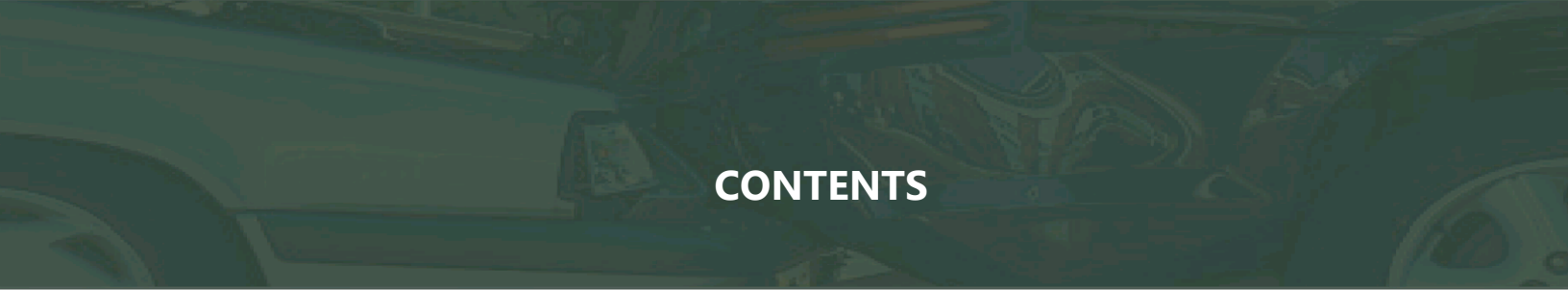

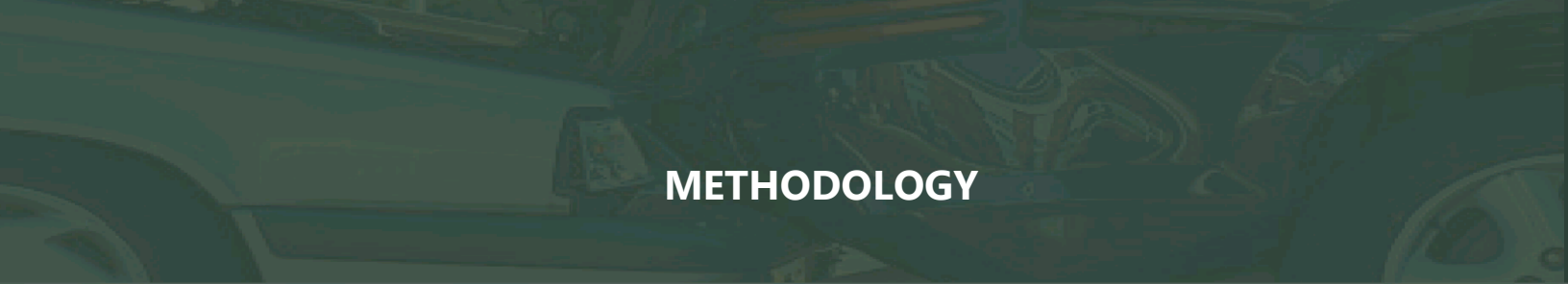

Data is provided by the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), and reported by the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS)

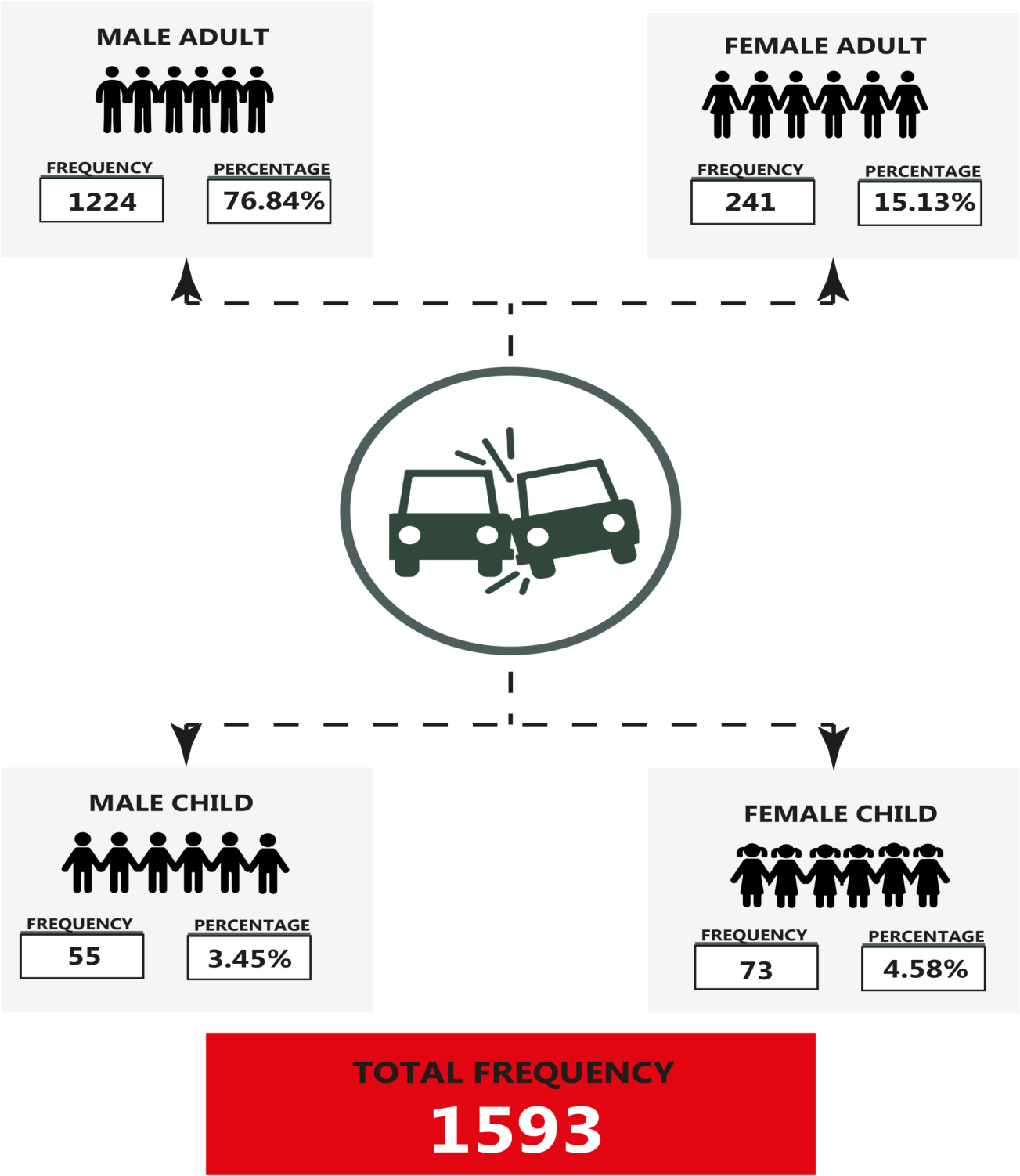
KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- The total number of road traffic crashes in Q1 2025 was 2,650 which indicates a 3.56% from the 2,559 crashes recorded in the previous quarter, and a 0.45% decrease from the 2,662 recorded in Q1 2024.
- Of all crashes, serious cases stood top in Q1 2025 with 1,704 compared to fatal and minor cases with 706 and 240 respectively. .
- A total of 1,279 males were killed in Q1 2025 accounts for 80.29%. While the total female killed were 314 and represents 19.71% of the total death recorded
- During the period, 7,171 males were injured, this indicates 77%, while 2,127 females were reported injured and represents 23% of the total injured person
- A total of 3,895 vehicles were involved in road traffic crashes
- The North-Central zone recorded the highest number of crashes in Q1 2025 with 803 followed by the South-West with 722, while the South-South had the least with 152. Similarly, the North-Central reported the highest number of casualties with 3,418 followed by the South-West with 1,930, while the South-South recorded the least with 488.

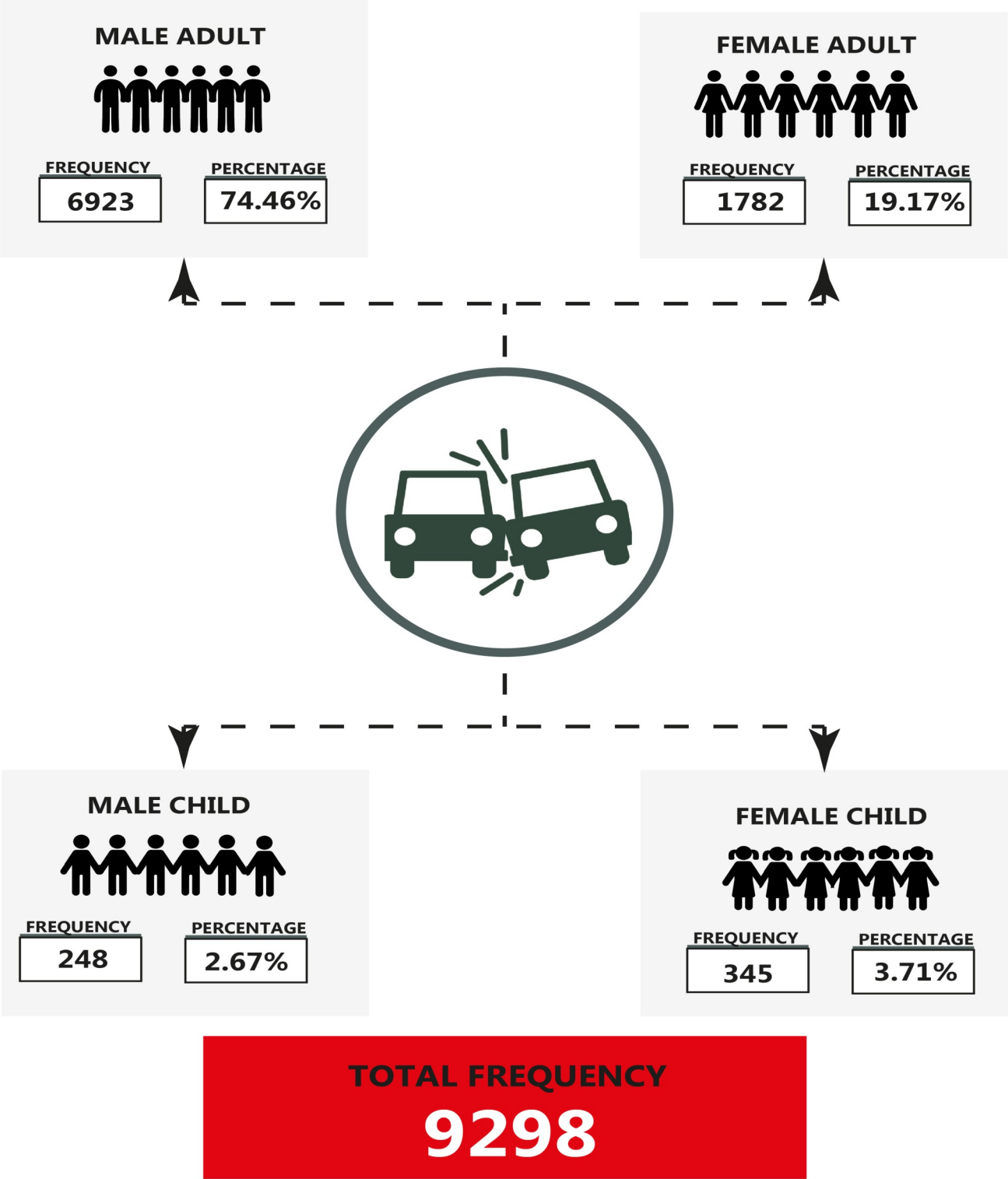

In Road Traffic Crashes



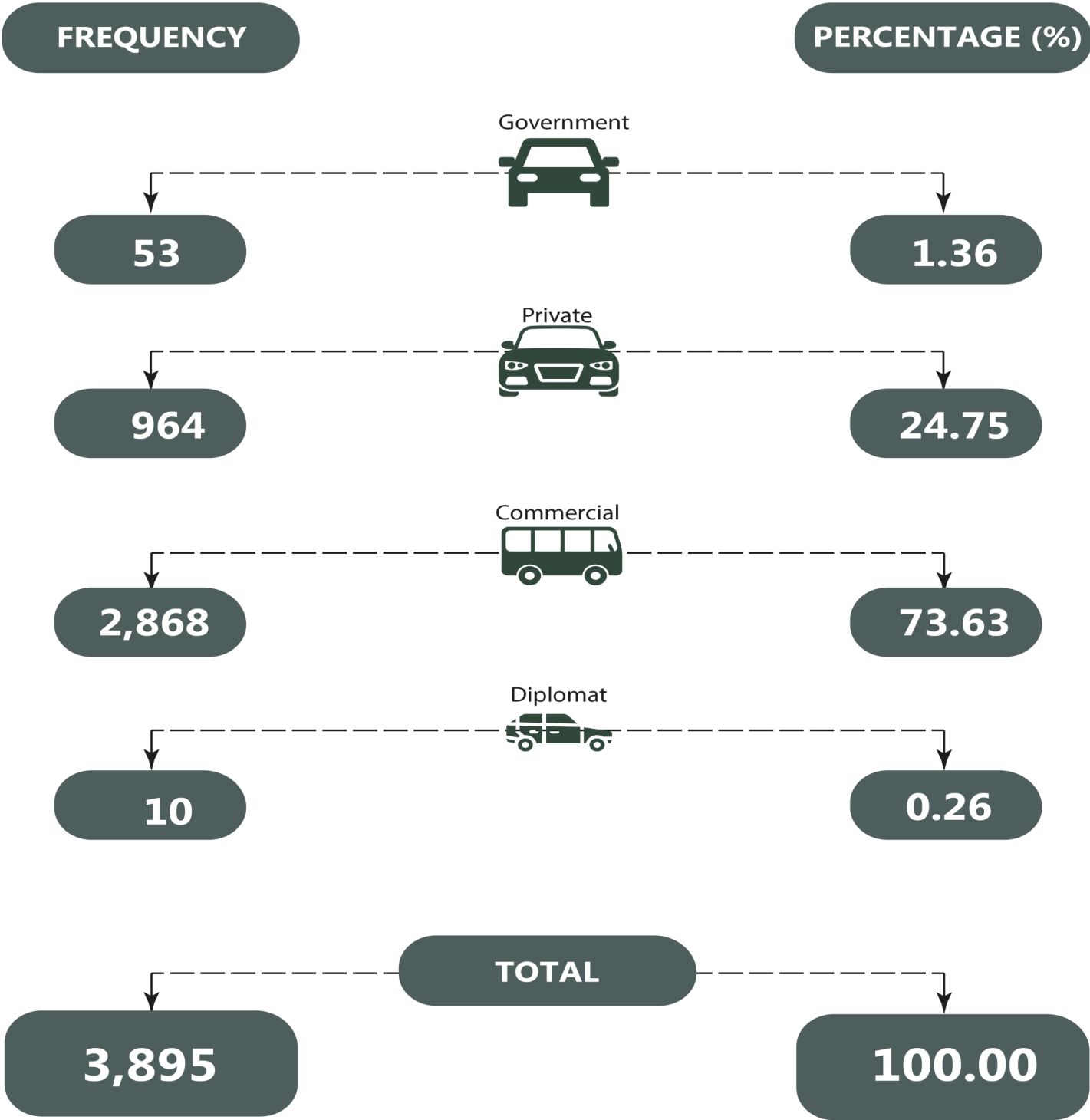

In Road Traffic Crashes



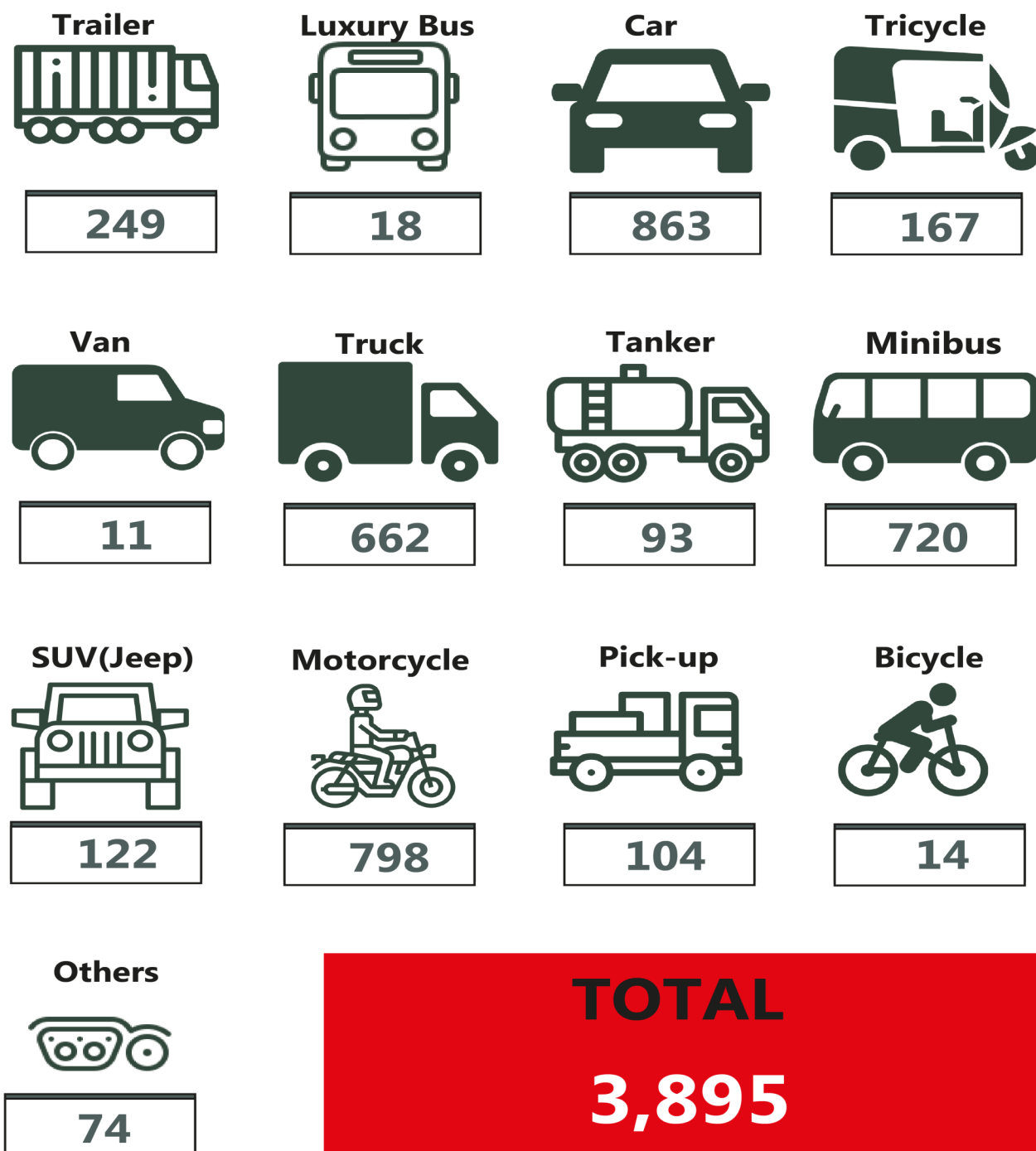

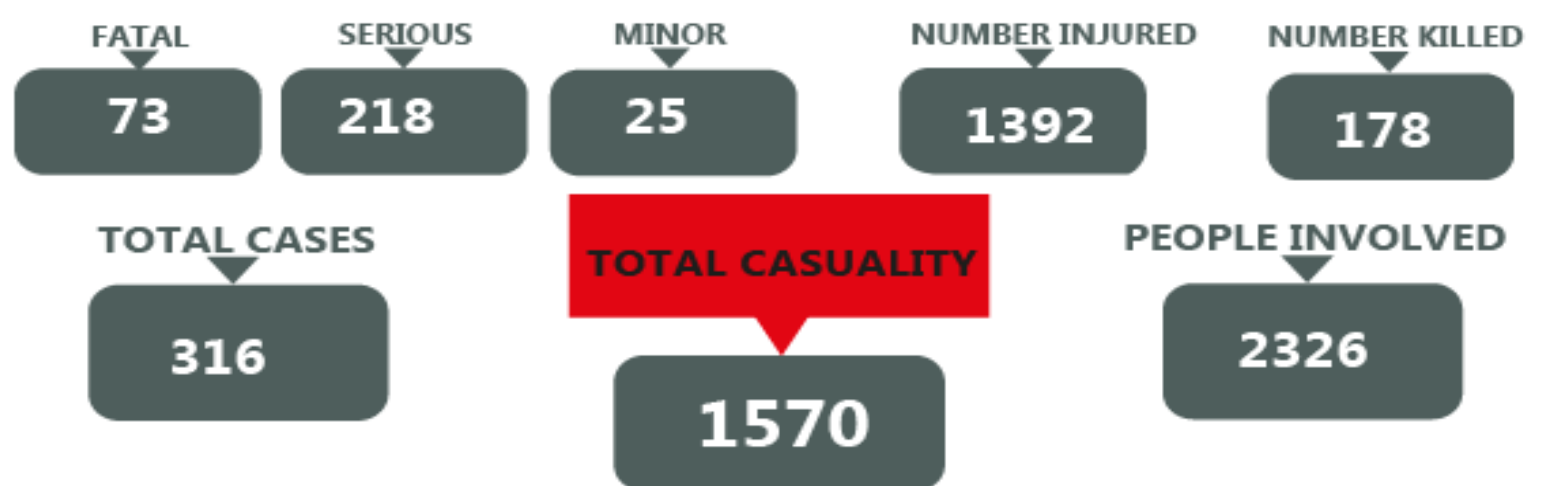

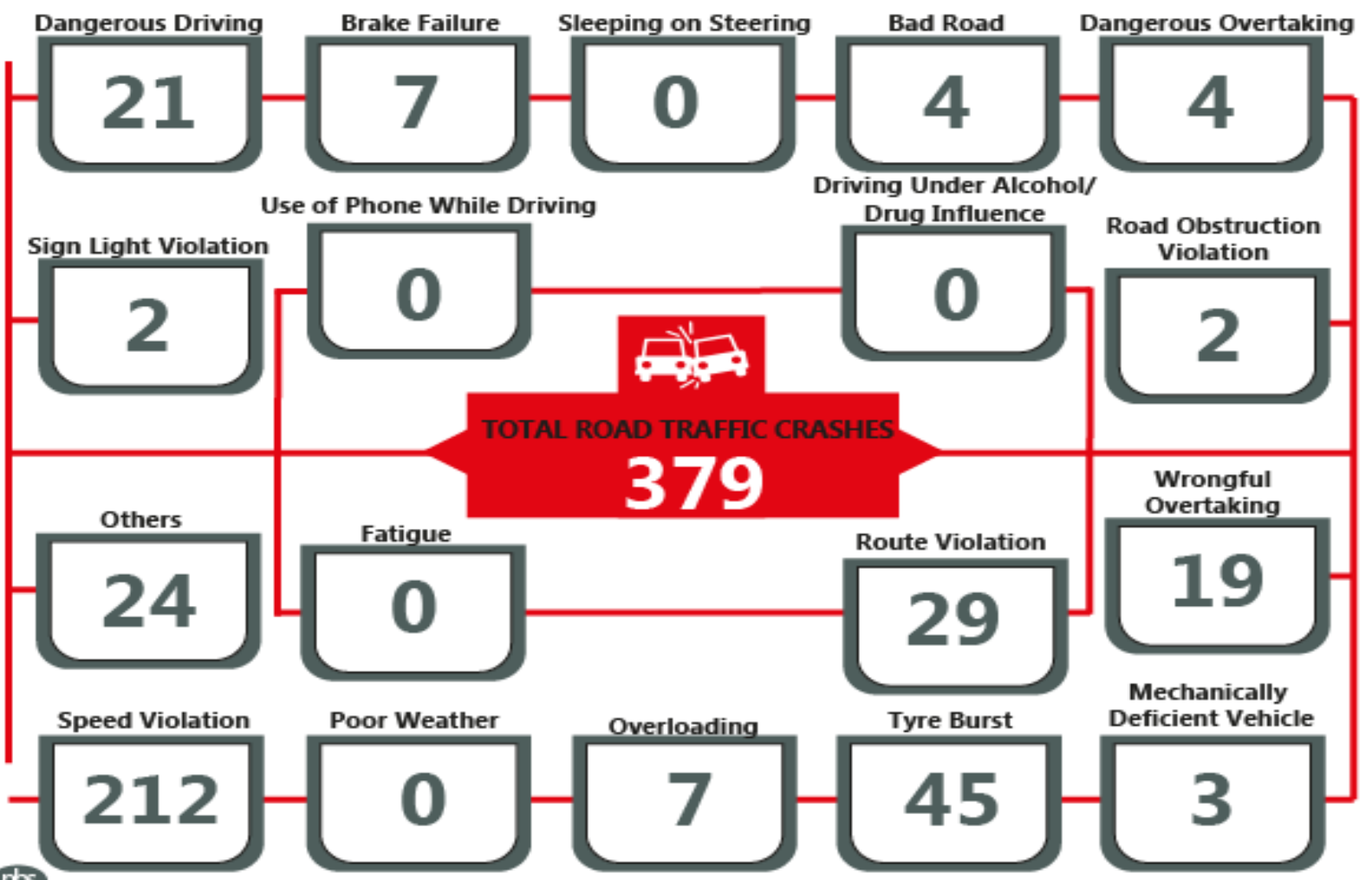

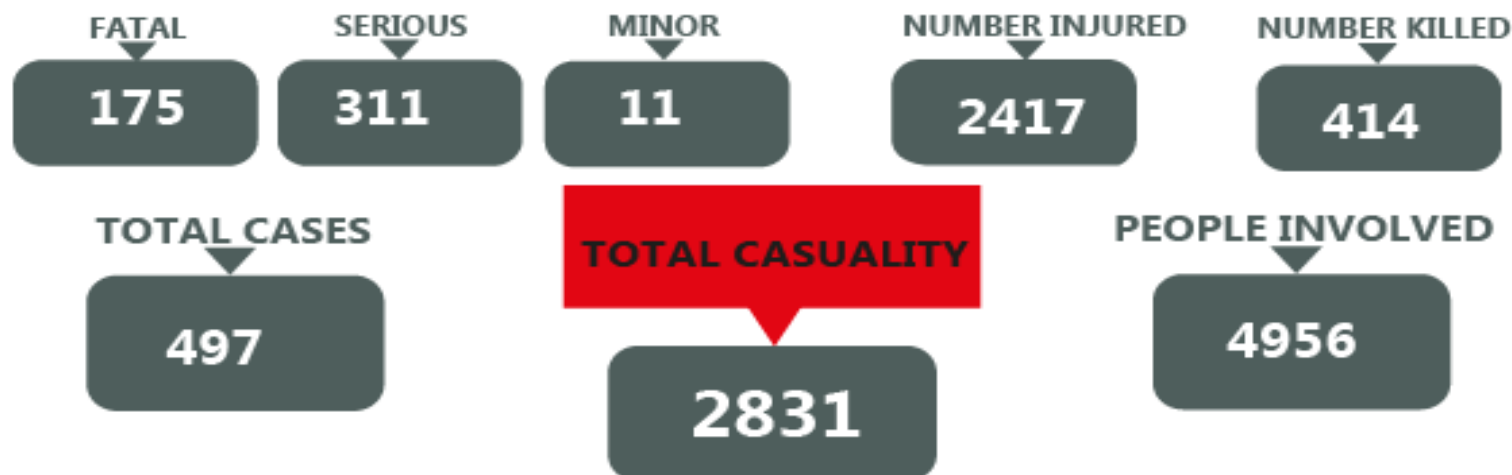

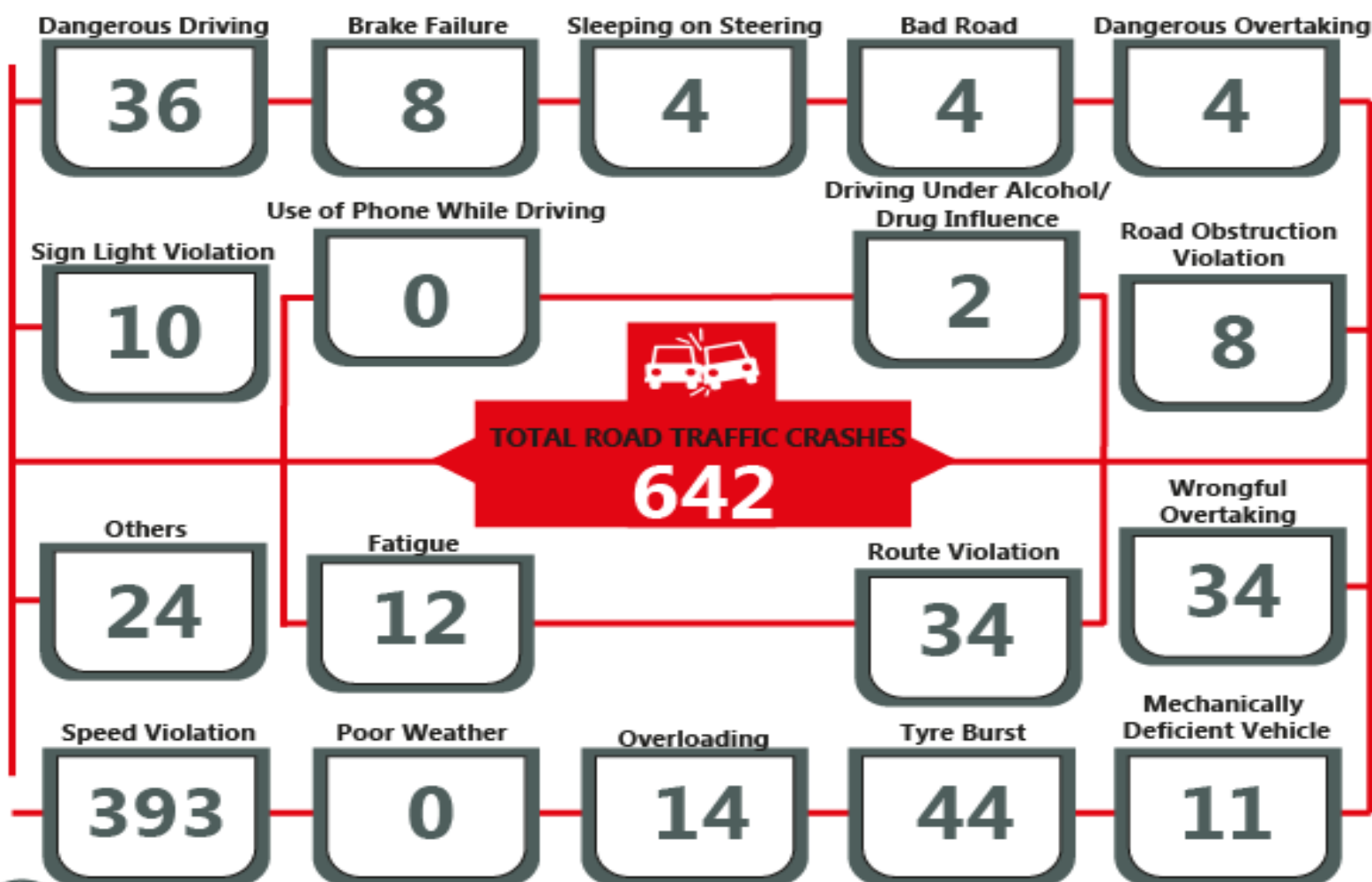

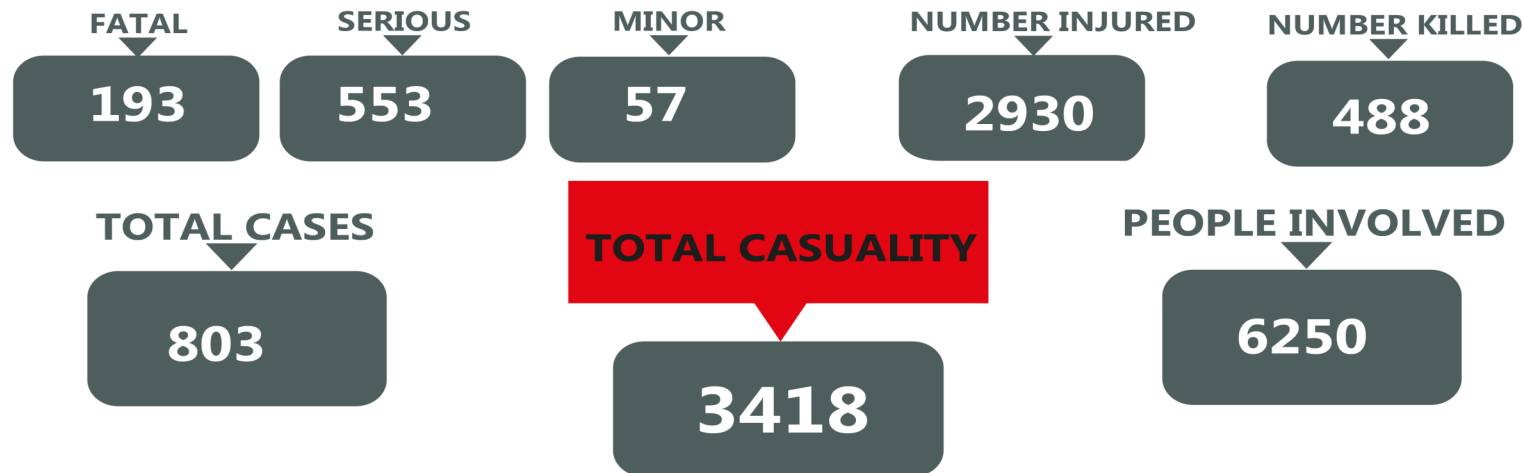

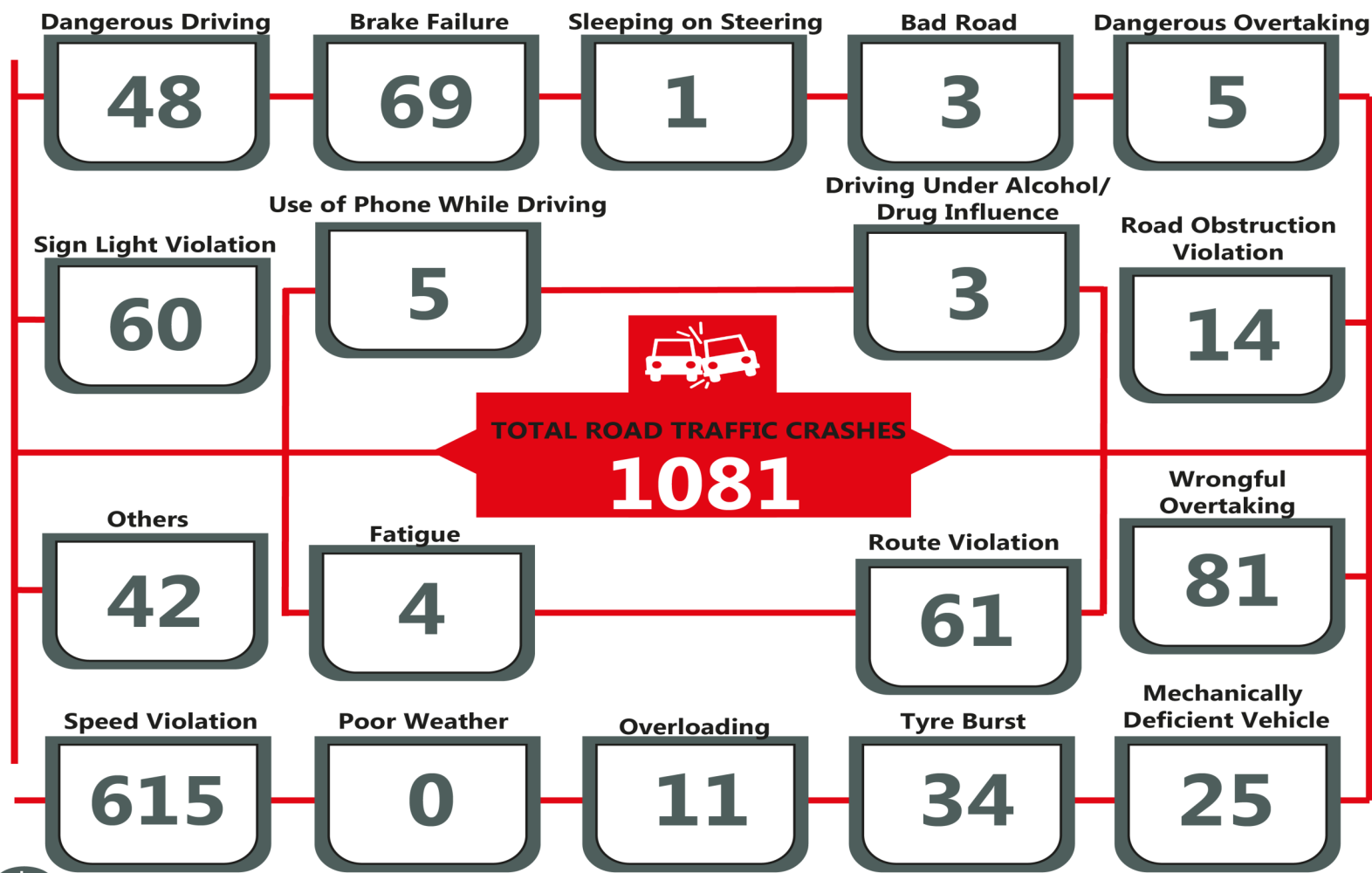

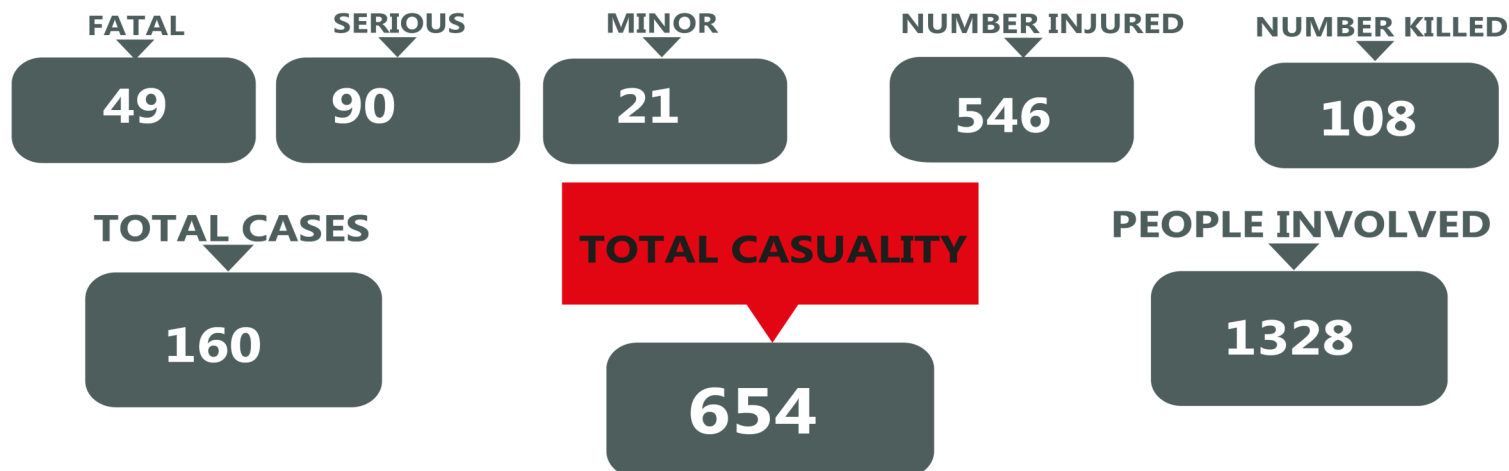

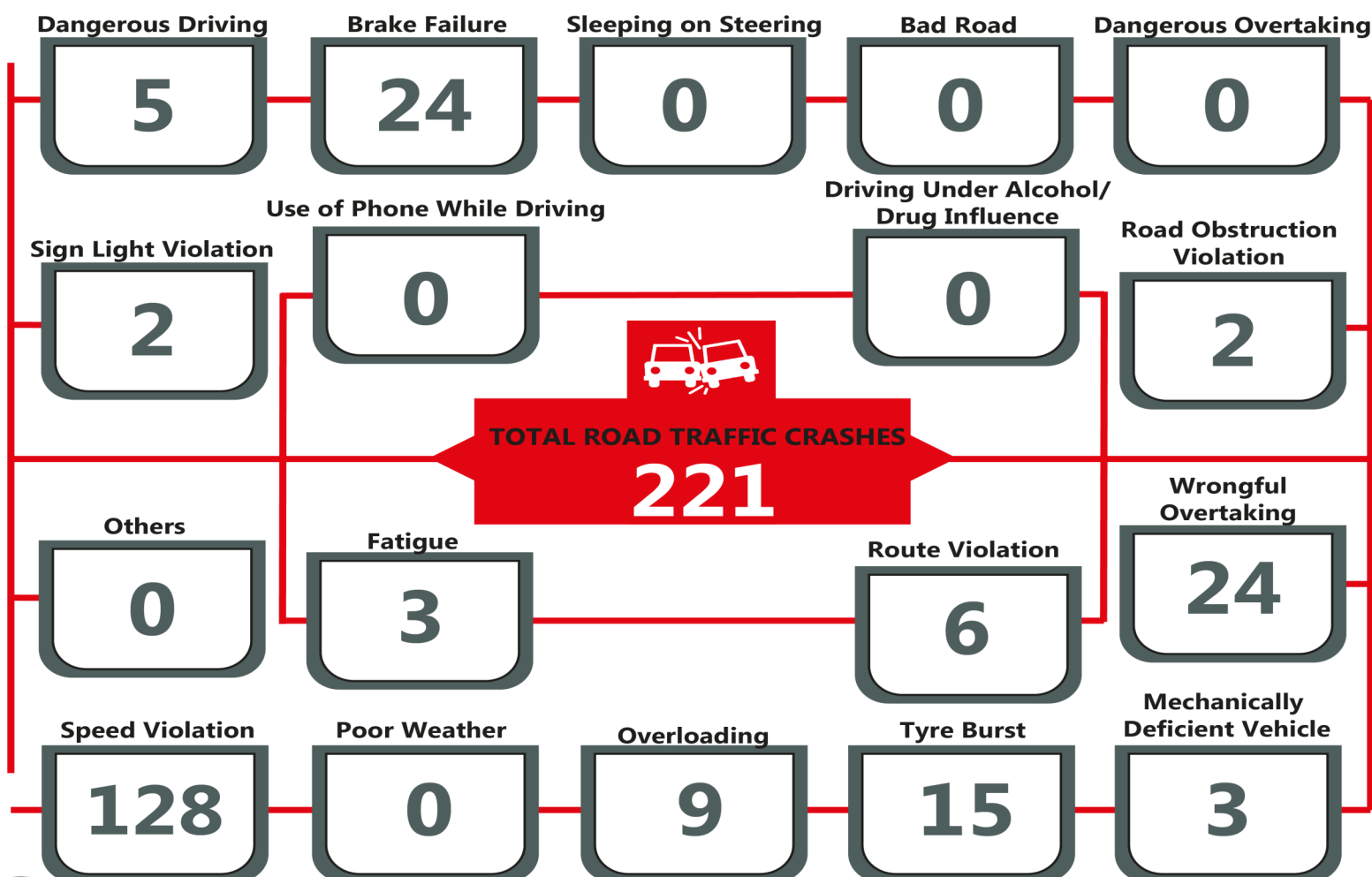

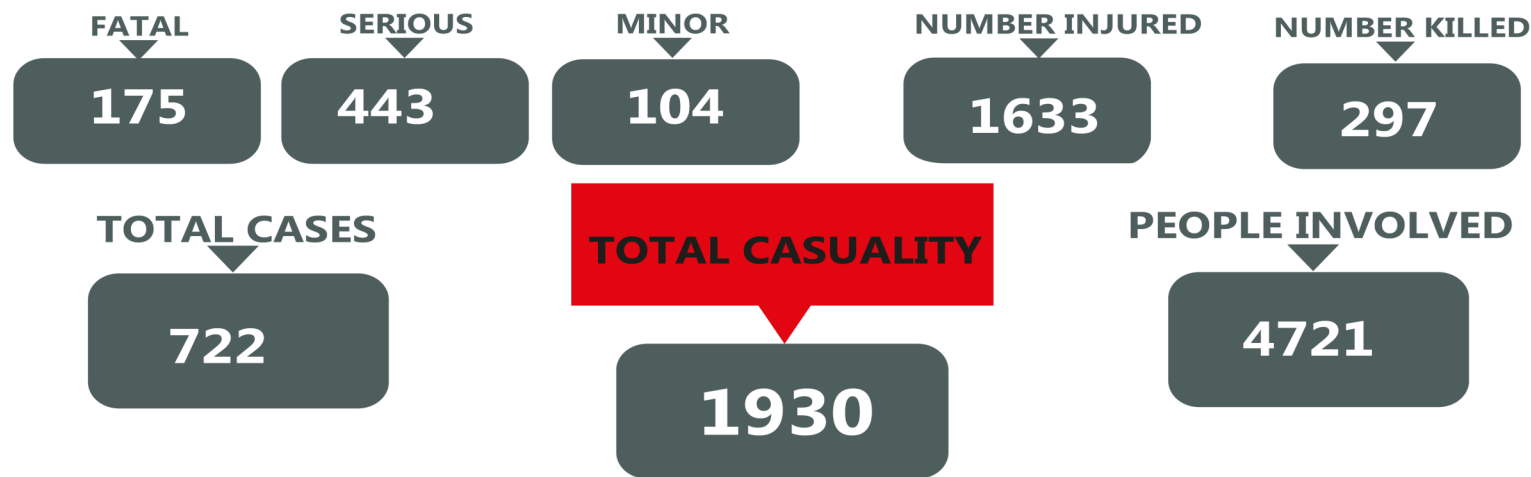

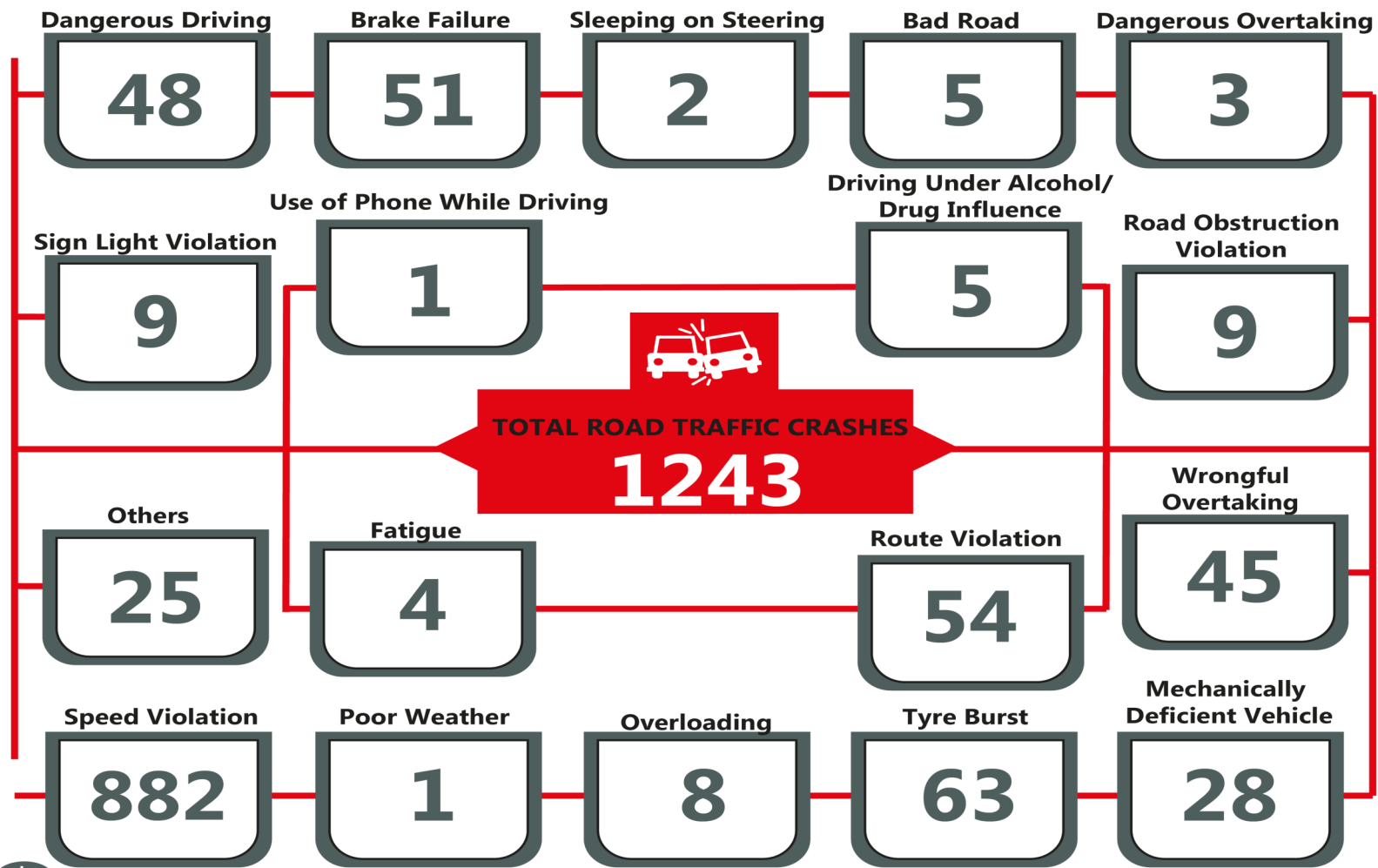

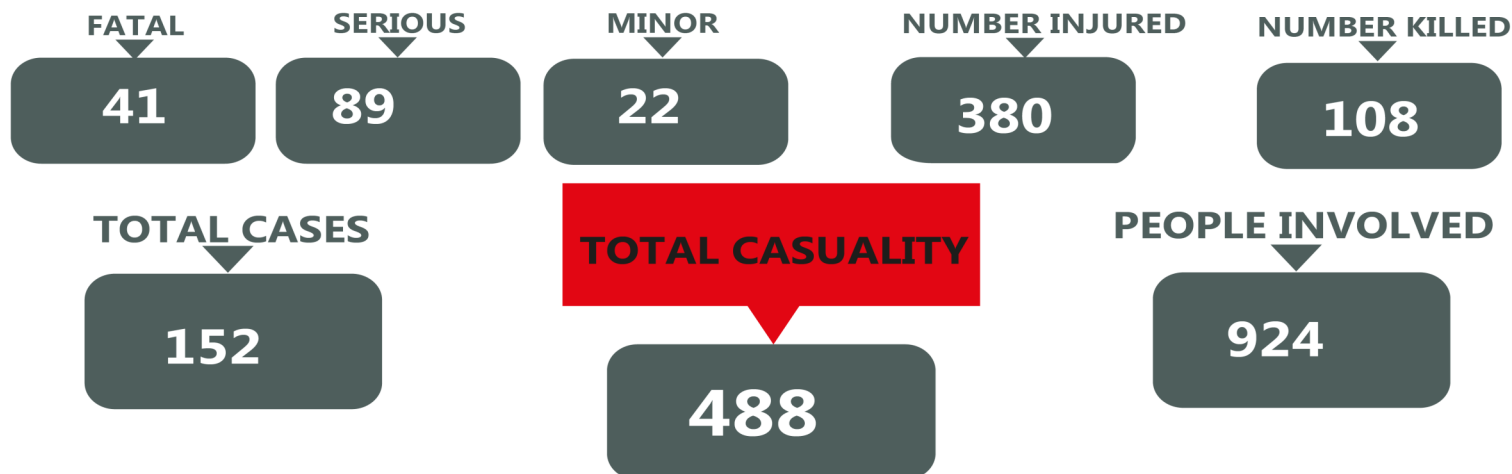

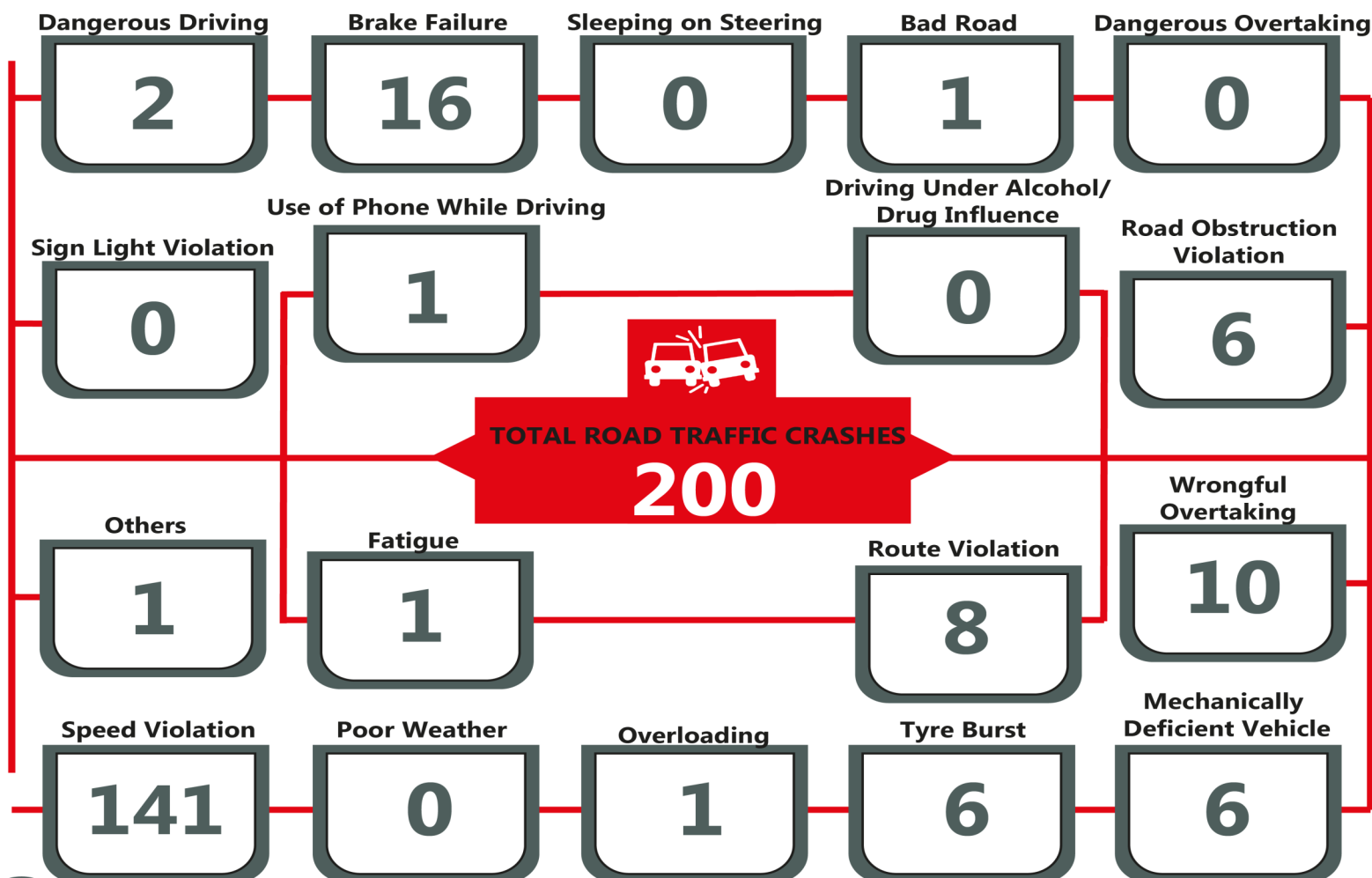
