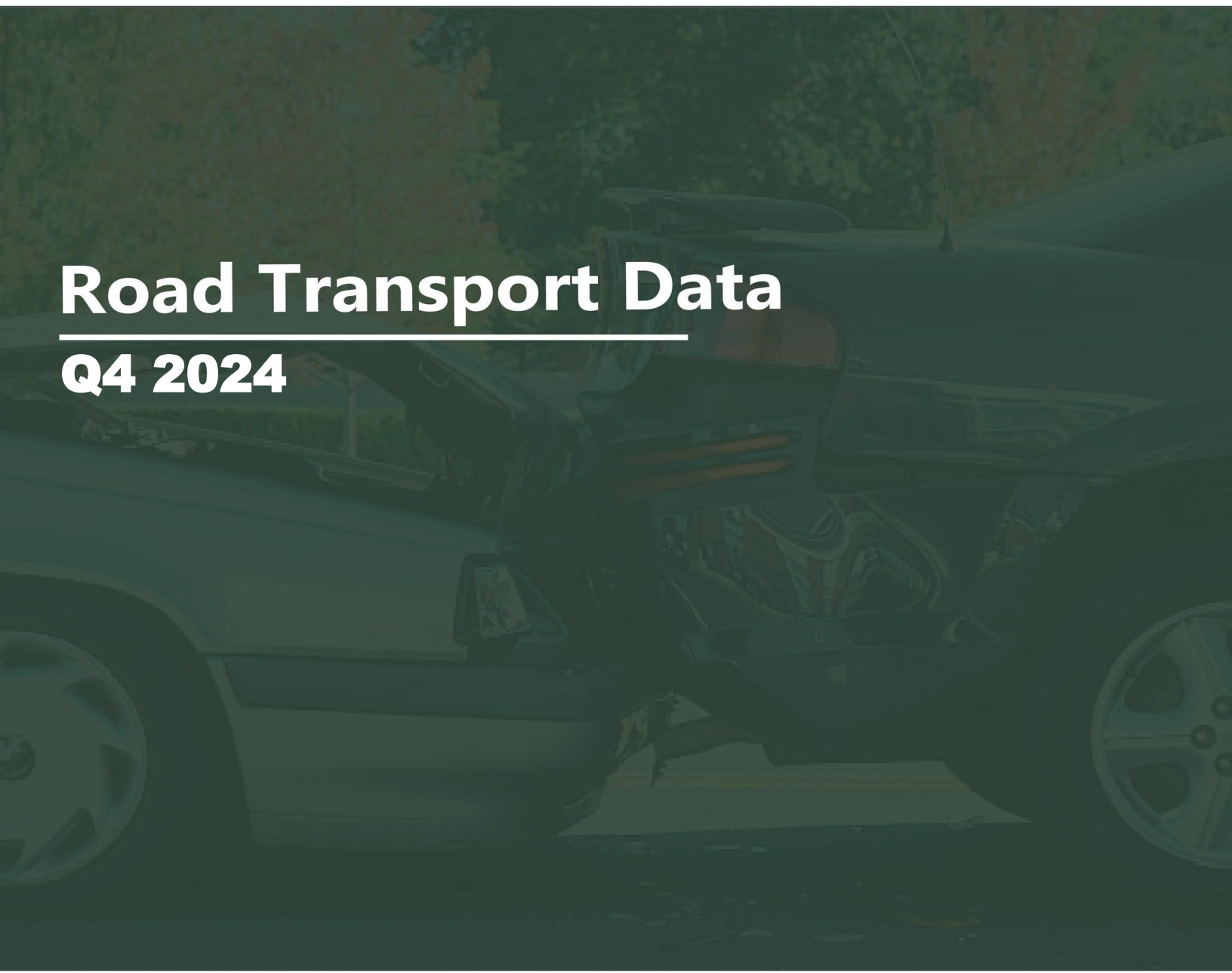

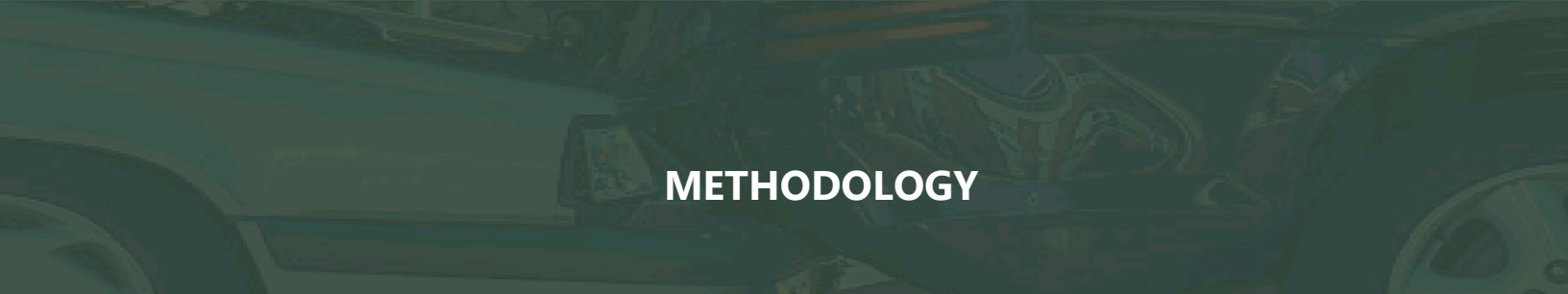

METHODOLOGY

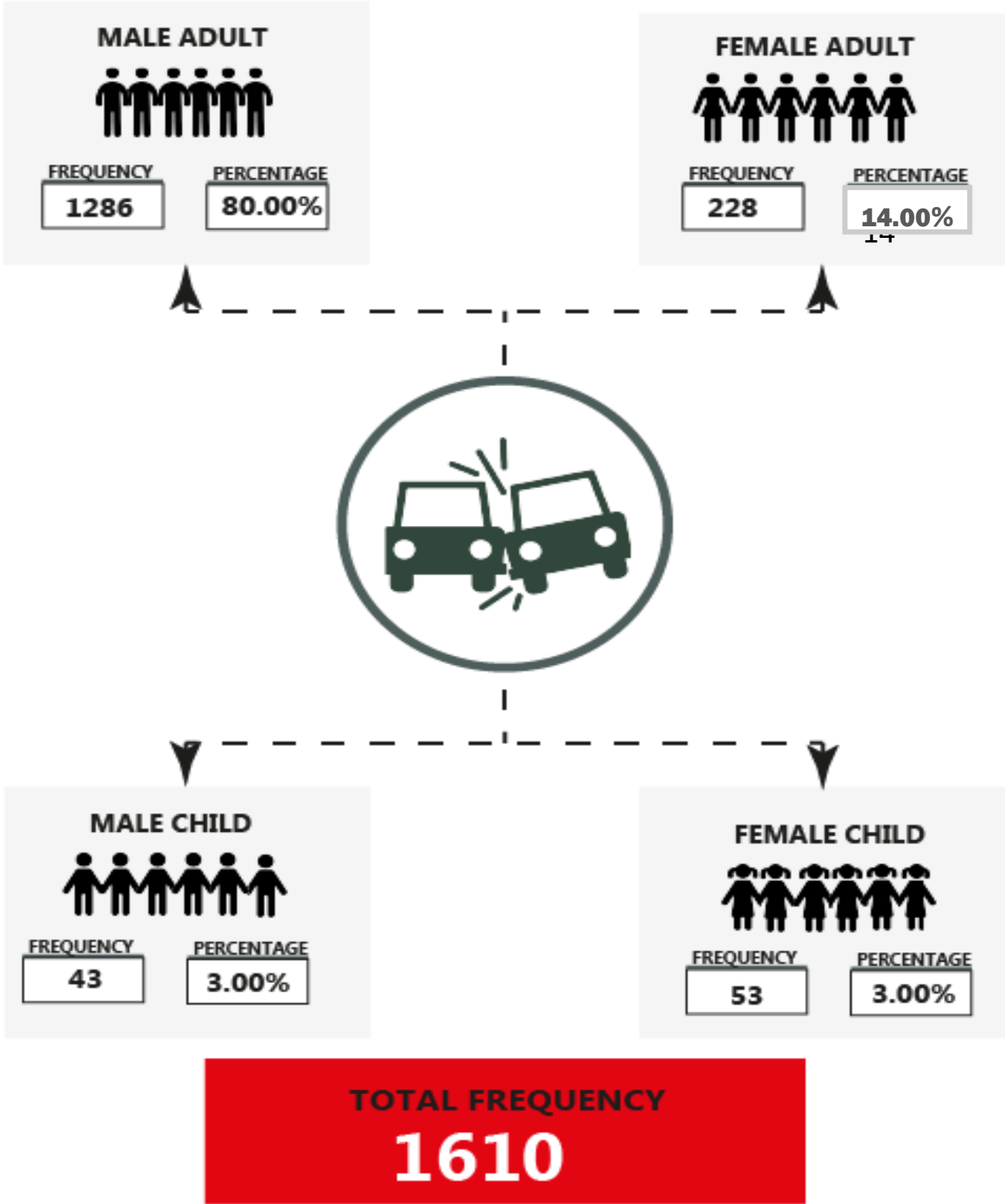
Data is provided by the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), and reported by the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS)

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- The total number of road traffic crashes in Q4 2024 was 2,559 which indicates a 32.38% increase from the 1,933 crashes recorded in the previous quarter, and a 5.82% decrease from the 2,717 crashes recorded in the same period last year (Q4 2023).
- Serious cases was the most occurred road traffic crash cases with 1,607 occurrence compared to fatal and minor cases with 683 and 269; respectively.
- A total of 1,329 males were killed in Q4 2024 accounts for 83%, while the total female killed were 281 and represents 17%. of the total death recorded.
- During the period, 6,566 males were injured, this indicates 75%; while 2,215 females were reported injured and represents 25% of the total injured person.
- The total vehicles involved in road traffic crashes in Q4 2024 were 3,799.
- The South-West zone recorded the highest number of crashes in Q4 2024 with 738 followed by the North-Central zones with 710, while the South-South had the least with 147. Similarly, the North-Central reported the highest number of casualties with 3027 followed by the North-West with 2706, while the South-South recorded the least with 482.

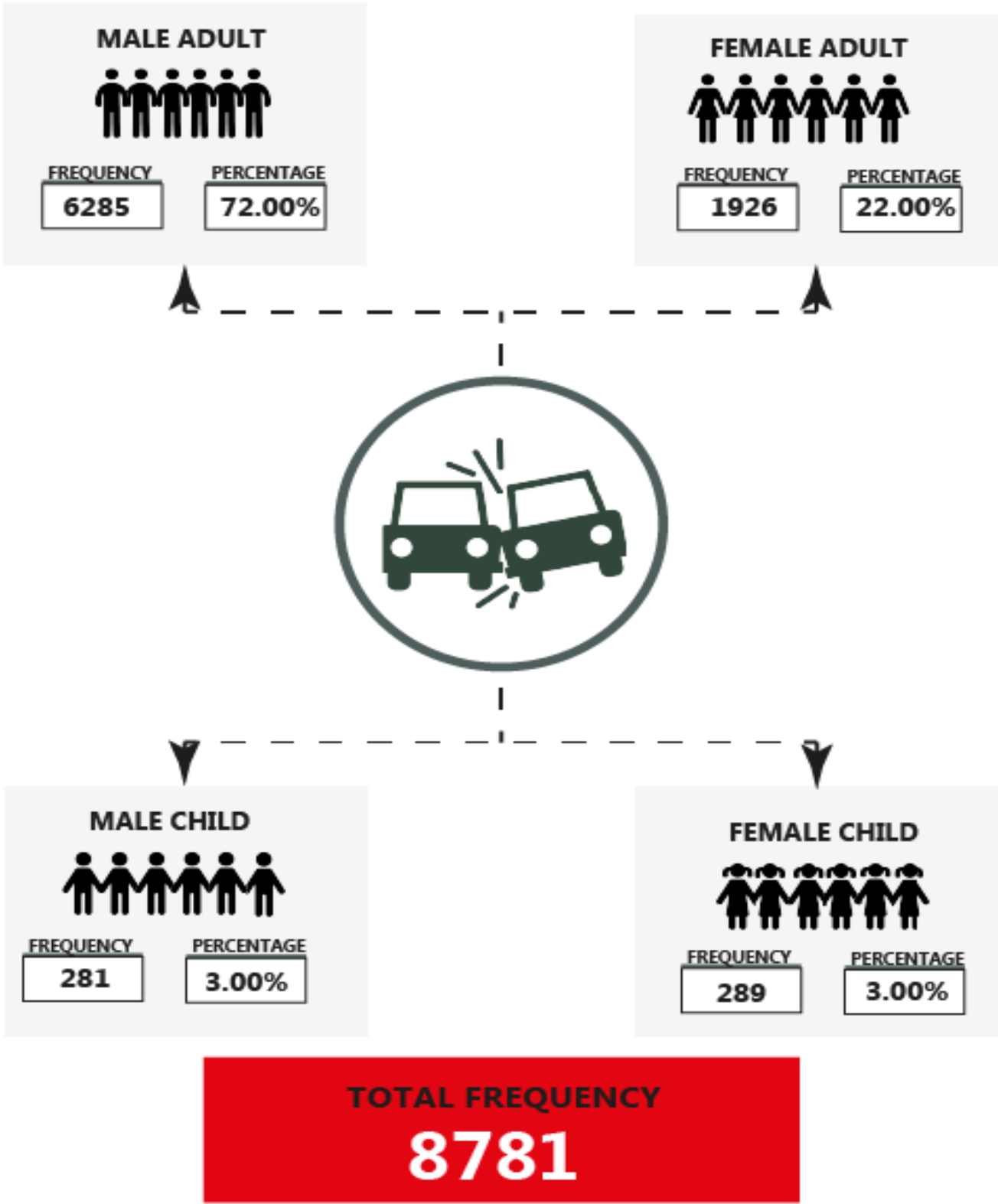

In Road Traffic Crashes



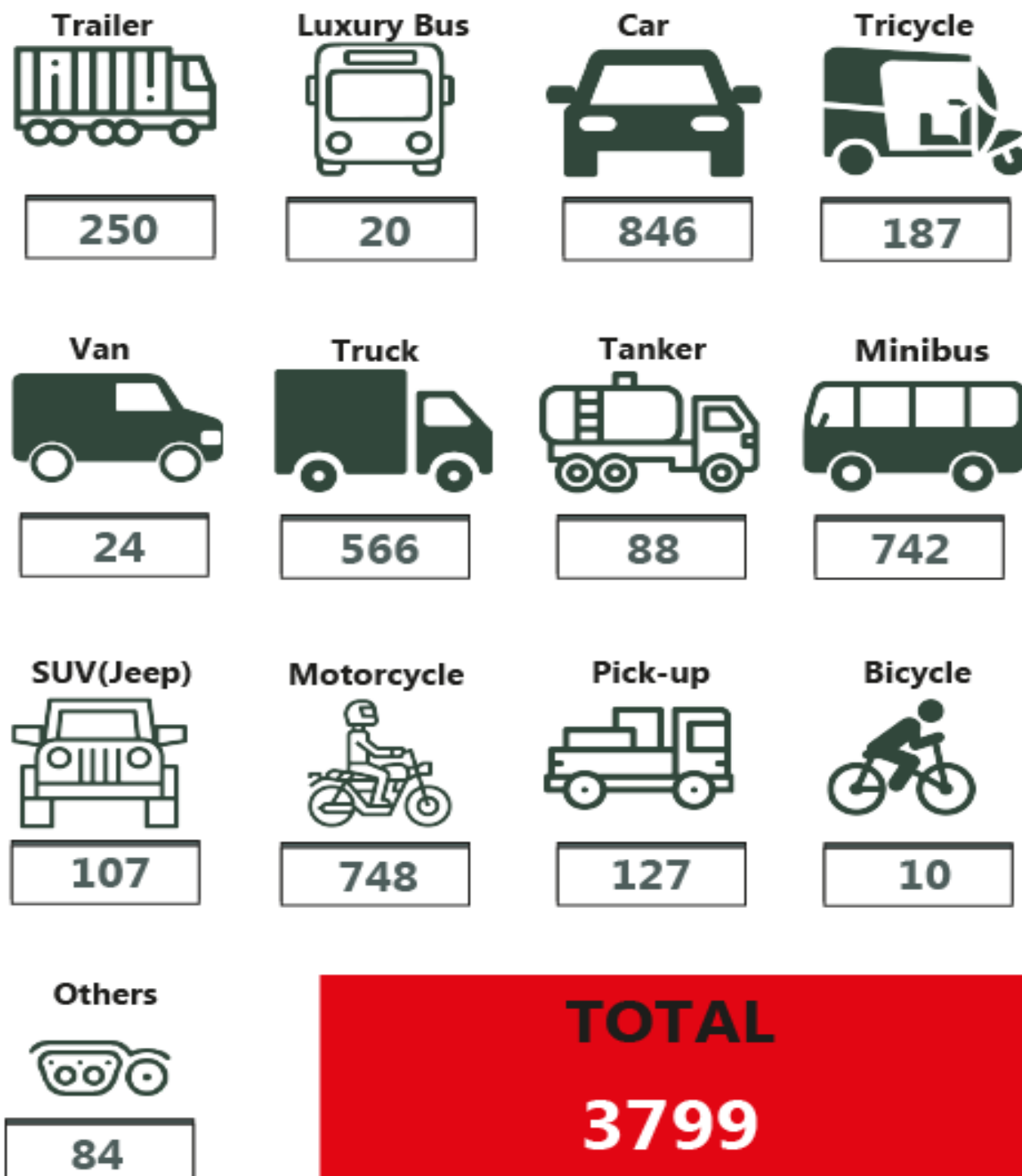

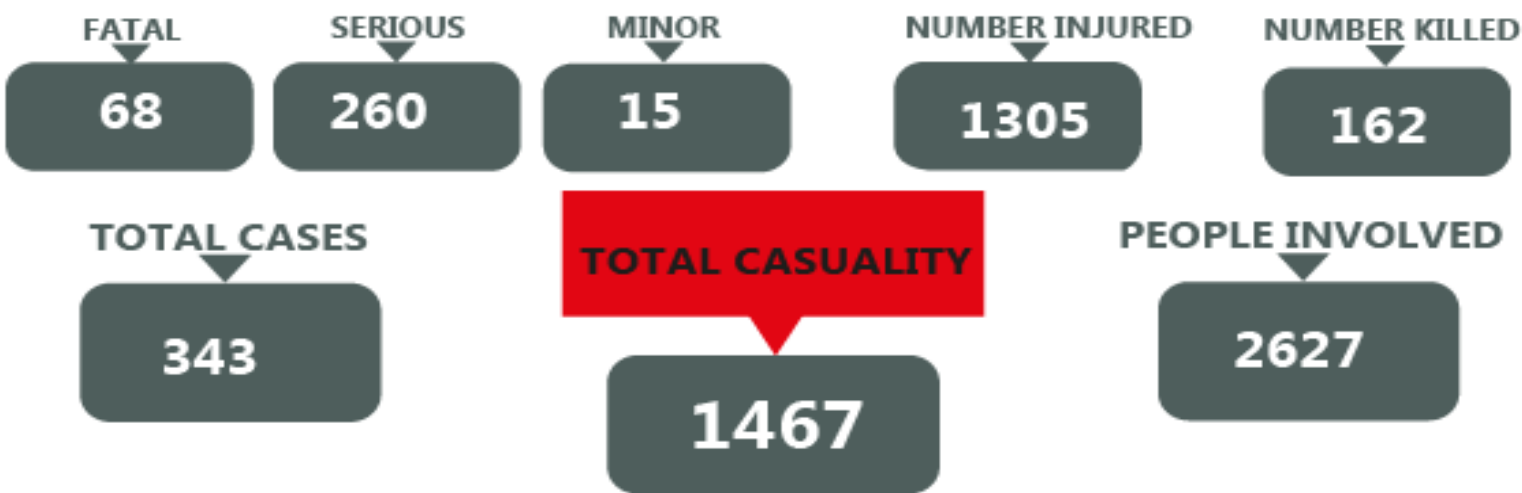

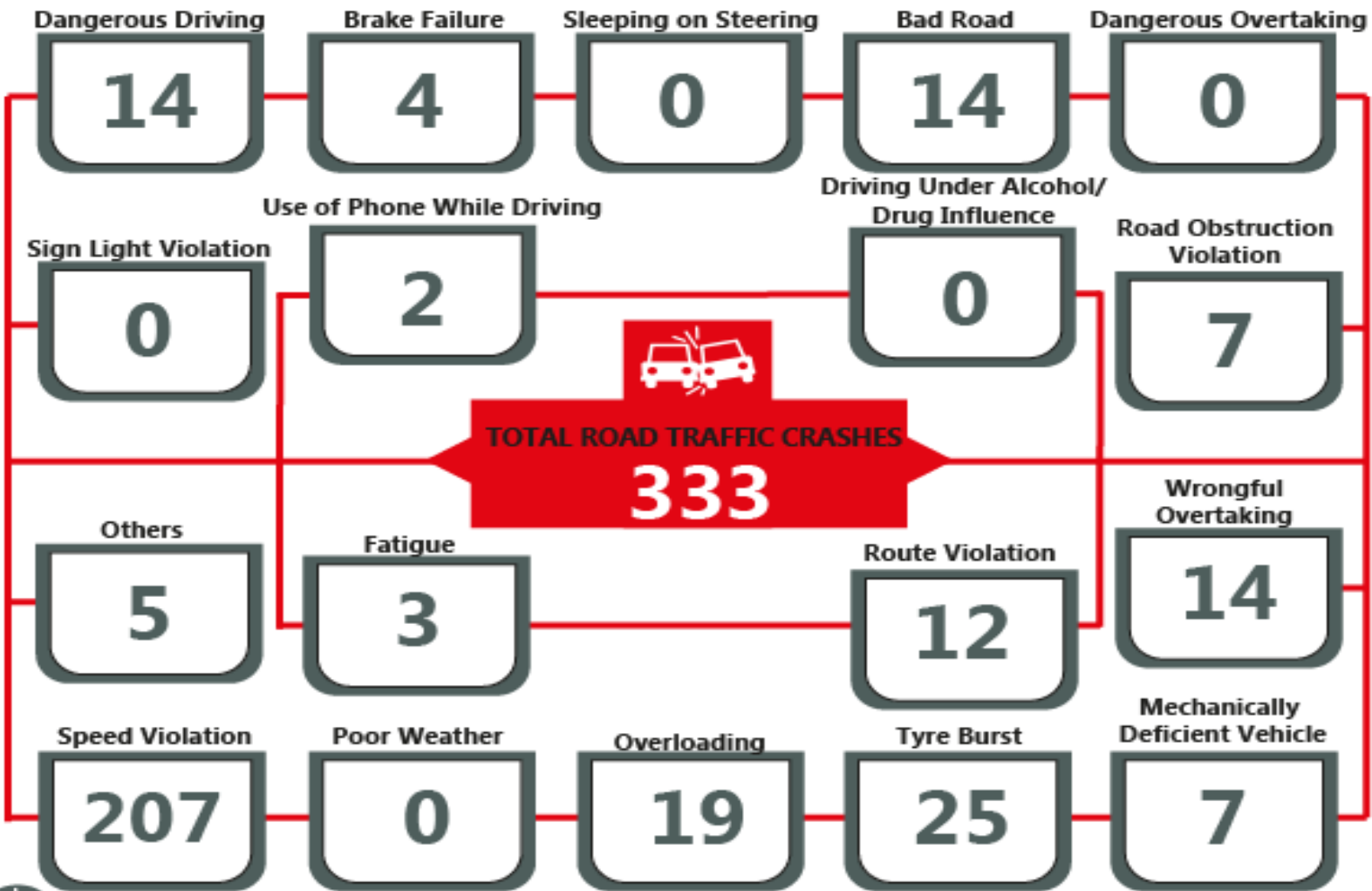

CAUSATIVE FACTORS OF ROAD TRAFFIC CRASHES, Q4 2024

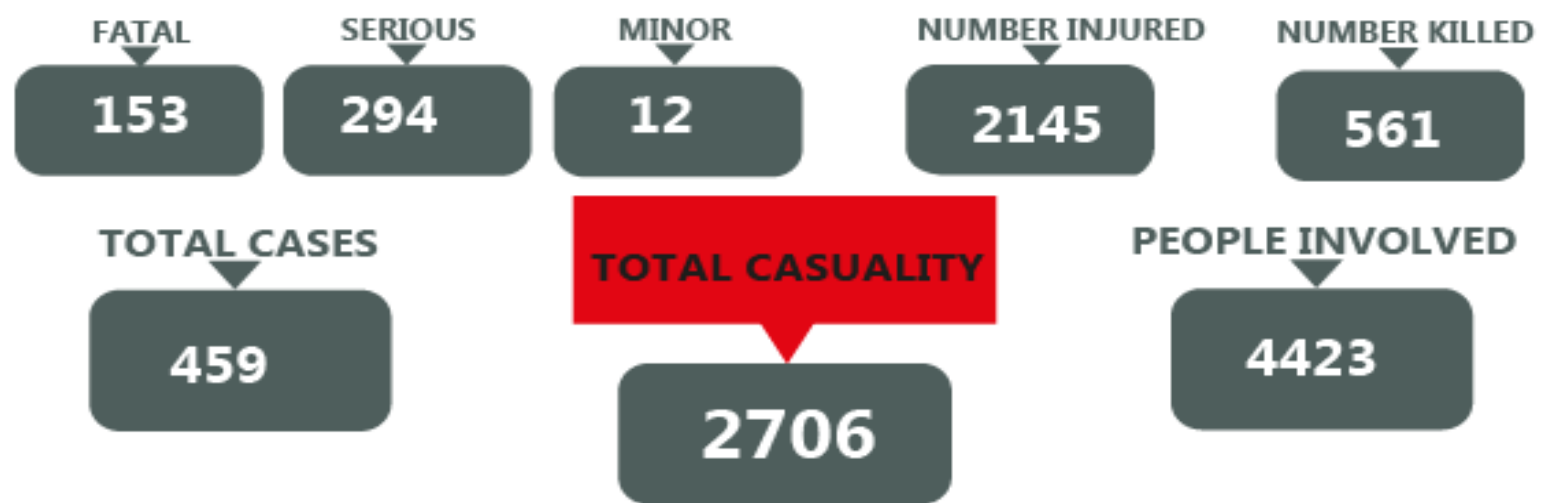

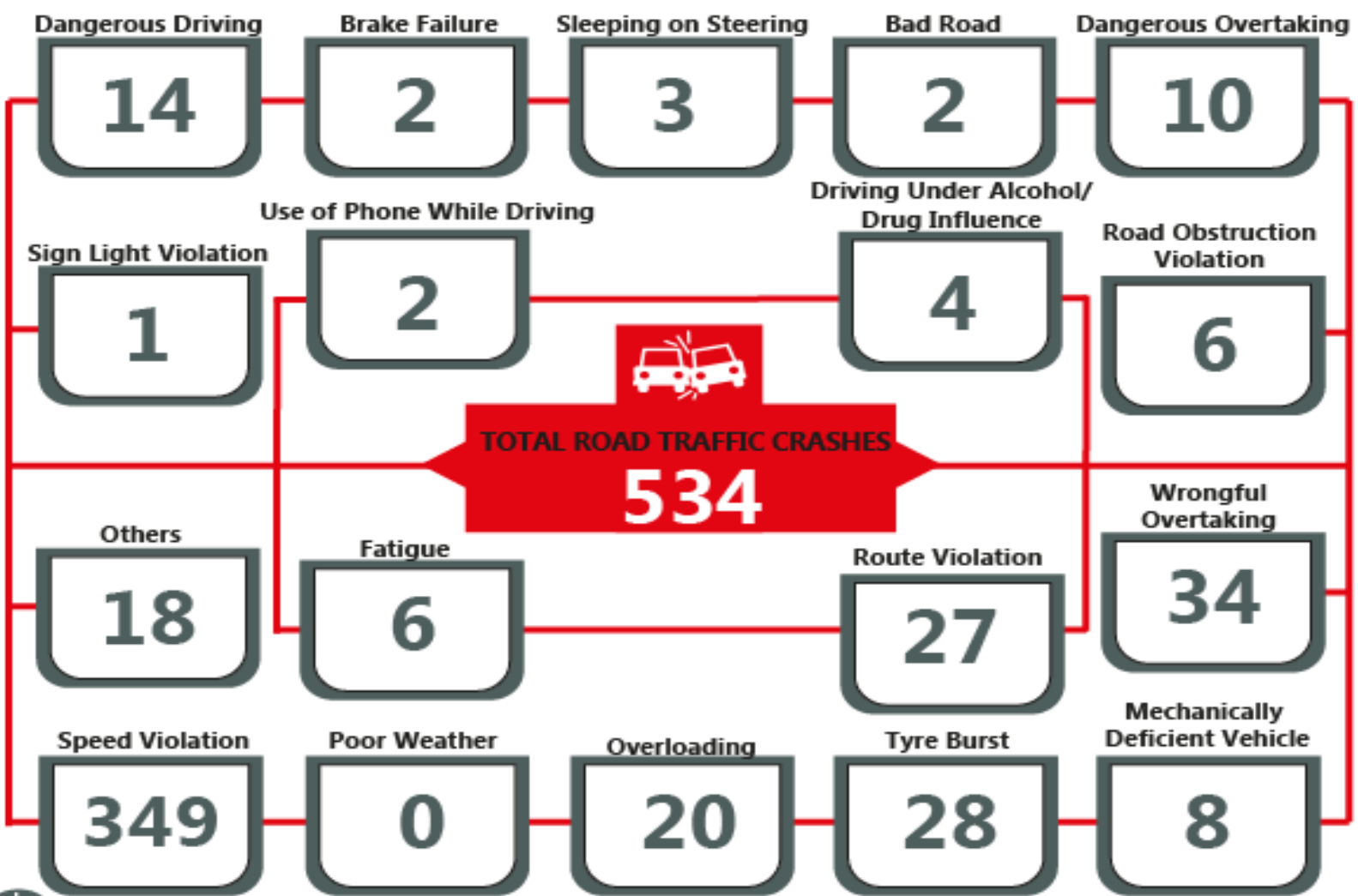

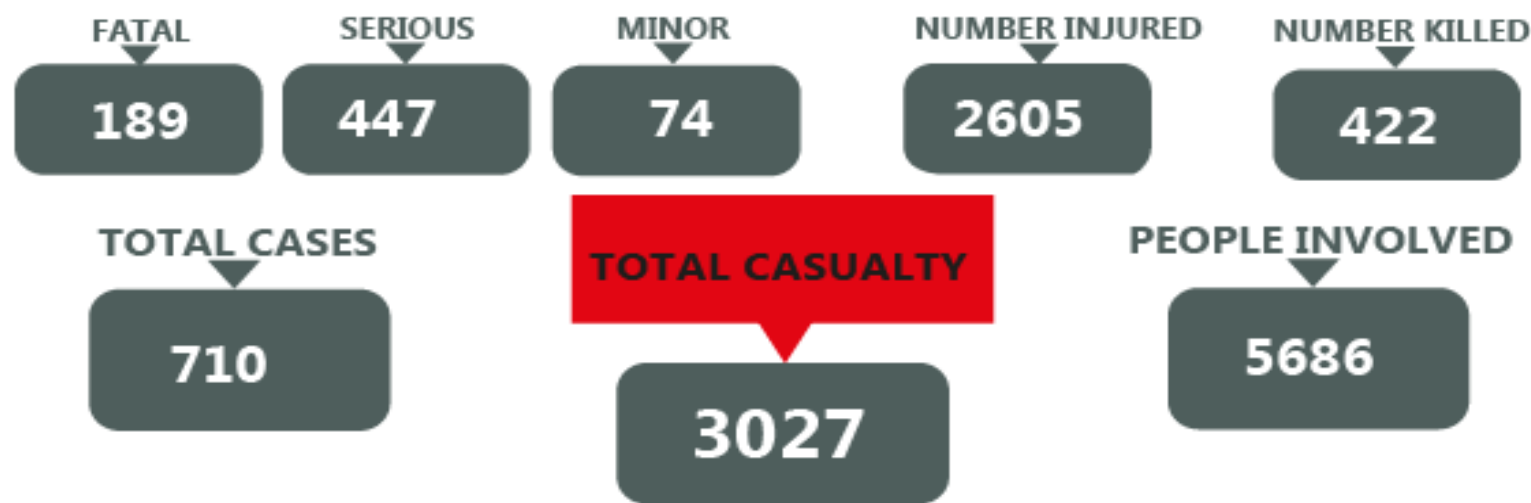

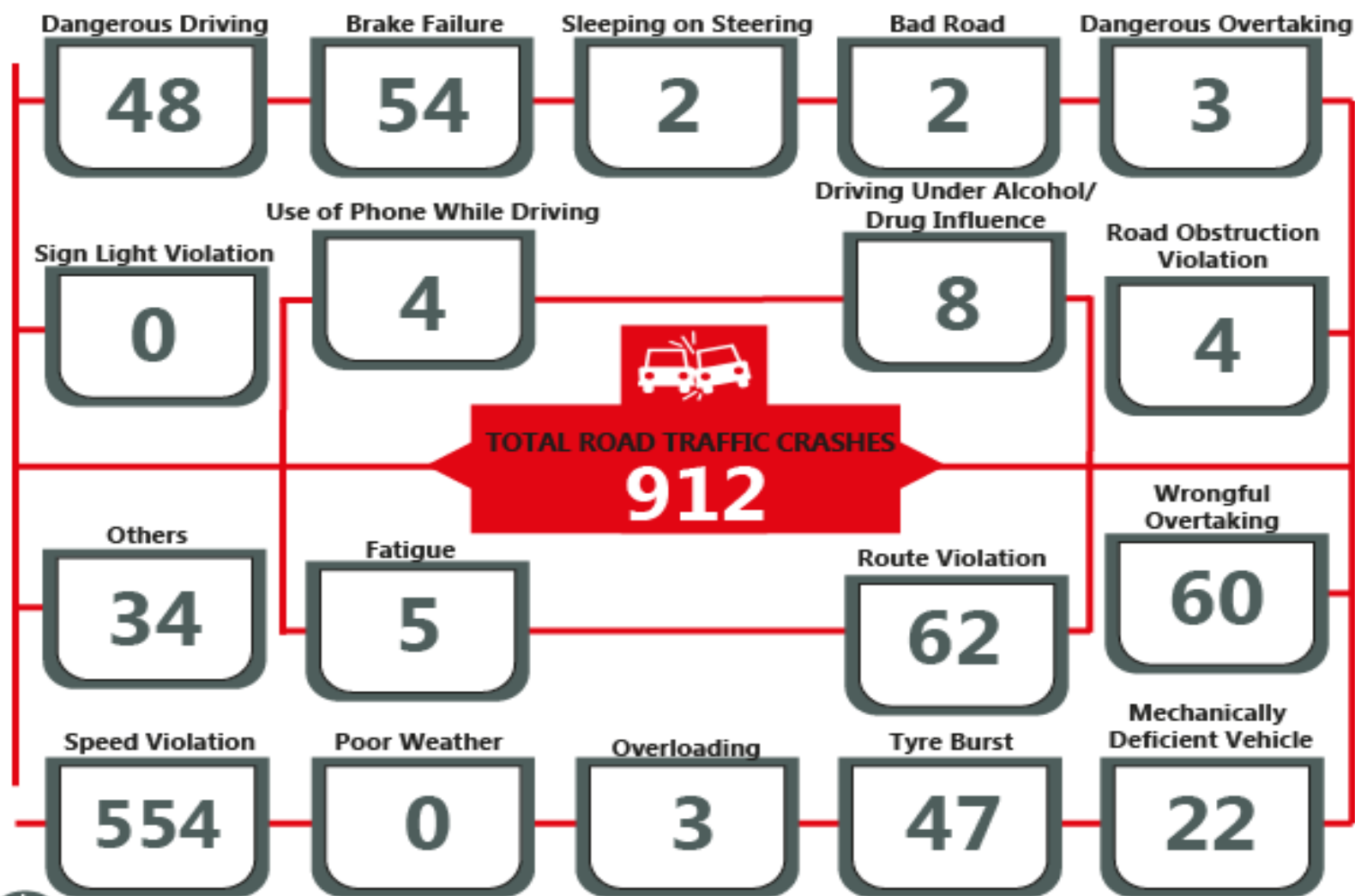

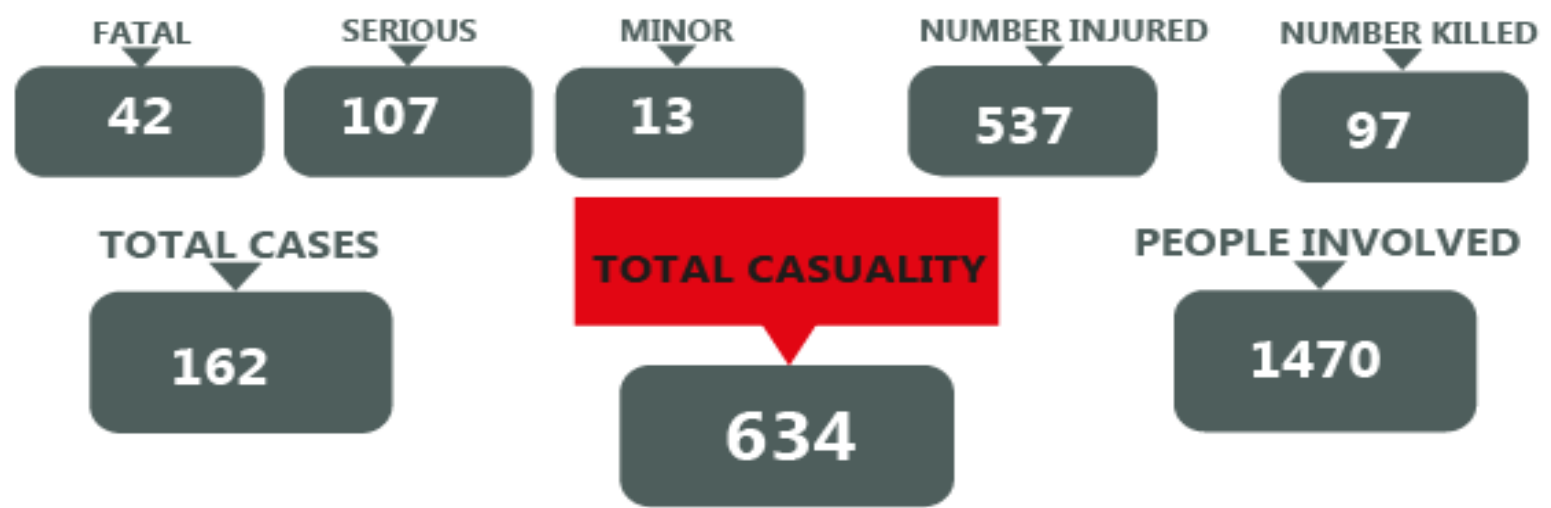

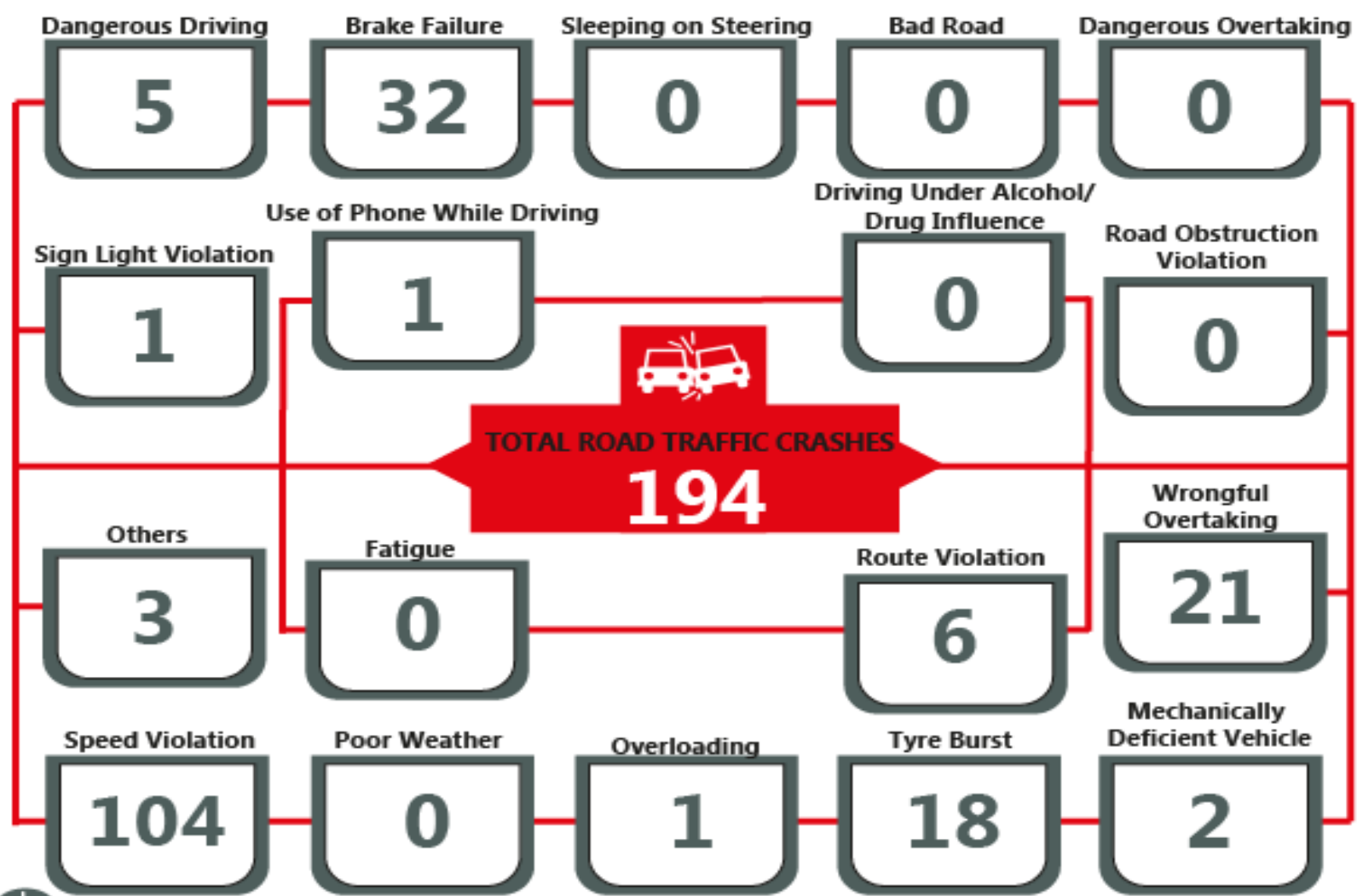

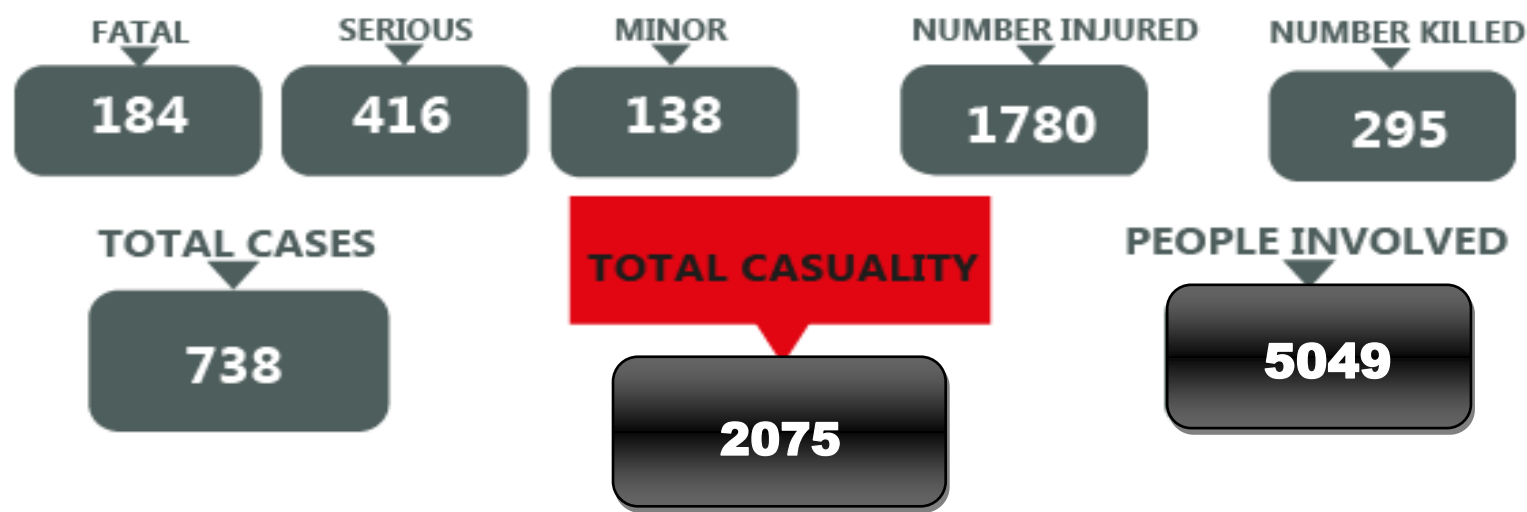

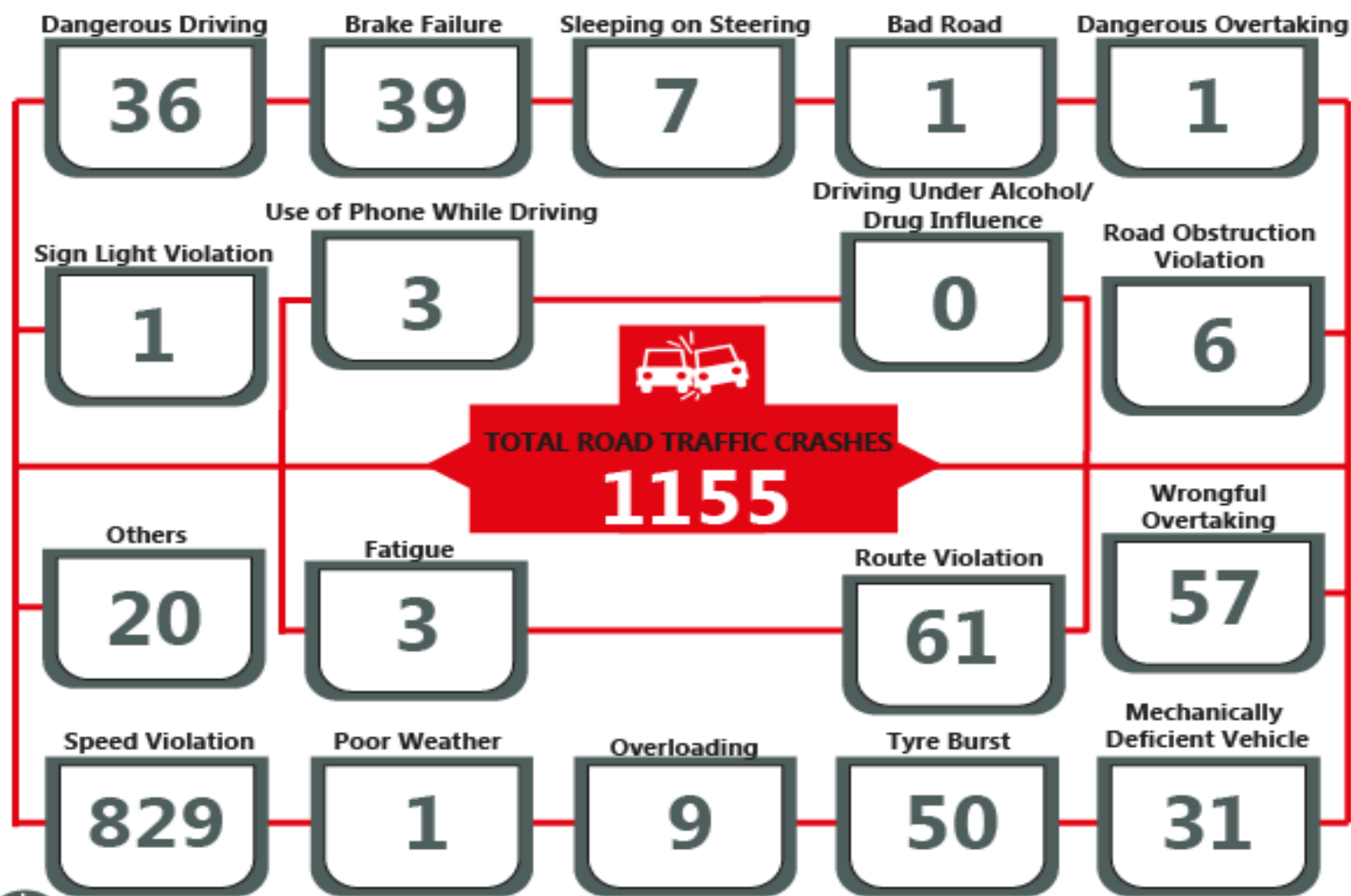

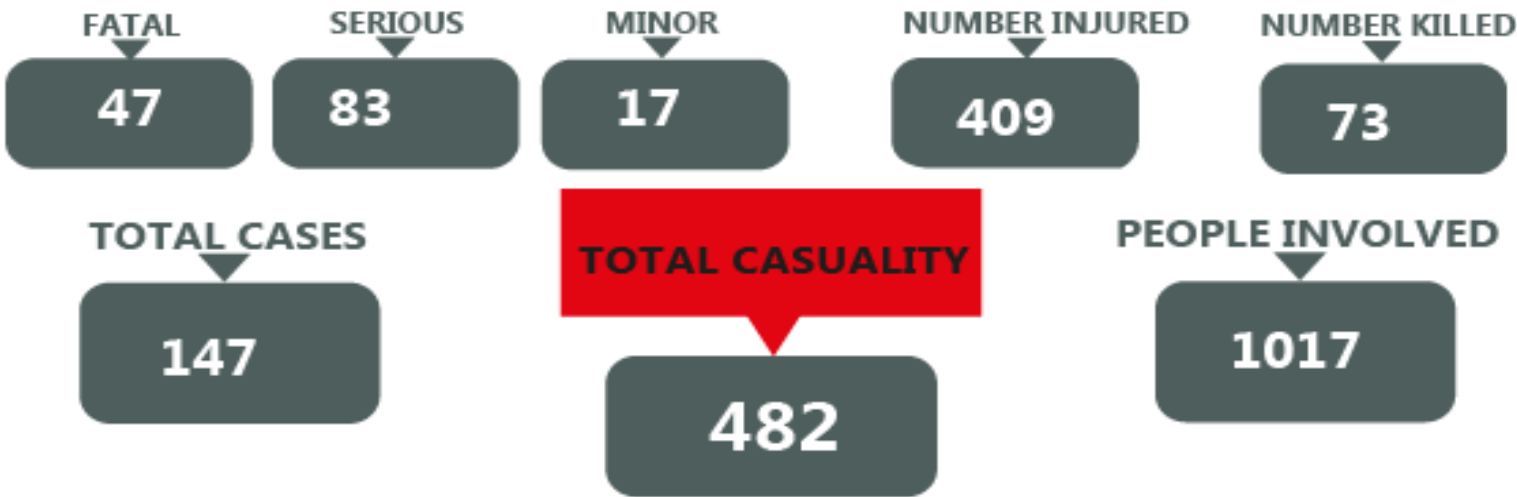

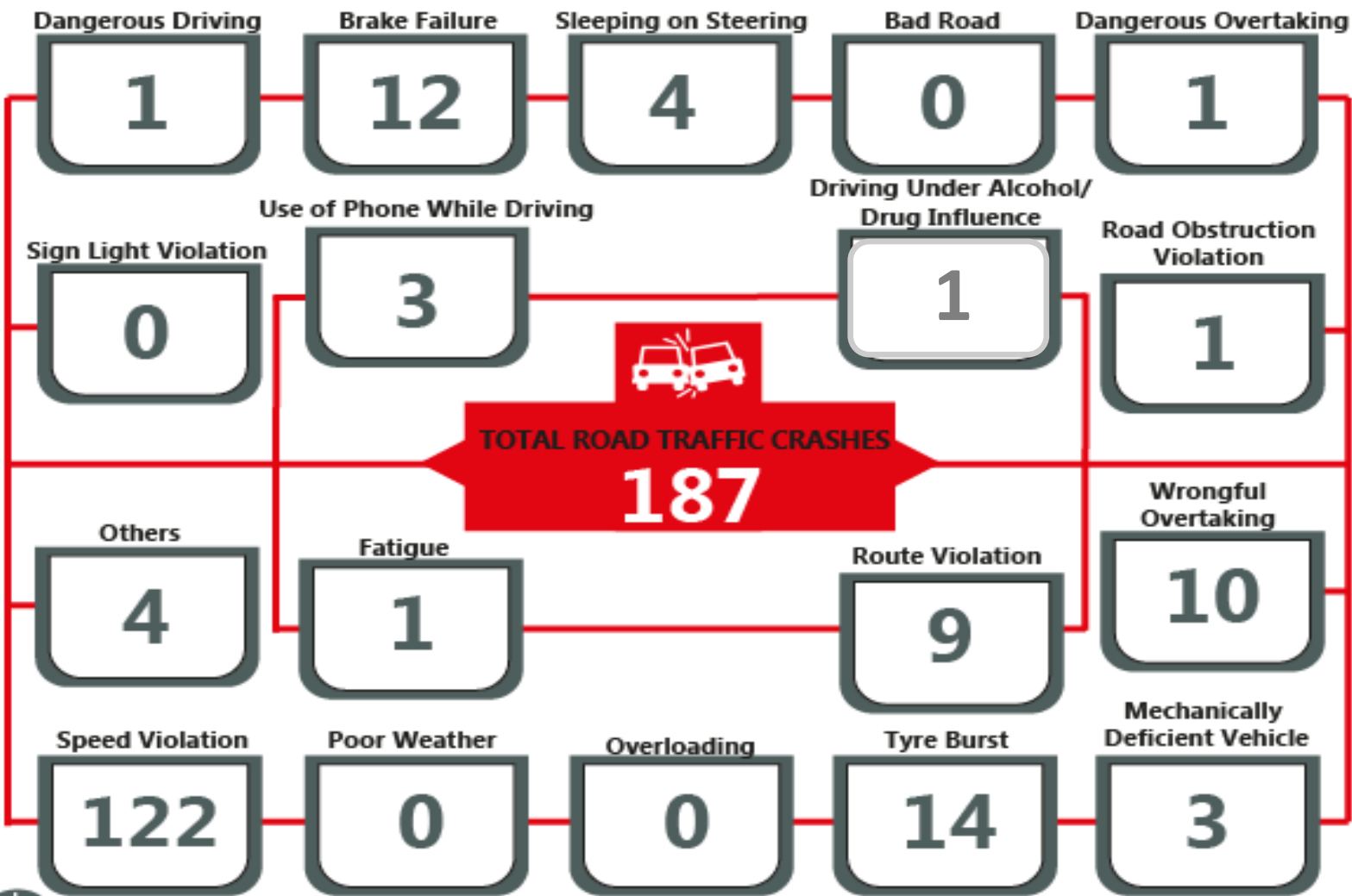
