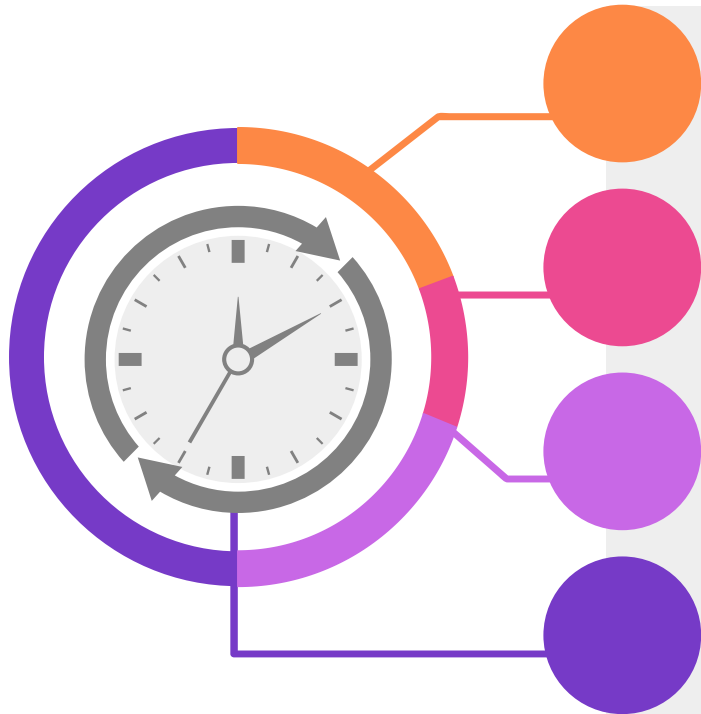

INTRODUCTION

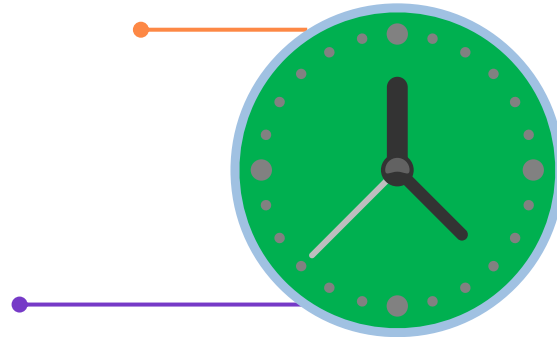
- In today's world, understanding how people allocate their time is crucial for policy makers and researchers who seek to address the demands of Nigeria's diverse population



- NBS conducted a successful Pilot time -use survey in 1998 but was unable to proceed due to lack of funding
- There is an urgent need for a national Time Use Survey to inform evidence based policy and promoting social-economic development

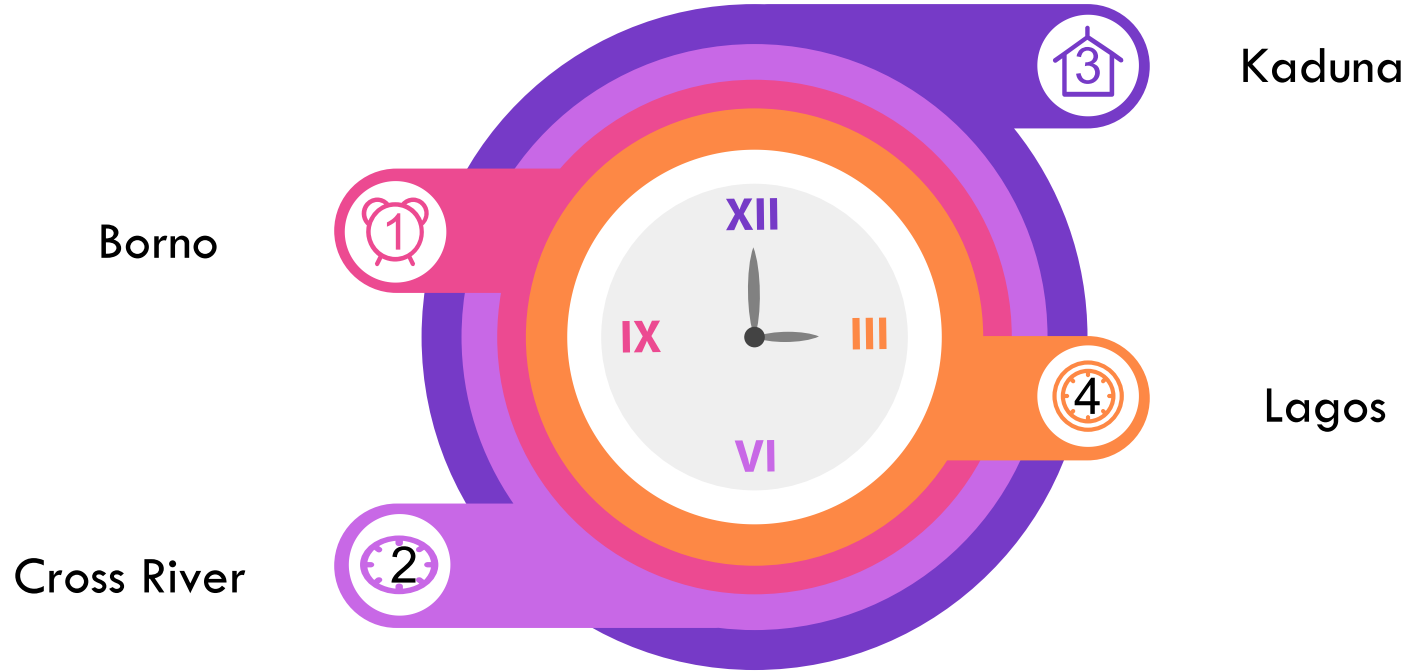
OBJECTIVES

- The specific objectives are to:
 - ✓ Generate data on the amount of time people spend on paid and unpaid care work.
 - ✓ Provide information on the amount of time spent on
 - working activities
 - socializing
 - exercising
 - religious activities
 - relaxing, etc.
 - ✓ Provide data for the development of
 - ✓ a multi-level nested disaggregation analysis
 - ✓ satellite account for households in the System of National Accounts (SNA)



COVERAGE

- Four (4) states will be covered



- The Enumeration Areas to be covered will cut across urban and rural areas

SCOPE

Areas of interest for this exercise;

HOUSEHOLD QUESTIONNAIRE:

- Identification
- List of Household Members
- Difficulty in Performing Activities
- Household Characteristics
- Agricultural Household
- Household Earnings

INDIVIDUAL QUESTIONNAIRE:

- Identification
- Education and ICT Use
- Agricultural Land Ownership and Tenure Rights
- Health
- Access to Social Protection Programs
- Perception Based questions

24 HOURS TIME USE DIARY QUESTIONNAIRE



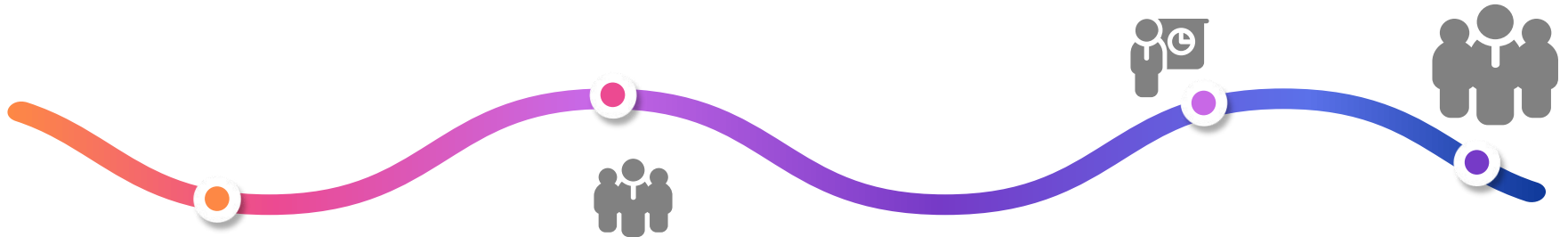
SAMPLE DESIGN

- FRAME
 - ✓ The frame of digitized enumeration areas by National Population Commission will be used
- A Two-stage sampling technique will be adopted
- First stage is the selection of EAs
 - ✓ 30 EAs will be selected in each state for this season
 - ✓ A systematic random sampling of 120 EAs will be canvassed across the 4 states
- Second Stage is the selection of households
 - ✓ 15 HHs will be scientifically selected in each EA
 - ✓ 450 HHs will be interviewed in each state
 - ✓ In this Survey, 1800 HHs will be covered in the 4 states



CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- Eligible household members to be interviewed will be 15 years and above
- Kish Grid will be used to select eligible male and female in each HH to be interviewed
- If eligible members are of the same sex, Kish Grid will select the two members of the same gender to be interviewed
- Where there is only 1 eligible in a household he or she should be interviewed



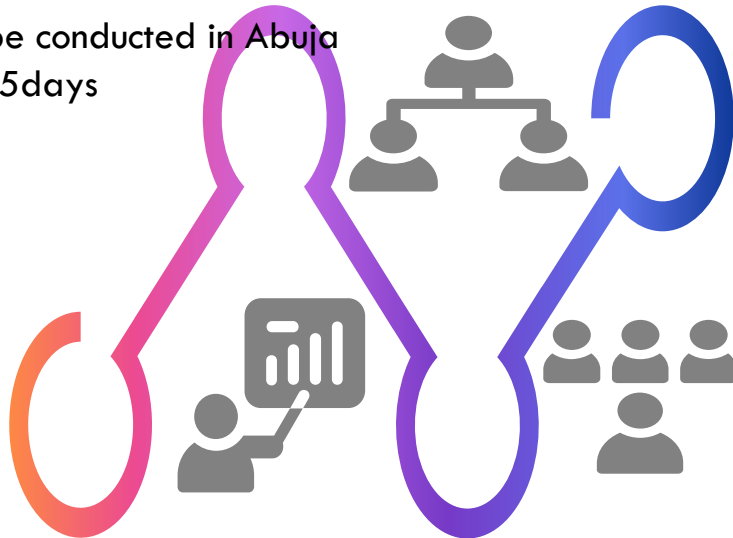
TRAINING FOR FIELD WORK

Two levels of training will be adopted

1st level: Training of Trainers (ToT)

- Participants at the training will include:
 - ✓ Trainers
 - ✓ Coordinators
 - ✓ Stakeholders
 - ✓ Data editors

- Training will be conducted in Abuja
- It will last for 5days



2nd level: Training of Enumerator (ToE)

- It will take place along keffi express way Nassarawa State
- Participants at the training will include:
 - ✓ Enumerators
 - ✓ Trainers/Monitors
 - ✓ Data Editors
 - ✓ State Officers
 - ✓ Zonal Controllers
 - ✓ Independent monitors
 - ✓ Stakeholders

- Training will last for 7days

FIELD WORK ARRANGEMENT

- One (1) team will be formed in each state
- The team will comprise of five (5) persons
 - 1 team lead & 4 teammates
 - Each enumerator will interview 3 HHs in an EA
 - 20 enumerators will cover the 4 states in all
- The team will cover 10 EAs in 15 days
- 30 EAs will be covered in each state making a total of 120EAs for the 4 states
- 450 HHs will be covered in each state making a total of 1800 HHs

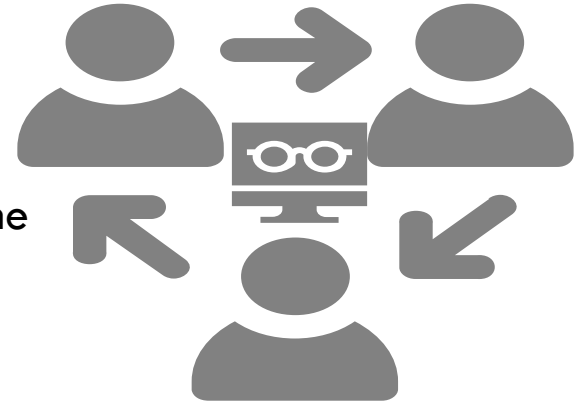
Data collection will be carried out in 51 days including 6 days for rest after covering 10EA



MONITORING and COORDINATION

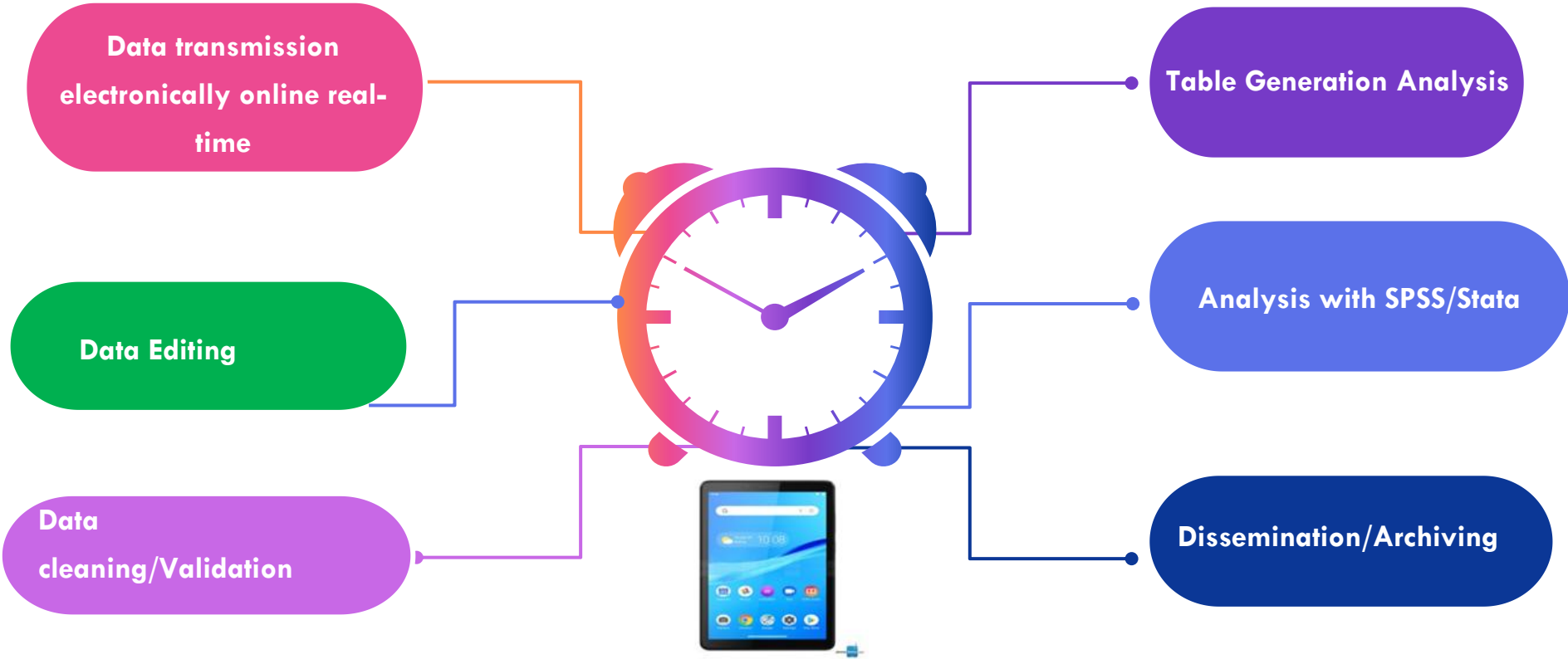
- **Monitoring exercise will be carried out by;**
 - Trainer/Monitors
 - NBS State officers
 - Zonal controllers
 - Independent Monitors
- Monitors/Independent monitors will monitor for 10days
- State officers and zonal controllers will monitor throughout the period of data collection

- **Coordination** will be carried out by directorate members of the Bureau
- It will last throughout the period of the data production exercise
