Methodology

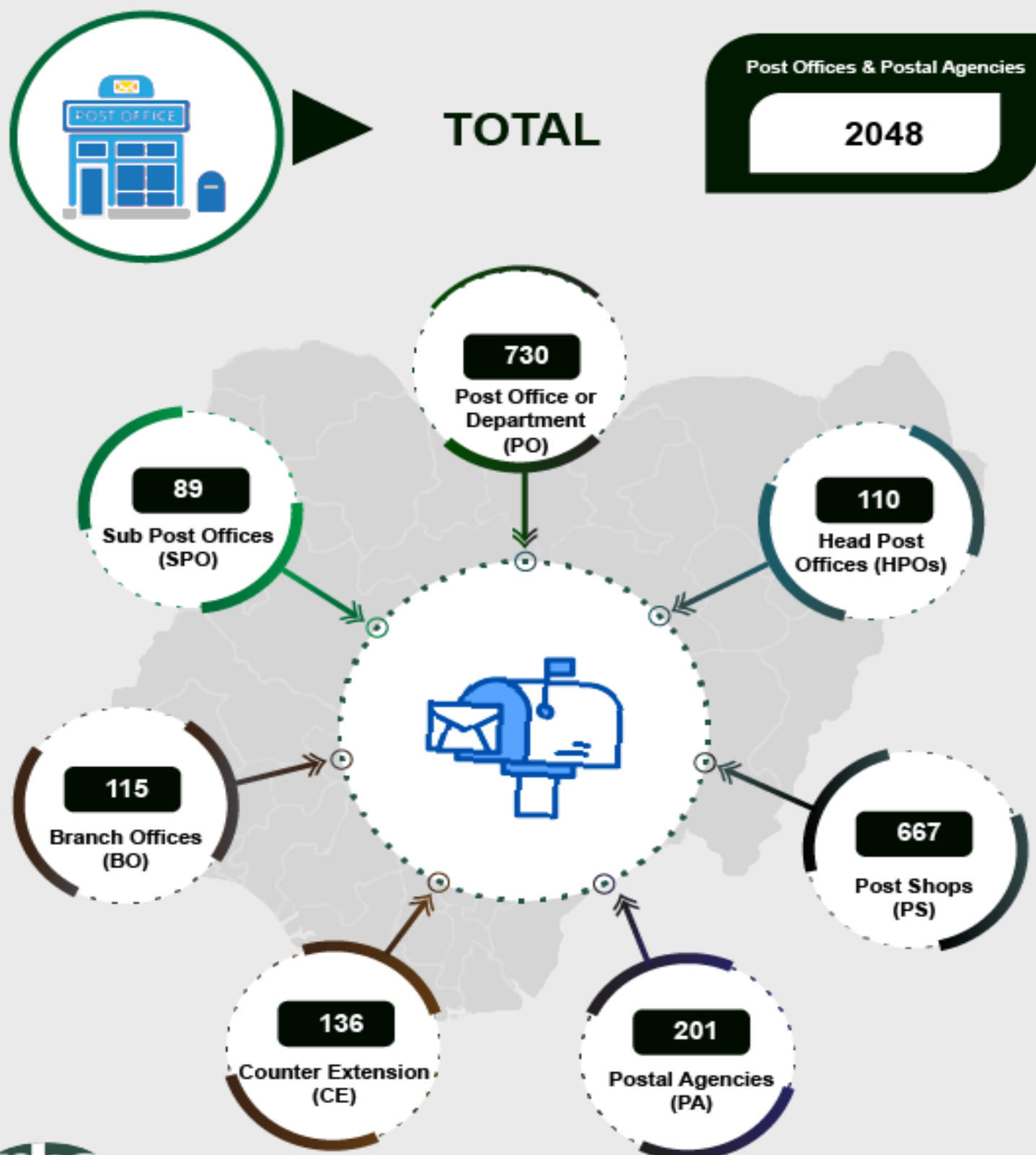
Data is provided by the Nigerian Postal Service (NIPOST) and reported by the National Bureau of Statistics.

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- In 2025, total revenue generated from postal activities rose significantly by 166.81% from ₦3.05 billion in 2024 to ₦8.14 billion.
- The total number of Post Offices and Postal Agencies remained unchanged in 2025 at 2,048 compared to the previous year.
- The number of boxes installed decreased slightly from 788,124 in 2024 to 786,323 in 2025, representing a 0.23% decline.
- The total number of Private Mail Bags (PMBs) available stood at 21,962 in 2025, reflecting a 0.46% decrease from 22,064 in 2024.
- The volume of postal articles handled declined from 23,990,357 in 2024 to 18,237,462 in 2025, representing a 23.98% decrease.
- At the state level, Lagos state recorded the highest number of installed boxes in 2025, with 143,416 boxes, while Jigawa state recorded the lowest, with 1,800 boxes installed.
